REMARKS

On 2/6/2017, at approximately 0812 hours, I was traveling northbound on Main Street, approaching Green Street, on my way to a private duty job. I observed a silver Nissan Altima idling on the east side of the street. The vehicle was backed into a space that is not designated for parking. It appeared the vehicles back tires were resting against the curb. As I was passing the vehicle, I observed it back up over the curb and onto the sidewalk, and then strike a metal fence that surrounded the Green Street Garden. At this point I noticed the vehicle was not occupied by a driver. Had it not been for the fence the vehicle would have went down a hill and hit a house, conceivably at a high rate of speed. Also any pedestrian that walked by would have been in immediate danger of getting struck by the car. This is usually a high traffic area. I turned around and activated my emergency lights.

As I approached the vehicle I observed a male (later identified by his Connecticut driver's license as Delmar Wedderburn) running towards the vehicle. The tints on the driver's side and passengers side of the vehicle were so dark that it made it impossible to see inside. When I got to the front of the car, I could see through the windshield that the vehicle was occupied by two juvenile passengers in the back seat (later determined to be ages 9 and 1). One child was wearing his seatbelt and the other was in a car seat. The vehicle gear selector was set in reverse. It was evident that they did not engage the vehicle in reverse because they were secured in their seats. I asked Wedderburn if the Altima was his and he said it was. He told me he had parked the car and was going to Los Primos to purchase an item. He told me he left the car running, with the doors locked and the children inside. He thought he put the vehicle in park before walking away.

Wedderburn unlocked the car and pulled it forward off of the fence. The children seemed unfazed by what had happened and were sitting quietly in their seats. No one was injured. When Wedderburn opened the car door I could smell the odor of marijuana emanating from the interior of the vehicle.

Officer Murphy responded as backup. I told Wedderburn that I smelled marijuana and he admitted he has some hidden in a water bottle on the front passenger floor. I retrieved the bottle and found marijuana tied in plastic baggies (later weighed .35 ounces and tested positive for marijuana with NARK 9). I examined the fence and did not observe any damage.

When I spoke to Wedderburn I could not detect any cues that would indicate that he was under the influence of alcohol or drugs. He produced his license, registration and insurance.

I went to my private duty job and Officer Murphy issued Wedderburn MSC MC397264 for violation of CGS 53a-64 Reckless Endangerment 2nd, 21a-279a(a)(1) Possession of Less than ½ Ounce of Marijuana, and 14-99g(b) Illegal Tints.

REMARKS

The Middletown Police Department Narcotics Unit continually receives information regarding illegal drug activity from reliable confidential informants, informants, arrested persons, concerned citizens, anonymous callers, and brother police officers. Detectives have received information from confidential informants and concerned citizens about street level drug dealing in the area of Main Street and Rapallo Avenue. This is a high crime area and Detectives and patrol officers have made vice crime arrests in the area.

On 2-6-2017 Sergeant Yepes was conducting surveillance in the area of Main Street and Rapallo Avenue. Sergeant

Yepes observed three white males loitering by the southeast corner of Main Street and Rapallo Avenue. Sergeant Yepes was able to identify one of the white males as [redacted]. Detectives know [redacted] to be a drug user and often sells drugs to support his habit. Sergeant Yepes observed as the three white males crossed over Rapallo Avenue towards the driveway to 710 Main Street. One of the unidentified white males pointed to the rear of 710 Main Street and one of the other unidentified white males walked to the back of 710 Main Street where Sergeant Yepes lost sight of him. [redacted] and the other remaining white male crossed over Main Street to the west side of Main Street and onto Kings Avenue. There they appeared to meet with a vehicle; Sergeant Yepes observed the vehicle and identified it as 4 door Honda with a Rhode Island registration to Detective Dirga and I over our two way radio. Sergeant Yepes believed the behavior was suspicious and consistent with a possible narcotics transaction. Sergeant Yepes observed as the unidentified white male walked to the rear passenger side of the Honda and after a short conversation, the rear passenger door opened and another unidentified white male emerged from the Honda. Sergeant Yepes had lost sight of [redacted] at this time but the two unidentified white males then walked across Main Street from Kings Avenue towards 710 Main Street where he again lost sight of them as they went back into the driveway of 710 Main Street.

Once the two white males were in the back driveway of 710 Main Street, Sergeant Yepes observed as the Honda pulled out of Kings Avenue and went S/B on Main Street, made a U turn, and then went directly back N/B on Main Street to 710 Main Street. The Honda proceeded to the rear of 710 Main Street and after approximately 30 seconds Sergeant Yepes then observed the same Honda emerge from the rear driveway leading to 710 Main Street and make a right turn N/B onto Main Street. The Honda then made an immediate left turn into the turnaround on Main Street in front of Kings Avenue and it continued S/B on Main Street. Sergeant Yepes was able to identify this behavior to be consistent with an individual's purchasing or selling narcotics. Sergeant Yepes was in constant real time contact with Detective Dirga and I and he instructed us to make a motor vehicle stop of the Honda.

We were nearby in an unmarked MPD police vehicle. We got behind the Honda Accord which was bearing RI registration marker FZ825. Detective Dirga called in the registration marker to MPD dispatch and they advised the marker plate was expired and belonged on a 1999 Nissan but no model was given. The Accord made a left turn onto Ferry Street from Main Street where we decided to enact our emergency lights and siren and conduct a motor vehicle stop of the Honda.

I approached the vehicle on the driver side and Detective Dirga approached on the passenger side. I observed as the operator, later identified as Luis Anglero was moving around the interior of the vehicle possibly attempting to hide contraband or retrieve a weapon to use against Police. The vehicle had a heavy smell of burnt marijuana coming from inside the vehicle as we approached. I also observed as the rear passenger, later identified as Juvenile 1, was also moving his hands towards his pants pockets. The vehicle was occupied by a total of four black males, Anglero and three other black males. Due to the furtive moments and the number of occupants in the vehicle Detective Dirga and I requested more units to our location. We gave loud, clear instructions for all the occupants to show us their hands and to keep them up until told to do otherwise. I instructed the operator, Anglero, to exit the vehicle which he did without incident. Anglero was placed in handcuffs which were double locked and checked for tightness and detained. Other MPD officers arrived on scene and the other three black males were also taken out of the vehicle one by one and placed in handcuffs which were double locked and checked for tightness. A pat down search of Anglero, the front seat passenger (Juvenile 2) and the rear passenger (Juvenile 3) revealed no illegal contraband. A pat down search of the driver side rear passenger (Juvenile 1) by Detective Dirga revealed a small plastic baggie in the right front pants pocket containing an off white soap like substance which Detective Dirga was immediately able to identify as crack cocaine. Due to the suspect being a juvenile we did not question him about the crack cocaine at that time. We informed Juvenile 1 he was under arrest and we placed him in the rear of a marked MPD vehicle. I requested juvenile 1's parent's phone number which he provided. I called juvenile 1's father and requested him to meet us at MPD headquarters.

Detective Dirga and I searched the vehicle and we located numerous items related to narcotic use throughout the vehicle. We located several burnt marijuana roaches in the center console, plastic containers with suspected marijuana residue, and

roofing papers. Anglero later admitted he regularly smokes marijuana and all the paraphernalia in the vehicle was his.

Due to the furtive movements by Anglero and the rear driver side passenger (juvenile1) in conjunction with the contraband found on juvenile 1 and throughout the vehicle we requested narcotics K9 to the scene to perform a search of the vehicle and the occupants.

CT State Police sent an Officer from Troop E to the scene to assist with our search. Trooper Paul Pieper #462 and his narcotics K9 Elsa arrived on scene. After conducting a person search and a vehicle search no further contraband was located.


Anglero and Juvenile 1 were transported to MPD headquarters for booking and processing.

Luis Anglero was fingerprinted, photographed and processed under UAR # 8873977 in violation of 21a-277aa1 Possession of less than ½ Ounce Marijuana, 14-147(c) Improper use of Marker Plate, and 14-213b Operation of a Motor Vehicle without Insurance. Anglero was released on a \$20,000 non-surety bond and issued a court date of 02-22-2017 at GA-09 located at 1 Court Street Middletown CT 06457.







She stated that Victim observed a text from another woman on her phone and an argument ensued in which Victim began punching Ms. Ramos in the face and then began hitting her in the head with a cell phone. This is what caused the laceration. Ms. Ramos stated that she then fled next door where she currently resides, to call the police.

Officer Magnano and I responded next door to speak with Victim. She stated that she was doing Ms. Ramos's hair and eyebrows and that a text from another woman did come to her phone. She stated that she laughed about it and Ms. Ramos became enraged and began hitting her with her hands. She stated that she grabbed Ms. Ramos around the waist to restrain her and the fight became worse. This all happened in the small bathroom. Victim showed me where the toilet paper holder was snapped off of the wall and stated that Ms. Ramos had probably hit it with her head, which in turn caused the small laceration.


Victim had several small red marks on her face and arms from the disturbance.

Ms. Ramos and Victim are former cohabitant's that resided together in a dating relationship and still currently "hook up" for sex.

Ms. Ramos declined medical attention on the scene from South Fire District and Hunter's Ambulance and wanted to go to the wedding in Bolton.

As the two do not currently reside together but are still in some form of a relationship, both were released on the scene on an MSC for Disorderly Conduct with a court date of 2-14-17 in GA 9. Both were also issued Conditions Of Release Family Violence forms and all of the boxes were checked. I explained the No Contact part of the order to them in depth. Both stated that they understood and would not contact the other until after the court date of 2-14-17.

REMARKS

The caller had stated to dispatchers that they had locked him out of the building and he was still standing in the vestibule and banging on the doors.

Upon arrival I located the unwanted person in the vestibule area of the building. He was identified as Charles Mishler.

The employee stated that Mishler was intoxicated and bothering other people in the waiting area. The employee stated that Mishler had been sitting in the waiting area making strange noises before taking a bus and retuning. The employee stated that Mishler would not leave when he was asked to and that he would curse at staff and customers including using the f-word. MAT employees stated that they wished to have Mishler leave the property and told not to return or board any MAT busses for the remainder of the day, but that he could use them in the future.

I then spoke to Mishler and explained that he had to leave and that he could not return to the bus station or use any MAT busses for the rest of the day. He stated that he understood.

Approximately 30 minutes later at 15:42 I was again dispatched back to the MAT station because Mishler had returned and was again causing a disturbance.

Mishler was taken into custody. He stated that he did not know that he was not allowed to return today and denied that he was making a scene inside the building. I told him that I was abundantly clear when I told him that he was not allowed back today and that he had told me that he understood.

Mishler was transported to police headquarters for processing. Once at headquarters Mishler became irate and uncooperative with officers. When being moved from a booking cell, Mishler tensed his body and began clench his fists. He had to be physically dragged into the cellblock and placed into a cell.



REMARKS

On 2-11-17, at or about 2304 hrs, I was at the intersection of Rapallo Avenue and Main Street. I could see a male and a female, at the intersection of Main Street and Grand Street. It appeared as though they were in some kind of argument. The male was only wearing a tank top, shorts, and no shoes. It was approximately 30 degrees out.

The male appeared to be taking an aggressive posture toward the female as they interacted. He was leaning forward, shoulders tensed up, chin tucked, and was waving his hands.

I radioed that I was making contact with the two parties and Officer Delima was dispatched to assist.

Upon making contact with the two parties, both were yelling and swearing at each other. I immediately recognized the male as Luis Krom, through past police encounters with him. Both parties remained irate as we began to interact with them. During our investigation, the female attempted to walk away from Officer Delima and when he began escorting her toward his police vehicle, she pulled away from him and when he attempted to place her in handcuffs to control her, she resisted. She was eventually put under control, handcuffed, and placed in Officer Delima's cruiser.

During this time, Krom attempted to walk over to the female several times. He was told to back away several times and did, but then would attempt to walk toward her again. After she was placed in Officer Delima's cruiser, Krom then turned away from me and started walking west on Grand Street. As the investigation into the incident had not concluded, I told him he was not free to go. He stopped, but did not turn back toward me. I placed my right hand on the underside of his of his left upper arm and attempted to lead him back toward Main and Grand Street where Officer Delima was.

Krom immediately tensed his entire body and braced himself against my efforts to guide him back. I attempted to turn Krom and he yelled, "Fuck that!" and attempted to pulled away from me. I grabbed onto his arm with both hands and told him to calm down, Krom then balled his right fist, began to tense his whole body, raised his shoulders and lowered his chin. His physical action, along with his already agitated state, lead me to believe that Krom was either going to start attempting to flee from me or attempt to fight with me, as he had taken a fighting stance.

Fearing an assault on my person, I brought Krom to the ground using a leg sweep and placed him in handcuffs. No strikes were thrown by Krom or by myself.

Krom was advised he was being placed under arrest for Interfering with Police, CGS 53a-167a. Krom reported that his arms and chest were sore from being thrown to the ground, but declined medical attention, no observable injuries were seen.

During the book process, Krom was allowed to make a phone call. During the phone call, it became clear that he called the female that had also been arrested on scene. The female had already been released when Krom called her. I heard him say, "You had a female cop? Was she blonde?" Krom then said, "Don't worry, I'm gunna put a fucking card on her, she'll get it." At this point I hung up the phone on Krom.

I know through my training and experience as a police officer, that the term "card" used in that context, means a hired assault or "hit." Krom was referring to the female police officer that conducted the search of the arrested female at Middletown Police Headquarters.


Krom then claimed that he knew people that would "do dirt," or perform the act of assaulting the officer, for him. It should be noted that Krom was arrested by Middletown Police in October for an incident in which he fought with officers and was carrying a large, fixed blade hunting knife (Case #16-24289). That case is still pending.

Krom was held on a \$1000 surety bond. He was assigned a court date of 2-14-17, the next available court date.

No officer sustained an injury during this incident.
