REMARKS

On 2/3/2017, at approximately 1612 hours I, Officer Foster, was dispatched to a motor vehicle accident with possible injuries at the intersection of Newfield Street and Tuttle Road. On arrival, it was determined that the accused, Alyssa Jeffrey, had caused the contributing factor of the accident. While speaking to the accused I determined that she may be under the influence of drugs and or alcohol. The accused consented to a field sobriety test on my request. The tests were explained and demonstrated which she acknowledged verbally with her understanding. Jeffrey failed to perform the tests to standard and was placed under arrest. She was transported to Middletown Police HQ for processing.

Jeffrey was read her Notice of Rights Form at approximately 1730 hours and at 1733 hours she declined console from an attorney. Jeffrey reported that she is a recovering heroin addict only a few days into being sober. Jeffrey stated she illegally obtained methadone which she consumed earlier in the evening from a friend.

Results

I am certified in the Drager Alcotest 9510. The device was checked in accordance with the applicable state regulations.

On 02/03/2017, at approximately 1749 hours, the following breath test result was obtained 0.000.

Based on those results, this Officer switched to a urine test at 1757 hours. A urine sample was obtained and was submitted to the state lab for evaluation pending the results.

Jeffrey was charged with violation of C.G.S. 14-227a DUI and violation of C.G.S. 14-299 Failure to Obey a Traffic Signal. Jeffrey was released on a \$500 non-surety bond and was assigned a court date of February 17, 2017 at 0900 hours. Her vehicle was towed from the scene by Midtown Towing and her license was revoked for 24 hours in conjunction with state statute.

REMARKS

On 2/8/17 at approximately 1325hrs Johnson was observed backing out a 2001 blue Lincoln Town Car bearing CT registration 510PYL in the area of 324 Main Street. As he backed up his vehicle, he screeched the tires. He then engaged the vehicle into drive screeching the tires again and proceeded north on Main Street. While traveling north on Main Street in the area of Ferry Street, Johnson was observed traveling in the middle of two lanes without using any turn signals.

When this officer stopped Johnson, he was identified by his Connecticut Operator's License. There was a strong odor of Listerine emitting from the vehicle and I was able to see that there was some spilled liquid on the front seat. However, Johnson denied spilling anything inside his vehicle. When asked for his driver's license, registration, and proof of insurance, Johnson handed me a credit card at first. Johnson was fumbling with numerous pieces of paperwork from his glovebox trying to locate the vehicle's registration and proof of insurance. I was able to see that these were among the piles of paperwork he was going through and pointed them out to him telling him that was what I needed. He did not hand me anything, he just kept going through the papers. I had to have him hand me the pile of paperwork so that I could get the registration and insurance card. While Johnson was going through his paperwork, I asked him where he was coming from and he told me "the hospital". I asked him if he had stopped anywhere else after the hospital and he said that he did not. I asked him if he was at the hospital due to an illness or visiting someone else. He claimed that he was there visiting his mother. He denied having any medical conditions. Johnson denied having anything to drink prior to driving.

While speaking to Johnson, I was able to see that his eyes were glassy and bloodshot. He was also slow to answer my questions.

Johnson was asked to exit the vehicle and he was given a field sobriety test on the sidewalk which he failed to conduct to standard.

After Johnson was advised of his Miranda Rights, read the implied consent advisory, given the opportunity to contact an attorney, he was given two breath tests using the Draeger Alcotest 9510 which failed due to an external standard. He then agreed to submit to a urine test. Two urine samples were taken from Johnson; one at 1500hrs and another one at 1513hrs. The results of these tests are pending at this time.

Johnson was charged with the above charges, released on a \$500 non-surety bond, and given a court date of 2/21/17 at GA9.

His operator's license was suspended for 24 hours and held at the police department.

REMARKS

On 2/11/17 at approximately 02:45 hours I, Officer L. Woolard was dispatched to Stevens Lane and Highland Avenue for a single car motor vehicle accident. Officer Jeffries was the assisting Officer.

Upon arrival I observed a brown Nissan Altima bearing CT Reg. AF47861, partially off of the roadway in a snow bank on Stevens Lane. The vehicle was facing West and was in the Eastbound lane. The operator and solo occupant of the vehicle was identified as Leandra Privott. Privott had glossy eyes, a strong odor of alcohol emanating from her person, and she had a difficult time walking. When asked, Privott admitted to drinking alcohol.

Privott failed all field sobriety tests. Privott elected to take the breathalyzer test. The following results were obtained. On 2/11/17 at 04:21 hours 0.1925. The second breath test was given and the following results were obtained on 2/11/17 at 04:41 hours 0.2022.

Privott was issued Misdemeanor Summons and Complaint ticket # MC 540872 for violating C.G.S. 14-218a* : Traveling too fast for conditions and 14-227a : Operating under the influence. Privott was released on a \$500.00 non-surety bond and given a court date of 2/23/17 at 9:00am at GA-9. Privott said she understood my instructions and signed in the designated areas. REMARKS

On 2-11-17, at or about 2304 hrs, I was at the intersection of Rapallo Avenue and Main Street. I could see a male and a female, at the intersection of Main Street and Grand Street. It appeared as though they were in some kind of argument. The male was only wearing a tank top, shorts, and no shoes. It was approximately 30 degrees out.

I radioed that I was stepping out with the two parties. Officer Delima would arrive a short time later to assist. He would begin to interact with the female, later identified as Kali Dickinson, as I interacted with the male.

Officer Delima advised the female, later identified as Kali Dickinson, to walk towards his patrol vehicle. Dickinson was very irate and was yelling and swearing at me.

Officer Delima began walking with Dickinson towards his vehicle when she threw her arms in the air and started to pull away from him. Officer Delima advised her to stop and to keep walking. Officer Delima grabbed onto her arms and tried to keep walking with her.

Dickinson continued to actively resist by pulling from him and trying to walk away. Dickinson tensed her

arms and swung them in a manner like she was trying to get away. Officer Delima then grabbed onto both of Dickinson's arms and put them behind her back and told her to stop resisting. Dickinson's arms were clenched as she continued to resist Officer Delima, and she yelled at him to take his hands off her.

It appeared that she was actively trying to flee from Officer Delima. Officer Delima put Dickinson's chest up against a nearby trash can to allow me to control her arms behind her back. She refused to obey commands and was placed in double-locked handcuffs that were checked for proper fit.

Dickinson was secured in the rear prisoner compartment of Officer Delima's patrol vehicle. She would not answer any questions regarding the yelling that was observed with the male in the street. She was advised that she was under arrest for interfering.

While in the prisoner compartment, she repeatedly kicked the interior of the door while swearing and screaming to be let out. She was transported to headquarters with mileage recorded. Upon arrival to headquarters, she was searched by Ofc Brenda White and secured in a holding room until processing.

She was charged with Interfering with Police, CGS 53a-167a, assigned a court date of 2-28-17, and released on a \$1000 non-surety bond. Dickinson has no prior criminal history.

Dickinson never claimed any injury resulting from the incident.


