REMARKS

On 1/30/2017 Detectives from the Middletown Police Department Narcotics Unit prepared to execute a signed narcotics search and seizure warrant on Robert Lowe and 17 Rapallo Avenue 1st floor Middletown, Connecticut. It should be noted that 17 Rapallo is within 1500' of the Macdonough Elementary School (see attached map).

At approximately 1200 hours detectives and uniformed patrol officers proceeded to 17 Rapallo Avenue 1st floor. We loudly announced their presence and intent to search a signed search and seizure warrant. After several seconds of no one answering the door, and feeling that those inside may either be hiding, attempting to destroy evidence, or attempting to retrieve weapons to use against the police, we were forced to gain entry by breaching the apartment door.

Once entry was made Lowe was found inside with two other residents, one of which was a 10 year old.

Without being asked or prompted to say so, Lowe admitted there was marijuana in the apartment and directed detectives to 9 bags of suspected marijuana hidden in his slippers and a coat. Lowe was then verbally advised of his Miranda rights at this time.

Once the residence was secured Detectives began a thorough search of the rest of the apartment. The following items were found:

In the bedroom shared by Lowe and Roman the following items were found:

1. Numerous unused clear sealable plastic baggies (the same used to package the marijuana Detective Lathrop found)
2. Metal grinder with suspected marijuana residue in it
3. (3) two dollar bills (\$6)
4. Wallet containing \$111 in US currency
5. Letters addressed to Lowe at 17 Rapallo Avenue
6. (1) two dollar bill (\$2)

There was no additional contraband related to drug sales found in the apartment.

The marijuana was also easily accessible to the 10 year old and 12 year children living in the apartment and created a threat to the child's wellbeing. DCF was contacted.

While the search was being conducted Lowe told detectives that he mostly used the marijuana and only sold it to a couple of people. When I asked Lowe if he knew how we obtained the search warrant he said that either people were complaining about what he was doing or we saw him sell marijuana. Lowe took responsibility for all of the contraband in the apartment.

Lowe was taken into custody and transported to the Middletown Police Department, where he was fingerprinted, photographed and processed.

The suspected marijuana tested positive for the presumptive presence of marijuana with NARK 8. The suspected marijuana weighed 17.4 grams on a department scale. The street value of the marijuana found in the department was



determined to be \$350 if sold at \$20 per gram.

The amount of marijuana individually packaged for sale found in the residence was more than a typical user would have in their possession, and was an amount that was indicative of an individual involved in the sale of the drug. That coupled with the packaging material used to break down large amounts of drugs into smaller amounts made it evident that Lowe was directly involved in the sale of marijuana.

Lowe was released on a \$50,000 non-surety bond for violation of CGS 53-21 Risk of Injury to a Minor, 21a-279(a)1 Possession of a Controlled Substance, 21a-267(a) Possession of Drug Paraphernalia, 21a-277(b) Possession of Marijuana with Intent to Sell, and 21a-278(a)b Possession of Marijuana with Intent to Sell within 1500' of a School Zone. He is scheduled to appear at GA9 in Middletown on 2/15/2017 at 0900 hours.

Lowe has 17 prior convictions including risk of injury to a minor, operating a motor vehicle under the influence, operating under suspension, larceny 3rd, criminal possession of weapon, possession of narcotics, possession of marijuana, and failure to appear.

REMARKS

On January 30, 2017 at approximately 1436 hours, I, Officer Spedding was dispatched to a disabled motor vehicle on Route 9 Southbound, approximately 1/2 mile North of Exit 16. Officer Owens and Officer Inglis also responded.

Upon arrival, Central Dispatch ran a query of the plate. CT Reg AC84494 belonged on a blue 2014 Hyundai Elantra registered to Andrea Cruz. The disable vehicle was a red 1992 Toyota Camry. A female was sitting in the front passenger seat. She identified herself as Andrea Cruz, but had no identification. She stated she just got the vehicle and it ran out of gas. Cruz's boyfriend was driving the vehicle, and left to get fuel. Cruz produced a Rhode Island registration and title for the vehicle. The title showed a transfer of ownership on 10/20/16. Cruz also stated the vehicle was not insured.

The registration plates were removed from the vehicle and submitted for return to DMV.

Mid-Town Towing towed the vehicle from the scene. I transported Cruz to her residence to obtain her identification.

Cruz was issued a Misdemeanor Summon (MC378290) for violating C.G.S. 14-147(c) Improper Use of Registration, 14-213(b) Failure to Carry Insurance. Cruz is scheduled to appear at GA9 on 2/10/2017 at 0900 hours.
