



**REMARKS**

On 9/18/16 at approximately 1830hrs I (Officer Wasilewski) attempted to conduct a motor vehicle stop on a maroon Mazda 626 (bearing CT registration 565ZUP) which was traveling southbound don South Main

Street. I had just witnessed the operator of the vehicle park at the Gulf gas station on South Main Street. After traveling southbound, the vehicle pulled into the parking lot of Subway on South Main Street. The Mazda immediately accelerate northbound at a high rate of speed through the parking lot. As the Mazda was traveling northbound through the parking lot adjacent to South Main Street, I was traveling south preparing to make the same left turn into the parking lot. At that point I was able to get a view of the operators face. The white male operator appeared in his mid-thirties wearing a white shirt with a goatee for facial hair.

I followed the vehicle northbound and activated my emergency lights and siren. The vehicle continued northbound at a high rate of speed which I estimated to be 65mph. The vehicle then crossed over the double yellow line and continued through a solid red light in the area of South Main Street and Warwick Street. I followed the vehicle with my emergency lights and siren still activated as it continued northbound. I observed the Mazda turn right (eastbound) onto the Route 9 connector ramp. The vehicle however proceeded eastbound down the off ramp onto oncoming vehicles traveling westbound which were exiting Route 9. I radioed to central dispatch that I was shutting off my lights and breaking off my attempt to stop the vehicle. I continued down the parallel onramp to ensure the Mazda did not collide head on into any vehicles and cause a major accident. Prior to losing sight of the Mazda where the onramp/offramp splits north and south, I observed the Mazda continue at a high rate of speed down the wrong way nearly missing 3 vehicles. The vehicles traveling westbound on the offramp were making emergency maneuvers to avoid high speed head on collisions. I radioed to central dispatch that the vehicle was causing a severe risk to oncoming vehicles and almost colliding head on with several of them. Sergeant Bartolotta then radioed to central dispatch to have any available Officer close down Route 9 southbound at the downtown exits of 15 & 16 to prevent any head on collisions.

I continued onto Route 9 northbound and observed the vehicle traveling at a high rate of speed northbound in the southbound lanes toward exit 14. The Mazda then made an abrupt left turn to take the exit 14 offramp onto DeKoven Drive nearly colliding with a vehicle traveling southbound. I lost sight of the Mazda as it continued southbound on DeKoven Drive toward East Main Street. Throughout the attempt to initiate the traffic stop and after the attempted stop was terminated, the operator was driving at a high rate of speed with no regard for any other vehicles on the road. The operator of the Mazda traveled down the center of the Route 9 Connector making no effort to get out of the vehicles' ways that were traveling in the proper direction, nearly hitting several head on.


On 9/19/16 Detective Laskowski assisted this Officer (Officer Wasilewski) in obtaining the video surveillance footage from the Gulf Gas Station at 339 South Main Street. Detective Laskowski was able to obtain still frame photos as well as video footage showing the white male park the maroon Mazda 626 (bearing CT registration 565ZUP) in front of the Gas Station. The photographs and video show the white male, clearly identifiable as Russell Culver, park in front of the store and exit the vehicle. He walks inside and buys a pack of cigarettes then leaves. He then drives southbound on South Main Street. Approximately a minute later Culver is seen driving northbound on South Main Street at a high rate of speed with a Middletown Police Cruiser following with its emergency lights activated. Detective Laskowski tagged the CD-ROM containing the video footage as evidence and placed it in an evidence locker.

State Police record check of Russell Culver revealed 13 prior arrests ranging from multiple Larceny 3rd, 4th, 5th, 6th, as well as multiple violations of probation, interfering/ resisting, and DUI. Culver was also convicted twice for engaging police in two separate pursuits. One incident occurred in East Hartford on 10/31/2011 and more recently a second conviction on 8/27/2013 in Glastonbury. He was also found to have a suspended license as on 1/14/2015. An in-house photograph of Culver, from a prior arrest in 2011, showed a photograph matching the individual seen in the video footage.

On 1/17/17 at approximately 18:30hrs Officers made contact with Culver at his address of 88 High Street. Culver was subsequently placed under arrest and transported to the Middletown Police Department where

he was read his rights and processed. He is charged with violation of CGS 14-223(b) Engaging Police in a Pursuit, 14-222 Reckless Driving, 14-215 Suspended License, 14-12 Operating and Unregistered Motor Vehicle, 14-232(b) Unsafe Passing, 14-299 Failure to Obey Traffic Signal, 14-238 Improper Entry onto a Controlled Access Highway, and 14-237 Traveling Wrong Way on a Divided Highway. Culver was held on the court set \$1,000 cash bond. He is scheduled to appear at the GA 9 Court House on 1/18/17 at 0900hrs.

Also beside the baggies in the driver door area was a capped clear syringe. I then advised Officer Remotti that Santamaria would also be under arrest.


The four found in Santamaria's driver side door were seized and later brought to the Middletown Police Department where they were tagged as evidence. The powdery substance was tested with a NARK 3 heroin test kit as well as a NARK 33 Fentanyl/Heroin test kit. The contents tested positive for the presumptive presence of heroin. They were tagged as evidence and placed in Middletown evidence locker #3.

Santamaria was transported to the Middletown Police Department where he was read his rights, photographed, fingerprinted, and processed by Officer Remotti. ### REMARKS

On 1-17-17 at 0915 hours, Lt. DeSena, Officers Kraeger, Bloom, and I were dispatched to 1 Russell St #14 for an active domestic assault.

Upon arrival on the scene, Victim/Arrest 1, Victim/Arrest 3, and Victim/Arrest 2 were all in the hallway arguing and screaming at each other. We separated the three. I took Victim/Arrest 1 into the apartment. She stated that her and Victim/Arrest 2 are ex-boyfriend/girlfriend but had dated and resided together for the past three (3) years. She stated that Victim/Arrest 2 had made her get out of bed this morning and had been controlling her for the past three years as well. She stated that an argument had ensued that had carried over from the night before. She stated that during the argument, Victim/Arrest 2 had elbowed her in the left side of the face under her eye. She had redness and swelling there. She stated that Victim/Arrest 3 then came into the apartment and tried to punch her in the face and choke her but Victim/Arrest 2 had pulled him off of her. He then left the apartment and called police.

Victim/Arrest 2 stated that he had told Victim/Arrest 1 to get out of bed because she had to be at court for a domestic arrest with her other ex-boyfriend from the night before. She told him she was getting up until he gave her a cigarette. He stated that the argument ensued from there and she struck him multiple times in the face. Victim/Arrest 3 then came into the apartment and Victim/Arrest 1 punched him in the face as well.

Victim/Arrest 2 had multiple scratches across his face and Victim/Arrest 3 had a red mark and swelling under his right eye.

Victim/Arrest 2 further stated that Victim/Arrest 1 had trashed the apartment throwing a garbage can and all of its contents across the apartment. This was visible at our arrival. He further explained the she and her other ex-boyfriend had a fight on Main St and she was issued a summons for this with court on 1-17-17. He had attempted to give her a ride home to Higganum but she had refused and wound up spending the night at his apartment. All three declined medical attention.


Victim/Arrest 3 stated that he heard a disturbance between Victim/Arrest 2 and Victim/Arrest 1 from apartment #15. He had purchased this condo and is in the process of renovating it. He went into the hallway and Victim/Arrest 1 came out of apartment #14 screaming that Victim/Arrest 3 was going to kill her. He told her to stop and she punched him in the face twice. Officer Bloom obtained a written and sworn statement from Victim/Arrest 3. Victim/Arrest 2 declined to give a statement and Victim/Arrest 1 was too irate and screaming at officers to obtain a statement even though she was asked several times.

As all three were involved in an obvious violent and tumultuous incident where all three sustained minor injuries, and none of them currently reside together, all three were released on the scene on a summons. Victim/Arrest 1 for Assault 3rd and Disorderly Conduct, and Victim/Arrest 2 and Victim/Arrest 3 for Disorderly Conduct all with court dates of 1-18-17 in GA 9.

Victim/Arrest 2 and Victim/Arrest 1 were also issued Conditions of Release Family Violence forms with all boxes. It was explained multiple times that they can have No Contact with each other until their court hearing on 1-18-17. Both agreed and stated that they understood.

Lt. DeSena gave Victim/Arrest 1 a ride to court from the residence and again explained that she could not return. She again stated that she understood.
