

REMARKS

On 12/16/16 at approximately 1436 hours central dispatch reported an erratic motor vehicle driving west on Washington St. Dispatch stated that the caller was following behind a blue jeep bearing CTReg#AC84944 that was allegedly all over the road. Dispatch added that the registered owner of said vehicle, Sharon Whipple additionally had an outstanding warrant out of Middletown. As the caller followed the above vehicle she informed dispatch of its direction of travel and dispatch relayed the information over the air. Dispatch stated that the above vehicle was exiting its lane of travel and striking curbing on Washington St. The caller reported following the above vehicle onto Stony Crest Dr from Newfield St. where it lost control and struck a parked vehicle.

As I drove up to the vehicle of concern operator and registered owner, Sharon Whipple was observed stumbling out of the driver side door of her vehicle. I immediately addressed Whipple's injuries on scene and she subsequently denied treatment from Hunters Ambulance.

She stated that she did not recall striking any curbing or swerving in her lane while driving. Whipple added that she did not have anything to drink nor does she ever drink. Whipple stated that she takes an Adderall prescription, but only takes one a day as prescribed. While speaking with Whipple, I could tell something seemed "off" about her behavior. She appeared to have difficulty maintaining her balance and she

consistently mumbled words making her difficult to understand.

Based on the information gathered thus far I asked Whipple if she would submit to the Standard Field Sobriety Tests. Whipple agreed to participate in these tests. She did not perform any of the required tests to standard. She was then placed in handcuffs and informed that she was under arrest for C.G.S 14-227a (Operating a Motor Vehicle while Under the Influence of Drugs and/or Alcohol).

Once at Middletown Police headquarters, Officer White conducted a search of Whipple and located a pill bottle on her person. Whipple stated that pills were her prescribed Adderal. I immediately addressed the pill bottle discovered on Whipple. The drug prescribed read "D-Amphetamine Salt Combo 20Mg Tabs" (generic for Adderall). The label additionally read prescribed to Whipple on 12/15/16, which was the day before this incident. The quantity of pills filled on 12/15/16 was for 30, 20mg tabs, however only 23 remained. It should be noted that the daily dosage is listed as one 20mg tablet per day. Also the prescription label states verbatim, "This drug may impair the ability to drive or operate machinery. Use care until you become familiar with its effects." Whipple stated that she had been taking her medication as prescribed.

Whipple was read her Notice of Rights form which she understood and signed at 1619 hours. Whipple was read verbatim Section E: Implied Consent Advisory section of the A-44 form. While filling out Section D of said form, Whipple admitted to consuming only her recommended dose (1, 20mg tablet) earlier in the day, but could not provide a specific time. Whipple additionally added that she had not consumed any food since 2000 hours the night before. Once completing my post arrest interview, Whipple was afforded a reasonable opportunity to telephone an attorney at 1618 hours, which she decided not to.

Based on the information gathered at the scene I decided to request two urine samples from Whipple, who agreed to do so. Whipple provided Urine Sample #1 at 1629 while in my presence. As recommended by the urine test sample kit, I waited approximately 15-20 mins to collect the second urine sample. Urine Sample #2 was provided by Whipple at 1645 hours. Both samples were packaged with integrity seals and placed into refrigerated locker "A" located in the Middletown Police Evidence room. The samples were requested to be set to the State Lab (Department Of Emergency Services and Public Protection for analysis immediately.

The medication located on Whipple (20mg D-Amphetamine Sodium Tablets) was seized and tagged as evidence since it was suspected to be directly involved with her impairment while operating a motor vehicle. The evidence was photographed and placed in Middletown Police Evidence locker #2.

Whipple was issued Misdemeanor Summons #MC379942 for C.G.S. 14-227a (Operating a Motor Vehicle Under Influence Of Drugs and/or Alcohol). Whipple is scheduled to appear in court at GA#9 on 12/29/16 at 0900 hours. Whipple was released on a \$500 Non Surety Bond. She was additionally informed that her operators license was suspended for 24 hours from the time of the accident which she agreed and signed for. Upon completion of the booking process, Whipple was released from custody at Middletown Police Headquarters.

On December 28, 2016 at approximately 0837 hours I was dispatched to 830 Westfield Street for a report of a domestic. The caller, [redacted], stated her daughter Victim 1 had a dispute with her boyfriend Matthew Kiesel. [redacted] stated in the process, Kiesel broke Victim 1's phone, smashed a window on the

house, and tried to shoot Victim 1 with a BB gun.


Upon arrival I spoke to Victim 1. Victim 1 stated they had been in her bedroom when Matt started arguing with her about their relationship. Victim 1 said Matt is constantly starting fights with her about stupid things. Victim 1 said she got upset and stormed out of her room while Matt was yelling at her and calling her names. When she returned to the room, she noticed her white Samsung cell phone, valued at approximately \$300, had been smashed on the ground. They continued to argue and Matt then jumped out the window. Victim 1 stated she closed the window and Matt then punched it with his fist, breaking it and sending glass all over. Victim 1 said she went outside shortly after thinking that Matt had left, but he was still there. They continued to argue and Matt told her he wanted his ring back. Victim 1 said she threw the ring on the ground in front of Matt. Victim 1 said Matt then pulled out a BB gun that he regularly carries around and pointed it at her. Victim 1 said Matt tried to shoot her with the BB gun but missed. Victim 1 described the BB gun as a black handgun with no orange tip on it. Victim 1 said Matt then left headed East on Westfield Street. Victim 1 Provided Officer White with a signed sworn written statement detailing the incident.

I called Matt's Father _____ and explained the incident to him. _____ is aware of Matt's tendency to commit crimes and stated if he spoke to Matt or located him, that he would contact me to let me know. _____ provided me with Matt's phone number. When I called him, Matt advised me he was at a friend's house at 7 Connery Road. Matt stated he would meet me at Club 24 located at 651 South Main Street to talk to me about the incident. Officer DeFrance met me at Club 24 to assist. Officer DeFrance went to 7 Connery Road and confiscated the BB Gun Matt had used. Officer DeFrance transported the BB gun to Middletown Police Headquarters where he tagged it as evidence and completed a JDCR-18.

I transported Matt to Middletown Police Headquarters where he was read his rights, fingerprinted, and processed. Matt was charged with Illegal Discharge of a Firearm (53-203), Reckless Endangerment 2nd degree (53a-64), Disorderly Conduct (53a-182) and Criminal Mischief 2nd degree (53a-116). Matt was held on a \$15,000 surety bond pending his appearance in court on December 29, 2016 at 0900 hours at GA9. Matt stated he would not be able to post his bond.
