



## REMARKS

On 01/12/2017 at approximately 0924hrs I was dispatched to the parking lot of 416 East Main Street for the report of suspicious activity. The caller, stated that an older white male attempted to open the drivers side door of her vehicle while she was in it. stated that the male who she described as wearing blue jeans, green jacket and knit cap walked away through the parking lot towards Rent-A-Center after unsuccessfully opening the door.

The male was located in the parking lot a short time later on the sidewalk between Bob's and Marshall's after he was pointed out by the complainant.

Officer Kraeger made contact with the accused who I immediately knew as Sebastian Augeri who I have had numerous dealings with in the past. Augeri who I know has mental issues but is for the most part harmless, stated that he never touched the ladies vehicle and he was just walking to Stop and Shop for a cup of coffee. Augeri continuously denied approaching the women in her car. It is believed that Augeri who I have known in the past to ask people for loose change was attempting to do just that but he denied it which he normally does.

Officer Kraeger took a sworn written statement from the complainant, who requested an arrest of Augeri. stated that Augeri approached her vehicle which was parked in a handicapped parking stall in front of the Bob's store and she became nervous. stated that she locked her doors at which time Augeri grabbed the drivers side handle and attempted to open it 4 or 5 times.


tated that she told the male "go, just go!" She then dialed "911" and Augeri walked away through the parking lot towards Rent-A-Center. She said that Augeri never said anything to her while attempting to open the door.

I checked for CCTV that may have been recording the parking stalls where the incident occurred with negative results.

Augeri was issued MSC #MC397342 for Breach of Peace (53a-181) and given a court date of 01/25/2017. A check through dispatch showed no outstanding warrants or orders for Augeri.

### REMARKS

On 1/10/2016, at approximately 2200 hours, Detective Lemieux and I were traveling southbound on Main Street, approaching Hartford Avenue. I observed a white Infinity G35, bearing CT registration 0ALBH8, traveling directly in front of our unmarked police vehicle. The Infinity failed to stop at the steady red traffic control at the intersection of Main Street and Hartford Avenue and made a right onto Hartford Avenue in violation of CGS14-299. I activated our emergency lights and siren as the Infinity turned left onto St. Johns Street. The Infinity rapidly increased it rapidly increased its speed and failed to obey or signal to stop. I could see that the vehicle was occupied by four people (the left rear passenger later identified as Jeremy Adams). I could see the front passenger and Adams moving in the passenger compartment. It appeared they were attempting to retrieve a weapon or hide contraband. The vehicle reached 45 mph in a 25 mph zone. After approximately 100 yards the vehicle rapidly decelerated and stopped.

Once backup units arrived we had the occupants exit the vehicle. I know the front passenger from prior law enforcement interactions and have personally arrested for sale of narcotics. Given the movement inside of the vehicle and passengers history all of the parties were detained. The driver was found to be in possession of a crack pipe.

Detectives searched the vehicle and in the center console Detective Peck found 10 wax paper bags, each containing suspected heroin in a powder form. I was able to identify the heroin through my training and experience. Adams told us


that the heroin belonged to him. Adams gave a sworn written at the scene that the heroin was his.

Detective Peck tested the suspected heroin with NARK 3 reagent and it tested positive for presumptive presence of heroin. The burnt crack cocaine residue tested positive for the presence of cocaine with a NIK wipe.


Adams was transported to the Middletown Police Department where he was processed, fingerprinted and photographed.

Adams was released on a \$25,000 non-surety bond. He is scheduled to appear at GA-9 in Middletown on 1/24/2017 at 0900 hours for violation of CGS 21a-279(a)(1) Possession of Heroin.

I could see that the vehicle was occupied by four people (the driver later identified as Thomas Freeman). I could see the front passenger and the left rear passenger moving in the passenger

compartment. It appeared they were attempting to retrieve a weapon or hide contraband. The vehicle reached 45 mph in a 25 mph zone. After approximately 100 yards the vehicle rapidly decelerated and stopped.


Once backup units arrived we had the occupants exit the vehicle. I know the front passenger from prior law enforcement interactions and have personally arrested for sale of narcotics. Given the movement inside of the vehicle and passengers history all of the parties were detained. As Officer Remotti was patting down Freeman a glass pipe commonly used to smoke crack cocaine fell out of his right coat pocket on the ground. I was able to identify the pipe through my training and experience. The other occupants were patted down with negative results. Ten bags of heroin were found in the center console that the left rear passenger said belonged to him.

Detective Peck tested the suspected heroin with NARK 3 reagent and it tested positive for presumptive presence of heroin. The burnt crack cocaine residue tested positive for the presence of cocaine with a NIK wipe.

Freeman was transported to the Middletown Police Department where he was processed, fingerprinted and photographed.

Freeman was released on a \$2,500 non-surety bond. He is scheduled to appear at GA-9 in Middletown on 1/24/2017 at 0900 hours for violation of CGS 21a-267(a) Possession of Drug Paraphernalia, 14-218a\* Traveling Unreasonably Fast, and 14-299 Failure to Obey Traffic Signal.


