REMARKS

On 12-20-2016 at approximately 0616 hrs. Ofc. Stead and I, Ofc. Mudano, responded to a certain address in Middletown on a reported domestic disturbance. Upon arrival I was met by

Ms. Sanchez gave the following account of the mornings events: Ms. Sanchez said she woke up at 5:00 a.m. and began to wake up her children for school. She said she went into her oldest daughter's (referred to further as Offender 1 (O1) room to wake her up.

Ms. Sanchez said O1 said she (O1) was not going to go to school today. Ms. Sanchez said she was upset because O1 has missed twelve days of school since September. Ms Sanchez said her boyfriend, further identified as Victim 1 (V1) asked if O1 was going to school and Ms. Sanchez told him "no". She said O1 was also upset because of O1's many absences. Ms. Sanchez said V1 was concerned that O1 would not stay home while the two were at work.

Ms. Sanchez said O1 became angry when V1 made his concerns known. Ms. Sanchez said O1 began yelling at V1 that he (V1) should "shut the fuck up" and that "it was none of his business." Ms. Sanchez said O1 then grabbed a white plastic chair that was in her bedroom and threw it at V1, who was at the bottom of the stair case. While interviewing Ms. Sanchez, after she told me O1 had thrown the chair, O1 said "It didn't even hit him."

O1 was transported to Middletown Police H.Q. where she was processed for violation of 53a-182, Disorderly Conduct, of the Connecticut General Statutes. O1 was given a court date of 12-20-2016 at GA09 in Middletown and held on a \$500.00 surety bond.

REMARKS

On 12/16/16 at approximately 0849 hours Officer Maio and I, Officer Murphy were dispatched to 500 Washington St #27 for a report of an overdose.

Upon my arrival Middletown Fire and Hunters Ambulance were both on scene assessing the patient, Christopher Sheaffer. While treating said patient, Middletown Fire staff located a bundle (10 individual dosage units) of heroin in Sheaffer's front t shirt pocket.

Scheaffer was subsequently transported to Middlesex Hospital via Hunters Ambulance to evaluate his condition. Officer Maio and I then made our way to Middlesex Hospital and placed Schaeffer into police custody. While at Middlesex Hospital, Schaeffer was told he was under arrest for the Possession of a Narcotic C.G.S. 21a-279(a)*. Schaeffer remained in police custody at Middlesex Hospital until approximately 1100 hours when the doctor on scene cleared Schaeffer to check himself out. Schaeffer was subsequently transported to Middletown Police Headquarters for booking.

Schaeffer was read his Notice Of Rights at 1154 hours and charged with C.G.S. 21a-279(a)* (Possession of a Narcotic). He was processed for the above charge and released from custody on a 5,000 Non-Surety Bond. He is scheduled to appear in court on 12/21/16 at 0900 hours.

The heroin obtained from Schaeffer's pocket was seized and packaged as evidence at Middletown Police Headquarters. The bundle contained 10 individual dosage units that weighed a total aggregate weight of 1.73g. I additionally tested the substance inside one of the individual baggies which tested positive for the presence of heroin using NARC Test Kit #3. The bundle was subsequently tagged and submitted into evidence locker #3.

REMARKS


On 12-16-2016 Det Dirga and I observed a silver Nissan traveling north on West Lake drive with only one headlight in violation of 14-96b. We got behind the vehicle bearing CT registration 168YPY. We realized the vehicle was listed as stolen, as we were advised in roll call prior to our shift. We advised dispatch that we were on Smith St approaching Industrial Park Rd and asked them to ensure the vehicle was still listed as stolen, which they confirmed it was. The _____ was confirmed through _____
We followed the vehicle to the intersection of Industrial Park Rd and Rt 372 in Cromwell where it pulled into a gas station. We were able to stop the vehicle and found the operator to be Eric Hoggard
He was ordered out of the vehicle and handcuffed immediately. He was searched and not found to be in possession of any weapons or narcotics.

Upon inspecting the vehicle we found a significant amount of fresh damage to the vehicle's front right area. The vehicle owner was consulted and it was determined the damage was not present when the vehicle was stolen. The estimated value of the damage was at least \$2000.00. A report (such as Carfax) of the repaired damage to the vehicle would be accessible to any future buyers of the vehicle, thus depreciating the value of the vehicle. In plain view on the driver's seat of the vehicle was a small amount of a white rock like substance Det Dirga was able to identify as crack cocaine through his training and experience. He used a NIK wipe to field test the substance which turned the wipe blue indicating the presence of cocaine.

The remaining cocaine was not a measurable amount. Our investigation also revealed Hoggard's license is currently suspended in violation of 14-215 operating a motor vehicle with a suspended license.

At the police department, Eric Hoggard was charged with 53a-279(a) possession of narcotics, 53a-115 criminal mischief in the first degree, 53a-124 larceny in the third degree and 53-126b criminal trover in the second degree on UAR # 8873808. He was also charged with 14-215 operating with a suspended license on UAR # 8873809. He was held on a \$100,000 surety bond and is scheduled to appear at GA9 in Middletown on 12/19/2016 at 0900 hours.

Hoggard's _____ shows convictions for disorderly conduct, burglary in the third degree, larceny in the third degree criminal mischief in the second degree and criminal mischief in the first degree.

REMARKS

On 12/14/16 at approximately 0953 hours Officer White and I, Officer Murphy were dispatched to 909 Washington (Home Depot) for a larceny. The complainant, Asset Protection Manager for Home Depot, stated that he had an employee in his office and she was being cooperative. Sgt. Lukanik additionally responded to the scene to provide assistance.

Upon our arrival we made contact with [redacted] at his Office, who had employee Kimberlee Donofrio in his custody. [redacted] informed me that Donofrio had been taking money from her register over the past month. [redacted] added that throughout the past 30 days a total \$3,000 was removed from the cash drawer that Donofrio was assigned to.

[redacted] provided a sworn written statement to Officer White at 1125 hours which provided that Donofrio willingly admitted to removing cash from her drawer several times over the past 30 days. [redacted] also stated that Donofrio's register was short the amount of \$632.77 on 12/12/16.

[redacted] provided video footage with detailed accounts and times of all the money removed from Donofrio's drawer over the past 30 days. [redacted] also provided print outs of the register shortages for each occurrence, and the signed statement provided by Donofrio early in the day.

It was determined by Sgt. Lukanik and responding Officers that Donofrio be placed into custody based solely on her larceny from Home Depot on 12/12/16. While at Middletown Police Headquarters Kimberlee Donofrio was read and signed her Notice Of Rights at 1143 hours. While in police custody Donofrio willingly admitted again to taking money several times from Home Depot, but could not specify the amounts.

Based on the Donofrio's and verbal and written statements this Officer believes Donofrio to be in violation of C.G.S. 53A-125a (Larceny 5th Degree) for removing a total of \$632.77 from her register drawer on 12/12/16. Donofrio was processed for the charge and given a court date of 12/28/16 at 0900 hours. Donofrio was additionally released from custody on a \$5,000 Non Surety bond.


