REMARKS

On 12/29/16 at approximately 1635 hours I responded to 416 East Main Street (Stop and Shop) for a report of a shoplifter. Dispatch advised me Asset Protection had the suspect in custody and the party was cooperative.

Upon arrival I spoke with . She stated while working as an asset protection detective for Stop and Shop she observed a white female, wearing a brown jacket and black pants exit the store on the produce side of the building with a carriage of unbagged groceries.

stated she and Store Manager, , approached the female at her vehicle, where she was bagging the groceries. She stated when she asked for a receipt, the female admitted to not paying. According to all merchandise was recovered. The merchandise totalled \$75.36. She stated Stop and Shop would like to press charges and wanted the party trespassed from the property. She provided a sworn written statement.

The female was identified as Jennifer Bergstrom.

I spoke with Bergstrom. She stated she was "loopy" from taking her medication. Bergstrom stated she did not pay for the merchandise, but would have realized that she did not pay when she got home.

Bergstrom was issued MSC# MC 379961 for Larceny in the 6th degree. She was issued a court date of 1/12/17 at GA09 in Middletown and released on a PTA.

REMARKS

On Tuesday 01-10-2017, at approximately 1420 hours Sgt. Yepes was conducting surveillance in the area of Main Street and Ferry Street. This is a high crime area with numerous documented incidents of narcotics related arrests. The narcotics unit has received information that drug sales are occurring in this area from arrested persons, concerned citizens and confidential informants.

Sgt. Yepes observed a black male walking on the sidewalk at the intersection of Main Street and Ferry Street. The black male met up with a group of males and females at the corner and they started talking. Sgt. Yepes then observed as a Hispanic male reached into his jacket pocket and pulled out a plastic container and took off the top of the container. The black male walked closer, leaned in, and appeared to smell the container. The Hispanic male then put the container back into his jacket pocket and the black male and the Hispanic male walked towards a vehicle. The Hispanic male went into the vehicle and then came back out quickly and met with the awaiting black male. Sgt. Yepes observed as the Hispanic male handed the black male an item suspected to be narcotics. The black male then handed the Hispanic male something which was suspected to be money. Once the suspected narcotic transaction was made the black male left and got into an awaiting vehicle up the street bearing CT registration marker 2AUUX4 being operated by a white female. The Hispanic male walked away from the area and back to the group he was with earlier.

Due to Sgt. Yepes observations of a possible narcotic transaction he contacted Detective Peck and I, and told us what he observed. Detective Peck and I (Detective Lathrop) were parked close by in an unmarked MPD Police vehicle. Sgt. Yepes told us the above vehicle (which he was following) was now parking at Aresco's Market on Liberty Street. The same black male and white female got out of the vehicle and went inside the market. A short time later they exited the market and the black male got in the driver's seat and the white female got into the passenger seat. The vehicle pulled away from the market and began to travel W/B on Liberty Street. As it got to the intersection of Liberty Street and High Street Detective Peck and I were in sight of the vehicle. The vehicle did not make a complete stop at the intersection of Liberty Street and High Street at the stop sign. That intersection is a four way stop which is controlled by stop signs. The vehicle then continued W/B on Liberty Street where I decided to activate our emergency lights and siren to initiate a motor vehicle stop of the above vehicle.

The vehicle came to a stop near the intersection of Liberty Street and Park Place. I approached the vehicle on the driver side and Detective Peck approached on the passenger side. The operator was identified as Craig D. Haynes from his State of Texas ID card. I instructed Haynes to step out of the vehicle. I conducted a pat down of Haynes for weapons and contraband. While doing so Haynes stated he had some marijuana in his front jacket pocket. I asked him where he got the marijuana and he stated he had just bought it on Main Street from a guy. I asked Haynes who the guy was that sold him the marijuana and he refused to answer. I located a purple latex glove in his front jacket pocket where Haynes said the marijuana was. I secured the latex glove and I could feel what I believed was suspected marijuana inside the glove from my training and experience. I placed Haynes in handcuffs which were double locked and checked for tightness. I advised Haynes he was being detained while I finished his pat down and conducted a search of the vehicle. A further pat down search of Haynes was performed which revealed 16 bags of suspected heroin in the same front jacket pocket. These bags all had the stamp "Dubai" in grey/black letters. I asked Haynes about the suspected heroin and he stated he forgot it was there.

I asked Haynes if he had anymore illegal narcotics or weapons on his person or in the vehicle. Haynes stated there was one pill, an oxycodone on the floor of the vehicle on the passenger side. Detective Peck had previously located the pill which was seized and secured in our vehicle.

The suspected heroin, marijuana, and the oxycodone pill were all secured and transported to MPD headquarters.

Haynes was advised of his Miranda rights and was transported to headquarters by a marked MPD vehicle. Once back at MPD headquarters Detective Peck began the booking process of Haynes in the booking area. Haynes was still handcuffed in the booking area and Haynes admitted to Detective Peck he had another 50 bags of suspected heroin in his left shoe. These suspected bags of heroin had the same stamp of "Dubai" in grey/black letters.

Detective Lemieux tested the suspected heroin which was seized from Haynes pocket and shoe using NARK kit 10003 which tested positive for heroin. The street value of the heroin sold at \$10.00 per bag gives it a value of \$660.00.

The amount of heroin seized during this incident is far more than a user would have in their possession, but is rather indicative of an individual that is selling amounts of heroin.

The suspected marijuana was tested by Detective Lemieux. The marijuana tested positive for the presumptive presence of THC using NARK 8. The marijuana weighed 3.7 grams on the department issued digital scale.

Detective Peck confirmed with the drugs.com pill identifier that the pill located in the vehicle was in fact Oxycodone 5mg. Detective Peck has utilized this method of identification on numerous narcotic pill related drug investigations. Oxycodone hydrochloride is classified as a Schedule 2 controlled substance under the controlled substance act (CSA). It has a high potential for abuse and is available by prescription only.

Haynes was charged in violation of C.G.S. 21a-279(a)(1) Possession of Narcotics (2 counts), 21a-279aa1 Possession of under half ounce of Marijuana, 21a-278(b) Possession of Narcotics with Intent to Sell, 14-301 Stop sign Violation, and 14-36a Operation of a Motor Vehicle Without a License.

Haynes was placed in a cell in the MPD lockup area and held on a \$50,000 surety bond and issued a court date of 01-11-2017 at GA-09.

A records check of Haynes revealed 40 prior arrests with several convictions of, narcotics possession, marijuana possession, larceny, assaults, sexual assault, probation violation, interfering/resisting, failure to appear, robbery, burglary, disorderly conduct, and criminal mischief.
