### REMARKS

On 08/03/19, at approximately 2140 hours, Lieutenant Maturo radioed into central dispatch he conducted a motor vehicle stop on CT Combination in the area of Main Street extension under the Route 9 connector overpass in Middletown CT. I, Officer DiFonzo, was dispatched to his location for a back-up.

Upon arrival I met with Lieutenant Maturo who had the above mentioned vehicle (2013 GMC K2500 color grey pick up) stopped in the north bound lane of Main Street Extension under the Route 9 overpass. I was advised by Lieutenant Maturo that while he was traveling west bound on Ridge Road he observed the above mentioned vehicle pulled over on the south side of Ridge Road near Randolph Road, facing east, flashing his head lights. Lieutenant Maturo stated he turned his police cruiser around and the vehicle began traveling east bound on Ridge Road.

Lieutenant Maturo stated he followed the vehicle east bound on Ridge Road and observed the driver failing

to maintain his travel lane. Lieutenant Maturo stated the vehicle made a left hand turn onto Main Street Extension, headed north bound, and he conducted a motor vehicle stop on Main Street Extension under the Route 9 connector overpass.

The driver was identified as David Malcolm by his CT Commercial Driver License # \_\_\_\_\_ J. Malcolm, who was the only occupant of the vehicle, admitted to drinking alcoholic beverages.

Based on the failure of the Standardized Field Sobriety Tests and that Malcolm was observed operating his vehicle on Ridge Road and Main Street Extension, he was placed under arrest and transported to Middletown Police Headquarters.

Malcolm was requested to submit to a breath test which he refused.

Malcolm was processed under the following charges: Operating Under the Influence (14-227a) and Failure to Maintain Lane (14-236). Malcolm was released on a \$500 Non-Surety bond and was picked up by his wife and was driven home. Malcolm is scheduled to appear in court (GA09) on 08/16/19 at 0900 hours.

### REMARKS

On 08/02/19 at approximately 0015 hours, I, K9 Officer Aura Smith was on routine patrol, traveling north on Main Street. As I approached the intersection of Main and Washington Streets I observed a large white

Ford pickup traveling south on Main Street in the left of two travel lanes. As the pickup began to turn left onto Washington Street, it began to accelerate as it did so and then once fully turned onto Washington Street, it accelerated hard causing the rear tires to squeal and spin so rapidly that the rear end of the truck started "fish tailing" from left to right for about 10-15 feet.

At this time, I activated my overhead lights and siren and pulled behind the pickup to conduct a motor vehicle stop. The pickup stopped spinning its tires but instead of pulling over, the operator continued at a normal rate of travel from the intersection down lower Washington Street for about 400 feet before turning left into the parking lot behind 44 Washington Street. I followed the vehicle into the lot and as I turned in, I saw the pickup was now parked. Instead of staying in the vehicle as instructed the male driver fled into the rear of the building and disappeared out of sight.

With the assistance of additional Officers, I was able to make contact with the operator, identified via his CT Drivers License as Jared Zotta (22), at his second floor apartment. Central Dispatch advised that the accused's drivers license was suspended as of 11/29/17). The accused offered no explanation as to why he had failed to stop when signaled, or fled once he had parked. The registered owner of the truck (the accused fiance) told Officers that the accused came home and when he got into the apartment he told her "A cop was chasing me!".

The accused was transported to headquarters where he was processed and released on a five thousand dollar non-surety and assigned a court date of Wednesday 08/14/19, 0900 hours at GA9 Middletown where he will answer for the charges of Traveling Too Fast for Conditions, Failure to Stop When Signaled, Operating Under Suspension and Interfering with an Officer, in violation of CGS 14-218\*, 14-223(b), 14-215(a) & 53a-167a respectively.
