



### REMARKS

On 12/21/2016 the Middletown Street Crimes Unit executed a search and seizure warrant on 460 Main Street, apartment 13 Middletown, CT. The target of the investigation, is arrested on numerous narcotics related charges including, possession of narcotics with intent to sell. was found to be in possession of heroin and drug paraphernalia related to cocaine, crack cocaine and heroin sales.

Along with narcotics, white Apple iPhone 4 cellular phone ( ) was seized as evidence. Detectives applied for a search and seizure warrant for said cellular phone which was granted by the Honorable Judge Edward Mullarkey. A subsequent search of the phone showed numerous text messages directly related to the sale of narcotics. One thread of text messages originated from . I ran this number through data mining servers and determined, with a 99% probability, that it belonged to Donald Guenther ( ). Guenther was later identified as the owner of the cellular phone with this number.

At approximately 1508 hours, cellular phone began receiving messages from Guenther as follows:

Today 1508 hours:

Guenther: Still nothing?

Det. Dirga as : Not yet

Det. Dirga as After 6

Guenther: Ok cool I'll hit u up cuz I'm gonna be in ur area

I know through my training and experience that this is consistent with individuals attempting to contact drug dealers in attempt to purchase drugs.

Today 1712 hours:

Det. Dirga as : On my way what do you need

Guenther: Eighth

Det. Dirga as . Ok

Guenther: I'll hit u up when I'm on way. Just waiting for to pick me up

Det. Dirga as How long

Guenther: Im thinking I'll be there by 6?

Guenther: He's in Wallingford now. So he should b at my house by 540 and then it takes me 15 to get to ur place

Det. Dirga as : Ok

Guenther: I got \$ for u on Friday

Guenther: On my way

Det. Dirga as : You got money

Guenther: No not till Friday

Guenther: Is that alright?

Guenther: I'm almost there

Det. Dirga as Wells Fargo

Guenther: Where's that

Guenther: Be there in a second

Det. Dirga as Washington

Guenther: Where u at

Guenther: Weve got : truck

Det. Dirga as Coming

Guenther: Ok

Det. Dirga as Dont see you

Guenther: Parked in back

I know through my training and experience that an eighth is a drug slang representing an eighth of an ounce of said drug. Evidence from the warrant, CI information, and the controlled purchase of drugs from showed that he was selling cocaine, crack cocaine, and heroin. It was evident that was attempting purchase an eighth of an ounce of cocaine or crack cocaine, as it is not common for individuals to purchase an eighth of an ounce of heroin.

Sgt. Yepes, Det. Dirga, Det. Lathrop and I pulled our unmarked Middletown Police vehicles into the parking lot of Wells Fargo bank, 111 Washington St., and observed a white 2015 GMC Sierra parked on the S/E side of the lot. The vehicle was idling and occupied by two individuals. Det. Dirga called Guenther's cellular phone with phone and it began to ring. It was evident that this was the individual Det. Dirga had been communicating with.

Detectives then approached the vehicle and identified themselves as Middletown Police Detectives. Both occupants, the driver and Donald Guenther (passenger) immediately put up their hands. Sgt. Yepes and Det. Lathrop had Guenther step out of the vehicle.

As the operator exited the vehicle I advised him that he was being detained and he would be patted down for weapons. I asked him if he had anything illegal on his person or in his vehicle and he responded that he had "some weed in the back seat." Upon searching his person, no contraband was located on his person.

Sgt. Yepes and Det. Lathrop began speaking with Guenther. He acknowledged the text messages had been sent from him. He stated he normally purchases marijuana from [redacted] at the car wash, but hadn't been able to meet him for the last two days. He stated he had contacted [redacted] phone with the intention of purchasing marijuana.

A search of the vehicle revealed a canvas bag in the rear passenger compartment of the vehicle. The bag contained;

- (2) large glass water pipes
- Marijuana grinder with residual amounts of marijuana
- (2) rolling paper packages, (2) cut straws
- (3) glass pipes containing burnt marijuana residue
- A glass jar containing marijuana

A check of Guenther's history revealed that he had no previous history.

Despite Guenther's claim that he was purchasing marijuana, a totality of the circumstances indicated that he was purchasing narcotics.

Donald Guenther issued a misdemeanor summons and was released on a written promise to appear. He is scheduled to appear at GA9 in Middletown on 01/03/2016 at 0900 hours for violation of CGS 53a-49/21a-279(a) Criminal Attempt to Possess Narcotics.

The messages from Guenther's cellular phone were added to the file. Digital copies of the messages were submitted with this report.

Riddick's license was valid and [redacted] and III showed no warrants for her arrest.



Lathrop observed 3 males seated in a vehicle parked directly behind the injured party. Several additional Officers arrived and began to assist the injured party. See MPD case #16-31263 for additional information.

Due to the nature of the call, I approached the vehicle to investigate if the individuals had either seen anything or been involved in the reported fight.

Upon making contact with the occupants of the vehicle, I immediately recognized the occupants as Najawan Ward (driver's seat), ARRESTED PARTY 2 (AP2) (front passenger seat) and A third party (right rear passenger seat). These individuals have been involved in numerous complaints regarding disturbances, narcotics and other quality of life issues throughout the City of Middletown.

As I began to speak with Ward through his open driver's side window, I could smell the overwhelming odor of marijuana emanating from the interior of the vehicle. It was quickly determined that none of the occupants of the vehicle had been involved in the previously reported fight, however, due to the odor of marijuana in the vehicle I asked Ward to exit.

As he stepped from the vehicle, I asked Ward if he had anything illegal on his person and he stated that he did not. I advised Ward that he was going to be patted down for weapons and he responded, "Why are you bothering me, I'm just here to meet my girl."

Ward was patted down and as I ran my hand over the pocket of his pants, I could feel an unnatural bulge on the edge of the pocket. I immediately recognized the bulge as suspected narcotics. I removed the item from his pocket and revealed a plastic baggie tied around two smaller plastic baggies of a white powder substance which I recognized as suspected cocaine. Upon asking Ward about the narcotics he stated, "I was just trying to get high."

Ward was placed in handcuffs and a thorough search of his person was conducted. In his pants pocket I located \$380.00 in US currency. In his jacket pocket I located \$60.00 US currency. In an interior jacket pocket I located a small baggie containing a green leafy substance which I immediately recognized as suspected marijuana.

Ward was advised that he was under arrest and secured in a marked Middletown Police vehicle.

Det. Lemieux removed AP2 from the vehicle and conducted a search of his person. In AP2's pocket, Det. Lemieux located a small baggie containing a green leafy substance which he immediately recognized as suspected marijuana. No additional contraband was found on AP2's person. AP2 was detained in handcuffs while we continued our investigation.

The third party was asked to step from the vehicle and he was searched by Det. Lemieux as well. No contraband was found on his person, he was detained while the vehicle was searched.

Upon entering the vehicle, I observed an open box of "ziplock" style baggies on the floor behind the driver's seat. Through training and experience I am aware that drug dealers commonly use these type of bags by tearing off the corners to package their product for distribution.

In the trunk of the vehicle I located a used plastic baggie containing suspected marijuana residue.

On the floor between the passenger seat and the passenger front door I found several small white pieces of a rock-like substance which I immediately recognized as suspected crack cocaine. A small portion of the item was field-tested using a NARK Kit #13 which returned a positive result for the presence of cocaine. Due to the location where the crack cocaine was found, it was determined that no other party inside the vehicle could have dropped it except the individual who had been seated in the passenger front seat.

Based on the totality of circumstances it was determined that AP2 had been in possession of the crack cocaine and had attempted to dispose of it to avoid being caught by the Police. AP2 was advised that he was under arrest and secured in a marked Middletown Police vehicle. Upon placing AP2 in a vehicle, Ward began insisting that AP2 did not drop the crack cocaine inside the vehicle.

It should be noted that throughout our search of the vehicle there were two cell phones in the center console that were continuously ringing. Ward identified the phones as belonging to him.

Upon finishing searching the vehicle, the third party was released from the scene. AP2 and Ward were transported to

Middletown Police HQ where they were advised of their rights, photographed and fingerprinted.

All items seized at the scene were transported to MPD HQ where Det. Lemieux weighed and tested them. The marijuana in AP2's possession weighed 2.4 grams and tested positive for the presence of THC. The marijuana in Ward's possession weighed 3.1 grams and tested positive for the presence of THC. The crack cocaine in AP2's possession weighed .01 grams and tested positive for the presence of cocaine. The (2) bags of cocaine in Ward's possession weighed a total of 1.7 grams and tested positive for the presence of cocaine. All items were tagged as evidence and secured in an evidence locker.

The currency seized from Ward (\$400.00 total) was secured in evidence and tagged for asset forfeiture.

A check of Najawan Ward's history revealed - he is convicted felon with previous convictions for; Failure to Appear 1st and Possession of Narcotics (multiple convictions).

Najawan Ward was charged with violations of;

CGS 21a-279(d) – Possession of Drugs in a School Zone

CGS 21a-277(a) – Possession of Narcotics with Intent to Sell

CGS 21a-279(a)(1) – Possession of Narcotics

CGS 21a-279(a)(a)(1) – Possession of Marijuana Under ½ ounce

He was held on a \$50,000.00 Surety bond and issued a court date at Middletown Superior Court on 12/27/2016 at 0900 hours.

A check of Tysnick Hoggard's history revealed - he is convicted felon with previous convictions for; Assault 3rd, Threatening 2nd, Violation of Conditions of Release, Violation of a Protective Order, Sale of Hallucinogen/Narcotic, Possession of Narcotics (multiple convictions), Interfering/Resisting.

Tysnick Hoggard was charged with violations of;

CGS 21a-279(a)(1) – Possession of Narcotics

CGS 21a-279(a)(a)(1) - Possession of Marijuana Under 1/2 ounce

He was held on a \$50,000.00 Surety bond and issued a court date at Middletown Superior Court on 12/27/2016 at 0900 hours.


