## REMARKS

On 2/2/17 at approximately 2328hrs I (Officer Wasilewski) was traveling northbound on Main Street. I came to a stop behind a gray Hyundai Tucson (bearing CT registration 233SFH) at the intersection of Main Street and Court Street. The vehicle stopped due to a City of Middletown Public Works employee who was conducting traffic control for construction work on Main Street. Once the traffic was clear the flagger motioned several times for the Hyundai to travel forward but it remained stopped. After a few moments the Hyundai slowly began traveling northbound. I followed behind the Hyundai as we passed by the construction workers. The Hyundai then abruptly stopped in the roadway and made a U-turn into a parking stall on the

west side of the road. After the vehicle pulled into a parking stall I stopped behind it and illuminated the vehicle with my cruiser spotlight. I approached the driver side and made contact with the operator who was later identified by her Montana drivers license as [REDACTED]. I explained to [REDACTED] that there are clearly posted signs on Main Street stating there are no U-Turns/left turns into parking stalls allowed on Main Street.

I then illuminated the posted sign on the traffic control light metal span with my flashlight. The sign clearly reads "No Left Turns Into Stalls". The signs are posted in several locations throughout the Main Street area. While speaking to them I smelt the odor of marijuana emanating from the vehicle. I also smelt the odor of an alcoholic beverage coming from the interior of the vehicle. I observed an open beer can in the center console cup holder. I asked both [REDACTED] and Sambor how much they had been drinking and if they had been smoking marijuana. They both stated they "Had a couple beers". I asked her about the marijuana smell and she stated "Well I have been eating Doritos, so that may be what you are smelling. Both [REDACTED] and Sambor then laughed. Sambor again leaned over and said "Is this really necessary?" I explained to her that I initially stopped her to advise her that U-Turns/ Left turns into parking stalls were posted and not allowed on Main Street. My intention was to advise her of the law and issue a verbal warning, however, I now smelt the odor of marijuana and suspected that the operator may be under the influence of alcohol.

After Officer Ward arrived on scene I asked [REDACTED] to step out of the vehicle. [REDACTED] immediately replied "No." I then asked her again to step out of her vehicle. She said "No I'm not getting out." [REDACTED] also made comments that I don't have the right to tell her to do that. I told [REDACTED] that I did have the right to ask her to do that and I was asking her to step out to make sure she was not over the legal limit to drive. I explained to them that it was my job to ensure people are not driving while intoxicated and thousands of people die each year from DUI related accidents. [REDACTED] again stated "I'm not getting out". [REDACTED] eventually stepped out of the vehicle at which time I explained that I was going to conduct a field sobriety test.

On two occasions Sambor exited the vehicle while I was conducting the field sobriety test with [REDACTED]. On the first occasion she was told 3-4 times to return to the vehicle before she listened. A few minutes later she exited the vehicle again. Having already explained the purpose and safety reason behind conducting field sobriety tests, I did not engage her any further with the reasoning of my decision. I then directed her a second time to return to the vehicle. Sambor refused to do so. I told her approximately 3-4 times more to return to the vehicle but she continued to say that she was not going to. I then advised her that I was going to arrest her for interfering if she did not return to the vehicle. Sambor still refused. I explained to her that I did NOT want to arrest her and gave her one last directive to return to the vehicle. She refused. I then walked over to her and told her to place her hands behind her back and placed her under arrest. After placing Sambor in the rear of my Police cruiser, I completed the Standardized Field Sobriety Test with [REDACTED] and determined that she had passed.

After completing the Standardized Field Sobriety Tests I told [REDACTED] that I would like to see her vehicle registration and insurance. She told me they were in the glove compartment. When I opened the door I immediately saw a clear orange color prescription bottle on the floorboard. The bottle contained what I was able to identify as suspected marijuana. A second plastic bottle also contained suspected marijuana. The plastic bottle was the same approximately size of the prescription bottle which was found on the floorboard but was not for prescription medication. A female purse was on the floorboard as well. I searched the purse and found an orange metal marijuana grinder inside. A subsequent search of the vehicle revealed two multi-colored glass marijuana pipes. When asked, [REDACTED] and Sambor both admitted that the marijuana was Sambor's and the grinder and two marijuana pipes belonged to [REDACTED].

The two bottles of suspected marijuana, along with the marijuana grinder and two marijuana pipes were seized and later brought to the Middletown Police Department where they were tagged as evidence. The

prescription bottle and contents weighed 11.57 grams. The second bottle and contents weighed 6.12 grams.

Sambor was placed under arrest and transported to the Middletown Police Department where she was charged with violation of CGS 53a-167a Interfering with an Officer and 21a-279a(a)(1) Possession of less than ½ Ounce Marijuana. She was given a court date of 2/17/17 at 0900hrs and told she would have to appear at the GA 9 Court House on that date and time. She stated she understood. She was then released on a \$1,000 nonsurety bond.





REMARKS

On 2/9/2017 at 2243hrs, I Ofc. Sanford. responded to a reported domestic at ADDRESS. Dispatch reported a third party call from : who stated her friend, VICTIM, had a friend over who was acting out of control and VICTIM was hiding from him in the closet.

VICTIM provided a sworn written statement that reads:

"On 2/9/2017 at about 1pm, I VICTIM was hanging out with my friend [redacted] and my friend Brian Bunch while at my apartment drinking. Brian was fine all day until out of nowhere Brian got upset at around 10:30pm. Brian started saying he loved me and stating no one loved him and getting very emotional. I was sitting on the couch while Brian was acting strange, and at that point he pulled me off the couch and I fell on the floor. I was upstairs and hid in the closet and called [redacted] who had left earlier in the day. Brian continued to act strange and I could hear things breaking downstairs. The police then arrived and I came downstairs."

In the apartment there were paintings ripped off the wall and there were broken glass shards around the counter from a broken glass. Bunch's erratic behavior was so severe that VICTIM felt the need to hide in the closet after Bunch made threats to kill her. Between the broken glass and paintings approximately \$40 worth of damage was caused.

Bunch was placed under arrest and transported to Middletown Police Headquarters for the following charges: 53a-182 - Disorderly Conduct, 53a-117 - Criminal Mischief 3rd, and 53a-62 - Threatening 2nd.

Bunch was placed into a holding cell pending processing where he continued to act out. Bunch was seen through one of the security holding an object in his hand after being searched. Officers responded to the holding cell and discovered Bunch had destroyed the security camera in one of the booking cells and was holding the pieces in his hand.


The charge 53a-117a - Criminal Mischief 4th was added as well for damage to municipal property.
