**REMARKS**

The victim stated that the argument escalated and that Griffith then shoved him into the wall causing damage to the wall. The victim stated that he was uninjured but that the wall would need to have the sheetrock replaced.


The victim stated that Griffith then left the home and began to walk northbound. The victim stated that he called the police at that time.


I radioed to Officer Freiman that there were going to be domestic charges related to this incident and that he should place Griffith under arrest. Officer Freiman acknowledged, but then stated that Griffith was fleeing on foot and that he would be in pursuit.

Officer Freiman along with other officers were able to catch Griffith after he ran onto route 9 and was met with heavy vehicular traffic. Griffith was transported to police headquarters where he was charged with violating CGS 53a-182 Disorderly Conduct, 53a-117 Criminal Mischief 3rd degree, and 53a-167 Interfering with Police/ Resisting Arrest. Griffith was held on a \$5,000 surety bond and scheduled to appear at GA09 Middletown on 02/06/2017.

Kamp was issued a court date of 02-06-2017 at GA-09, located at 1 Court Street Middletown, CT 06457 at 09:00am. Kamp was released on a \$500.00 non-surety bond for this case but held on a \$50,000 court set surety bond for her warrant.



## REMARKS

On Sunday February 05, 2017 at approximately 2033 hours I was dispatched to a location in Middletown, CT for a report of a physical domestic that had taken place. The complainant stated she had been attacked by her husband.

Upon arrival I spoke to Victim 1/Offender 1 (v1o1) who stated she had been attacked by her husband Victim 2/Offender 2 (v2o2) over a disagreement they had about cheating. V1o1 stated she had found text messages on his phone between him and another girl he was not supposed to be talking to. When she found the messages, v1o1 said she went into the room where v2o2 was and hit him in the face. V1o1 said it was possible she had hit him with the phone without realizing it. V1o1 said V2o2 then started slapping her in the face. After a short scuffle ensued, v1o1 said she left the room and called the Police.

I then spoke to v2o2 who confirmed that v1o1 had seen text messages on his phone to another girl. V2o2 said v1o1 hit him in the face with his phone after seeing the messages, but denied putting his hands on her afterwards. V2o2 showed me the area where he had been hit with the phone near his right eye. There was a small bump and a red mark. (see attached photos) V2o2 stated he and v1o1 are "swingers" and they regularly have sexual relationships with other people. V1o1 confirmed this, but said the girl who he had been texting was someone he knew that she did not want him seeing.

Both parties stated that this was the extent of the disagreement they had.

V1o1 was placed under arrest and transported to Middletown Police headquarters where she was read her rights, fingerprinted, and processed. V1o1 was charged with Assault 3rd degree (53a-61) and released on a \$1,000 non-surety bond pending her appearance in court at GA9 on February 06, 2017 at 0900 hours.

Upon arrival I spoke to Victim 1/Offender 1 (v1o1) who stated she had been attacked by her husband Victim 2/Offender 2 (v2o2) over a disagreement they had about cheating. V1o1 stated she had found text messages on his phone between him and another girl he was not supposed to be talking to. When she found the messages, v1o1 said she went into the room where v2o2 was and hit him in the face. V1o1 said it was possible she had hit him with the phone without realizing it. V1o1 said V2o2 then started slapping her in the face. After a short scuffle ensued, v1o1 said she left the room and called the Police.


I then spoke to v2o2 who confirmed that v1o1 had seen text messages on his phone to another girl. V2o2 said v1o1 hit him in the face with his phone after seeing the messages, but denied putting his hands on her afterwards. V2o2 showed me the area where he had been hit with the phone near his right eye. There was a small bump and a red mark. (see attached photos) V2o2 stated he and v1o1 are "swingers" and they regularly have sexual relationships with other people. V1o1 confirmed this, but said the girl who he had been texting was someone he knew that she did not want him seeing.

Both parties stated that this was the extent of the disagreement they had.

V2o2 was issued misdemeanor summons #380250 by Officer Austin Smith charging him with Disorderly Conduct (53a-182). V2o2 is due to appear in court at GA9 on February 06, 2017 at 0900 hours.


Officer encountered Hewitt as she exited the building and immediately began to question her about the comments. Hewitt stated her was not Hewitt but instead and that she did not know Hewitt. This continued for several minutes until I confirmed her identity through tattoos on her neck. Prior to this


confirmation, Hewitt attempted to run down a hallway away from officers and exit a fire escape. Once she was identified, a warrant was revealed and she was taken into custody.

During the booking process, Hewitt was found to be in possession of 1.8 grams of Heroin, 2 glass pipes used to smoke crack-cocaine containing residue, and a glass smoking pipe used to smoke Marijuana which contained residue. Additionally, an elastic arm band, hypodermic needle and 4 Lidocane medicated patches were found. After Hewitt was advised of and waived her rights, she stated she did not have a prescription for the patches.

Based on this, Hewitt was charged with violating C.G.S. 21a-279a; Possession of Narcotics, 21a-267a; Possession of Drug Paraphernalia; and 53a-167a Interfering with an Officer. She was photographed, fingerprinted and processed under UAR# 8873970. Hewitt was held in lieu of a \$1000 surety bond and placed in holding cell 12 She was assigned a G.A.-9 court appearance date of 2/6/17 at 0900 hours. Nothing further.

## REMARKS

On Monday February 06, 2017 at approximately 0130 hours I was dispatched to 4 Cottage Street for a report of a dispute between a boyfriend and girlfriend in which the boyfriend had taken the girlfriend's vehicle without her permission.

Upon arrival, victim 1 was arriving back at the residence operating her mother's vehicle. Victim 1 stated her boyfriend Alexander Agosto had taken her vehicle without her permission and she had gone to look for him. Victim 1 had not found Agosto and said he had gone on to South Main Street, but she was unsure which direction he had gone. As I was speaking to Victim 1, Officer Stead advised me that Agosto had just come to the lobby of the Police Department. Officer Harmon and Officer Pellegrini went to headquarters to speak to Agosto while I spoke to victim 1.

Victim 1 provided the following sworn written statement detailing the incident:

*"On February 5th or 6th, sometime around midnight, my boyfriend Alexander Agosto was at a super bowl party at his friend's house. He had told me he was going to come over after the game, so I started calling and texting him to see if that was still the plan. Alexander was mad at me because he had heard from his father that I was having a conversation with my ex-boyfriend who I work with. Eventually after arguing*

*about it for a while, he said he didn't want to talk about it. He said he would have left but didn't have a car. I told him I could have picked him up, so he told me to come get him. When I arrived to pick him up, my brother came out and told me Alexander had said not to pick him up. This turned into another argument, but Alexander ended up getting in the car and coming back to my house. We continued to argue as we got out of the car at my house and he grabbed my keys from me which I was holding in my hand. I went to my car to get the spare key that I keep in there, but the door was locked. I then went to the back of the house and came in the back door which is usually unlocked. As I came out the front door to tell Alexander to come inside, he was driving away in my car. He took a right on to Burr Ave and I assumed he continued on to South Main Street. I tried to call him a couple of times but he did not answer. I called the Police to tell them he had taken my car without my permission. I went to look for him using my mother's car but could not find him. I want Alexander arrested for taking and using my vehicle without my permission. Alexander does not ever drive my car for any reason".*

I was able to verify through dispatch that Victim 1 is the owner of the vehicle through the registration and Agosto's name is not involved with the vehicle in any way.

I asked Victim 1 if the incident had become physical and she said that at no point during their arguing had they gotten physical with each other. Victim 1 said the closest they came to becoming physical was when he grabbed the keys out of her hand. Victim 1 said the arguing has become a regular thing and was the reason that approximately 3 weeks earlier Agosto had moved out of her house and went to stay with his grandparents in Newington, CT.

After speaking to Officer Harmon, he confirmed that Agosto had in fact taken the vehicle and driven to the Police Department in an effort to make a cross complaint against victim 1. Agosto was placed under arrest and relocated to the booking area of the Police department where he was read his rights, fingerprinted, and processed by Officer Harmon and Officer Pellegrini.

Agosto was charged with Using a Motor Vehicle Without The Owner's Permission (53a-119b) and released on a \$2,000 non-surety bond pending his appearance in court at GA9 on February 06, 2017 at 0900 hours.

Agosto was issued a conditions of release order which is in effect until his court date.

I returned to headquarters where I spoke to Agosto. Agosto admitted that he knew he should not have taken the vehicle without victim 1's permission. Agosto confirmed the majority of victim 1's story, but stated the main reason they were arguing was because victim 1 had found out there was a girl at the party she did not like him being around. Agosto stated he had fallen asleep and when he woke up, the girl was laying next to him with her butt against him, even though he had not asked her to do that. Agosto stated he had admitted this to victim 1 and she had gotten upset with him.

While speaking to Officer Harmon, Agosto had stated he had a bag of items with him, including his wallet, a bottle of oxycodone, and his cell phone. Agosto said the oxycodone was for his knee which he had injured in a work related incident. Agosto stated at first he thought his phone was missing, but he had located it inside the vehicle after taking it. According to Agosto, victim 1 had taken his bag from him at her house and was throwing his pills all over her driveway. Agosto stated victim 1 also took his wallet and threw it in a bush in front of a house on Burr Avenue. Agosto stated the pill bottle also should have been there. This information was relayed to me when I was initially speaking to victim 1 so I inspected the driveway and did not recover and pills. I also could not find Agosto's wallet while scanning the bushes in the area. I did not find it reasonable to conclude that victim 1 could have cleaned up the pills from the driveway prior to our arrival at the house, especially since she had left in her mother's car to look for him shortly after he had left. Officer D'Aresta assisted me in looking for the pills and wallet utilizing his K9 Hunter who is trained in article

recovery. Officer D'Aresta stated he had not located any pills in the driveway and did not locate a wallet after searching through numerous bushes and yards in the area. I was unable to find sufficient evidence to prove that victim 1 had thrown Agosto's belongings. Agosto also stated victim 1 had bitten him on his arm, but there were no marks on the area he had pointed out. Victim 1 had previously denied any physical contact between the two of them.
