REMARKS

On 12/14/2016 Detectives from the Middletown Police Department Narcotics Unit prepared to execute a signed narcotics search and seizure warrant on Neil Brion, a grey 2009 Honda Accord bearing Connecticut registration 573XEG, and 22 Newberry Way Middletown, Connecticut. The residents of 22 Newberry Way are his girlfriend, his parents, and two juveniles (age 13 and 3 months). Brion is known to Detectives to sell marijuana from 22 Newberry Way and at various locations throughout Middletown, Connecticut.

At approximately 1900 hours, Detective Peck and I observed Brion exit 22 Newberry Way and get into the Honda. Detective Peck and I followed Brion in our unmarked police vehicle. We observed Brion fail to come to a complete stop at the marked state stop sign at the intersection of York Road and East Street. While following Brion on East Street I clocked his vehicle traveling at 55 MPH in a posted 35 MPH zone for approximately .4 miles. The vehicle then failed to stop at the marked state stop sign at intersection of East Street and Westfield Street. When Brion turned onto Westfield Street I activated our emergency lights and siren and initiated a traffic stop. We approached the vehicle and advised Brion of our intent to serve a search and seizure warrant on him, his car and residence. He was detained without incident.

Brion was verbally advised of his Miranda rights at the scene and chose to speak with me. I detected the odor of an alcoholic beverage emanating from his breath as he spoke with me. Brion admitted that he had been drinking a beer that was in the vehicle. He also admitted there was a "dime" (meaning a gram) of marijuana in a baggie between his driver seat and the center console. I found the baggie of suspected marijuana where Brion said it was (later weighed 2.4 grams on a department scale) and observed a partially consumed a 24 ounce can of Natural Ice beer. The can was still cold to the touch and the beer was still carbonated, indicating he had been drinking it while driving. I also found his cellular phone in Brion's pocket and \$90 in US currency in his wallet. Brion assured me there was no additional contraband in his residence.

Detectives and uniformed patrol officers proceeded to 22 Newberry Way and made entry into the residence. Once inside Detectives entered the residence and found Brion's parents, his girlfriend and the juvenile teenager. The 3 month old was sleeping in the bed in the bedroom shared by Neil Brion and his girlfriend.

Once the residence was secured a thorough search was conducted of Neil Brion's bedroom. A cursory search of the rest of the residence was completed as well.

In the bedroom shared by Neil Brion and the following items were found:

- Plastic jar that contained a baggie of marijuana (the contents of which weighed 23.2 grams on a department scale)

- iPad

- Box of sandwich baggies (the same type the marijuana found in the car was packaged in)

- Piece of mail addressed to Neil Brion at 22 Newberry Way

- Track cellular phone

- A digital scale with suspected marijuana residue

- A hollowed out cigar filled with suspected marijuana (later weighed 1.1 grams on a department scale)

- A baggie with suspected marijuana residue in it

- Numerous baggies with suspected marijuana residue

- A marijuana smoking bowl with suspected burnt marijuana

- Glass jar with marijuana residue

Brion admitted on scene that the marijuana was his and did not belong to anyone else. Marijuana was also easily accessible to the 13 year old child and created a threat to the child's wellbeing. The bedroom the baby was sleeping in had an overwhelming odor of marijuana emanating from it. It was evident that marijuana was regularly being smoked in this room. DCF was contacted by Detective Lathrop and a DCF report of neglect and abuse was completed.

Brion was transported to the Middletown Police Department, where he was fingerprinted, photographed and processed.

Brion was advised of his Miranda rights again in writing. Brion admitted that all of the marijuana and other contraband found at the residence was his, but denied selling drugs.

The suspected marijuana and marijuana residue tested positive for the presumptive presence of marijuana with NARK 9.

The total combined weight of the seized marijuana was 26.7 grams. The street value of the marijuana found in the department was determined to be \$530 if sold at \$20 per gram.

The amount of marijuana found in the residence was more than a typical user would have in their possession, and was an amount that was indicative of an individual involved in the sale of the drug. That coupled with the digital scale and packaging material used to break down large amounts of drugs into smaller amounts made it evident that Brion was directly involved in the sale of illicit drugs.


Brion was held on a \$50,000 surety bond for violation of CGS 2 counts of 14-301 failure to obey stop sign, 14-218a speeding, 53a-213 drinking while operating a motor vehicle, 21a-267(a) possession of drug paraphernalia, 21a-279(a)(1) possession of a controlled substance, 21a-277(b) possession of marijuana with intent to sell. He is scheduled to appear at GA9 in Middletown on 12/29/2016 at 0900 hours.

Brion has prior convictions for possession of narcotics, possession of narcotics with intent to sell, possession of drug paraphernalia, 3 counts of possession of marijuana, and violation of probation

REMARKS

On Tuesday, 12/13/16 at approximately 1931 hours, I, Officer Jeffries was parked in my marked police vehicle on Benjamin Lane near Tuttle Road.

I observed a color black, 2008 Honda Accord bearing CT registration AD27240 traveling in a easterly direction, fail to stop for the stop sign at Tuttle Road and Benjamin Lane. The vehicle did not appear to slow down for the stop sign and had no regard for pedestrian or other vehicular traffic. The stop sign was visible without any obstruction and can be seen for more than 100 feet.

I immediately began to follow this vehicle, which was traveling consistently at 45mph on Tuttle Road. The posted speed limit on Tuttle Road is 25mph.

I activated my emergency lights and sirens and conducted a motor vehicle stop of this vehicle on Newfield Street near Tuttle Road. Upon approaching the vehicle from the passenger side, I spoke with the operator and owner of the vehicle, David Chen. David Chen provided me with his license but stated he did not have his registration or insurance card in the vehicle. I was able to speak with a Geico Insurance representative and confirm he had insurance for the vehicle.

An inquiry was made on David's CT license (038159020) with Middletown Dispatch which came back suspended as of 11/25/15. I asked David for the vehicle key, which he provided me.

The vehicle was towed by Midtown Towing to 1 Jackson Street. I completed the Notice of Motor Vehicle Tow form (H-114) and provided David and the tow truck driver with a copy.

David was issued a Misdemeanor Summons (MC397014) for violation of C.G.S. 14-301, Failure to Obey a Stop Sign, 14-215(a), Operating Under Suspension, 14-218a, Traveling Unreasonably Fast, 14-13, Failure to Carry Registration and Insurance card.

David is scheduled to appear at Middletown Superior Court, GA-09, on Wednesday, 12/28/16 at 0900 hours.



We observed White operating a black Dodge Durango bearing Connecticut passenger plate 318UZG, stopped at the stop sign of Miner Street and East Street. We were able to identify White through numerous prior law enforcement interactions. The Dodge made a right onto East Street and began heading southbound. We confirmed the warrants through dispatch and followed the Dodge. The Dodge made a left turn onto Westfield Street and we activated our emergency lights and siren. The Dodge did not immediately pull over and continued west on Westfield Street, and then turned left onto Meadowbrook Road, before coming to a stop. We approached the vehicle and placed White into custody without incident. In plain view I saw a baggie of suspected marijuana in the front driver's door arm rest. The lone passenger was temporarily detained. The vehicle was searched and aside from the suspected marijuana no additional contraband was found. Two Android cellular phones (Samsung and a ZTE) were found in the center console and seized as evidence in the

drug cases.

A check through dispatch revealed that White does not have a valid driver's license. The warrants were canceled.

The passenger was released at the scene. White was transported to the Middletown Police Department where he was fingerprinted, photographed and processed. He refused to waive his Miranda rights.






