REMARKS

On 1/12/2017, at approximately 2141 hours, Officers were dispatched to two calls, one for a single car motor vehicle accident and the other for a male asking for help, in the area of 42 Military Road. On arrival I, Officer Foster, made contact with the male who was identified as Nathaniel Hardesty by his Connecticut Driver's License. The accused admitted to drinking alcoholic beverages earlier in the evening and identified his vehicle, a blue Volks. Jetta, that was located in a grass island. The accused stated that the accident occurred at "9:30pm".

The accused smelt strongly of an alcoholic beverage and was noticeably slurring his words. Suspecting that the accused

was under the influence of drugs or alcohol, I asked Hardesty if he would consent to a field sobriety test. Hardesty stated he would perform the tests. Hardesty was demonstrated and asked if he understood each of the tests which he acknowledged verbally. Hardesty failed to perform the tests to standard.

The sum of all observations from the first contact with Hardesty to the time of arrest supported the probable cause for the arrest of D.U.I Hardesty was placed in handcuffs and was transported to Police headquarters for processing. Hardesty was read his Notice of Rights Form at approximately 2219 hours and at 2224 hours he declined console from an attorney.


I am certified in the Drager Alcotest 9510. The device was checked in accordance with the applicable state regulations.

Hardesty was released on a 500 non-surety bond. Hardesty was issued a Misdemeanor Summons, #MC378269. Hardesty was charged with violation of C.G.S. 14-227a DUI, violation of C.G.S. 14-12(a)* Operating an Unregistered Motor Vehicle, and violation of C.G.S. 14-236 Failure to Maintain Lane. Hardesty scheduled appear in Middlesex Superior Court on January 26, 2017 at 0900 hours. Hardesty's vehicle was towed from the scene by Untouchable Towing. The registration on Hardesty's vehicle had expired on 8/1/2015 according to dispatch.

REMARKS

On Friday 01-13-2017 at approximately 2020 hours Detective Peck and I (Detective Lathrop) were parked on Church Street in an unmarked Middletown Police vehicle. We observed a grey Nissan Altima make a left turn onto Church Street from Hubbard Street and start to proceed towards where we were parked. The grey Altima then stopped in the middle of the road near the intersection of Church Street and Hotchkiss Street and made a slow U turn without signaling in the middle of the road. The U turn the Altima made was over the double yellow line and the Altima then began to travel E/B on Church Street at approximately 5-10mph. Detective Peck and I positioned our unmarked vehicle behind the Altima and began to follow it at the slow speed of 10mph in a 25 mph zone. It was unclear to us at the time if the operator was possibly under the influence or having a medical emergency. Detective Peck activated our emergency lights and siren to initiate a motor vehicle stop of the Altima for the above violations.

We stopped the vehicle for the above violations and identified the operator as Tyquan V. Jackson from his CT operator's

license. The vehicle search was performed due to the interior cabin having a strong odor of burnt marijuana. The search revealed a small baseball bat under the driver side seat.

Jackson submitted to field sobriety tests which he did not perform to the standard. Jackson was placed under arrest for O.U.I and for a weapon in a motor vehicle. Jackson was transported to MPD headquarters for processing

Jackson was read his Notice of Rights at 2110 hours and signed off on them at the same time. I then read Jackson the A-44 Implied Consent Advisory. Jackson was given a chance to contact an attorney at 2112 hours which he declined. I advised Jackson I would be choosing a breath test for him to submit. Jackson stated he would take the tests as requested.

Jackson's first breath test which was taken on the Draeger Alcotest 9510 which I am certified to use was .0798 at 2125 hours. Due to Jackson's first test being under the legal limit I believed he was under the influence of something other than just alcohol, possibly narcotics or marijuana. The observations on scene from his poor driving, the marijuana smell coming from the vehicle, his difficulty of exiting the vehicle and following simple directions, and the poor performance on the SFST's, I decided Jackson's second test would be a urine test.


I advised Jackson I would be switching tests to a urine test for a second sample and he refused to submit a sample.


Jackson was fingerprinted, processed and photographed under UAR# 8873895 and 8873896 in violation of C.G.S. 29-38 Weapon in a Motor Vehicle and 14-227a Operation Under the Influence. Jackson was given a verbal warning for 14-242 U turn without signaling and 14-236 failure to Maintain Lane. Jackson was released on a \$25,000 surety bond and issued a court date of 01-27-2017 at GA-09 at 0900 hours.

Jackson's operator's license was held at MPD headquarters for the required 24 hour hold. Jackson was provided a copy of his Notice of Rights and Criminal Appearance Bond Form.

A DMV records check of Jackson revealed two violations of operating without a license. Jackson is a convicted felon and has 5 prior arrests with convictions of Possession of Marijuana, Sale of Narcotics, Criminal Possession of a Firearm, Possession with Intent to Sell, Disorderly Conduct, Robbery 1st, and Probation Violation.

REMARKS

On 1-17-17 at 1502 hours, Asset Protection Officer I called and stated that there was a W/M wearing a black sweatshirt, blue jeans, and a green hat running out of the door of Stop & Shop with a basket of shrimp that he did not pay for.

I was turning into the parking lot of 416 East Main St, Stop & Shop, at the time. I observed the male with and the store manager behind the suspect. I pulled up and ordered the suspect to stop. He did so without incident. He had taken four (4) bags of shrimp with a value of \$95.92. These were recovered by


The suspect, Pompei, stated that he steals to support his cocaine habit. He stated that he did not have his identification on him and that it was in his vehicle. We walked to his vehicle. I asked if there were any illegal items in the vehicle and he stated that there may be a "stem" (crack pipe). I entered the vehicle on the

driver's side and located his wallet in the center console of the vehicle with his CT driver's license. On the front passenger seat was a clear glass crack pipe with a screen and burnt residue. I seized this as evidence. No other illegal items were located.


As there was no issue, Pompei was released on the scene on an MSC for Larceny 6th and Possession of Drug Paraphernalia with a court date of 2-1-17 in GA 9. He was also advised, at the behest of Stop & Shop, that he is no longer allowed on the property of 416 East Main St and that if he returns, he will be arrested for Trespassing. Pompei stated that he understood.

Officer Bloom obtained a written and sworn statement from [redacted] along with a video of the incident. The crack pipe was placed into property as evidence.

REMARKS

On 1-18-17 at 1526 hours, I observed Mr. Allick operating CT registration 536-ZXL, a gray 4 door 2004 Nissan Altima, S/B on Main St Ext at Mill St with no front plate.

A records check showed that the vehicle registration had expired on 4-26-15. I stopped the vehicle on Saybrook Rd at Clew Ave. The operator and sole occupant of the vehicle, Mr. Allick, stated that the vehicle belongs to his and his wife, . He stated that he was aware that the vehicle was not registered and that it was not insured either. The records check also showed that the vehicle emissions had

expired on 4-25-14. Mr. Allick stated that he was only driving the vehicle in order to pick up his son.

Mr. Allick was released on the scene on an MSC for Operating A Motor Vehicle Without Insurance, Operating An Unregistered Motor Vehicle, and Emissions Violation with a court date of 2-8-17 in GA 9. The vehicle was parked on private property to be recovered at a later date.

REMARKS

On Thursday 01/19/2017 from approximately 1030 hours through 1300 hours, Sgt. Yepes was conducting surveillance in the area of the 400-500 block of Main St. This area is known to Detectives, due to previous investigations, as well as numerous recent neighbor complaints to have a significant amount of drug activity including sales and usage.

Sgt. Yepes observed a Black Toyota Camry bearing CT Reg 619 SJU parked on Main St. for several hours. The vehicle had dark tinted windows making it difficult to see the interior in violation of CGS 14-99(g).

Sgt. Yepes has recently received numerous complaints that a black male operating a similar vehicle has been selling narcotics throughout the North End of Main St.

At approximately 1300 hours, Sgt. Yepes observed a black male, who he positively identified from previous law enforcement interactions as Alan Kelley approach the vehicle and linger in the area. After speaking on the phone for several minutes the individual entered the driver side and began to pull away.

The operator began travelling N/B on Main St. He then turned onto Hartford Ave. and began traveling towards the Route 9 on ramp. Sgt Yepes advised me of the operator's location and direction of travel.

I located the vehicle as it was pulling onto Route 9 N/B and attempted to position my unmarked Police vehicle behind it. When the roadway was clear I positioned myself behind the Toyota and initiated a motor vehicle stop by activating my emergency lights and siren.

I activated my lights and siren as we passing Exit 18, however, the operator of the vehicle continued travelling at highway speed in the left lane for several hundred yards. He eventually moved to the right lane and began to slow after travelling approximately 1/8th of a mile.

Upon making contact with the occupants of the vehicle, the operator was identified by his CT Operators License as Alan Kelley and the passenger was identified as ARRESTED PARTY 2 (AP2).

It should be noted that I am familiar with Kelley from numerous Police interactions and have been involved in past investigations regarding him selling illegal narcotics.

I asked Kelley why he did not move to the right and pull over when I activated my lights and he mumbled unintelligibly. I advised Kelley that I had stopped him for the dark tinted windows, Kelley stated that he had borrowed the vehicle from a friend and "that's the way it came." I advised Kelley that as the operator of the vehicle he was responsible to ensure it was being legally operated on the road.

Due to the past knowledge of Kelley's narcotics history in conjunction with his failure to stop when signaled I asked him to exit the vehicle. I asked him if there was anything on his person or in the vehicle that he shouldn't have. Kelley responded that there was not.

I then patted him down for weapons. As I slid my hand over his right pocket, I could clearly feel numerous small round lumps inside. I immediately suspected these small lumps to be pills and asked Kelley if there were pills in his pocket. Kelley responded that there were. When asked what they were, Kelly responded that they were "Oxy's"

As a Narcotics Detective I am aware that all prescription narcotics must remain in their prescribed bottles containing the

patient's name. I advised Kelley of this information and removed the loose pills from his pocket.

The (6) pills removed from Kelley pocket were small round green pills imprinted with "A 214". They were later identified, through Drugs.com/Pill Identifier, as Oxycodone Hydrochloride 15mg, a schedule 2 narcotic controlled substance with a high risk for abuse.

Kelley was secured in handcuffs and advised that he was being detained. A search of his person revealed \$100.00 US currency in his right pocket, no further contraband was located on his person, at the scene.

I began searching the interior of the vehicle and contacted Off. Schreiner and his K9 partner, Otto, to respond to the scene. Prior to their arrival, I located an empty Alprazolam 1mg prescription bottle, prescribed to Alan Kelly, in the center console. The prescription had been filled earlier in the day, 01/19/2017, but was completely empty. When asked about the prescription, Kelley stated that an unknown person had entered his vehicle and taken the pills and the returned the empty script bottle. It should be noted that Sgt. Yepes had been watching the vehicle continuously throughout the day and the only people near his vehicle was him and AP2.

It should be noted that Alprazolam is a schedule 4 Benzodiazapine controlled substance with a potential for abuse.

In the center console I located a cut straw containing a white residue.

Off. Schreiner and Otto conducted a search of the interior of the vehicle. Inside the driver door pocket Off. Schreiner located a small wax fold containing a granular residue suspected to be heroin. On the floor under the driver seat, Off. Schreiner located a cut straw with a white residue.

No additional items were located.

AP2 and Kelley were advised that they were under arrest and transported to Middletown Police Headquarters. The Toyota was towed from the scene by Personal Automotive. The registered owner has been advised of the location of his vehicle.

All items listed above were transported to Middletown Police Department and tagged as evidence. The crack cocaine was tested and weighed by Det. Lemieux. On a department scale it weighed .1 grams and tested positive for the presence of cocaine with NARK Kit 13. The items were secured in an evidence locker.

A check of Kelley's prescription history showed numerous dates and prescriptions, however, none of the prescriptions were for Oxycodone Hydrochloride 15mg.

Alan Kelley's history showed he a convicted felon, currently on probation with previous convictions for; Possession of Drug Paraphernalia (multiple convictions), Possession with Intent, Possession of Narcotics, Sale of Hallucinogen/Narcotics (multiple convictions), Failure to Appear 2nd (multiple convictions), Breach of Peace (multiple convictions), Probation Violation, Burglary 3rd, Criminal Trespass 1st, Possession of Drugs/Marijuana, Interfering with Search.

Upon arrival at Headquarters, they were both advised of their rights fingerprinted and processed.

Alan Kelley was charged with violations of; CGS 21a-257 – Illegal Storage of Narcotics, CGS 21a-267(a) – Possession of Drug Paraphernalia, CGS 21a-279(a)(1) – Possession of Narcotics, CGS 21a-278(a)+ - Possession with Intent to Sell, 21a-279(a)(a)(1) – Possession under ½ ounce Marijuana. He was held on \$25,000.00 surety bond and issued a court date at Middletown Superior Court on 01/20/2017 at 0900 hours.


MS. LUSSIER was processed for her arrest and released from police custody after posting a \$30,000 surety (court set) bond.

REMARKS

DOMESTIC

On 1/19/2017, at approximately 2032 hours I, Officer Foster, was dispatched to an undisclosed address in Middletown on the report of a physical domestic actively taking place. On arrival, I determined that a physical domestic had taken place between a boyfriend and girlfriend. There were two juvenile children present (15 y/o and 10y/o) during the assault and witnessed the events. The victim in this case "Victim #1" had noticeable bruising on her face and upper right brow. Upon further investigation, it was determined that the accused, Marlix Arroyo, had assaulted Victim #1 in their bedroom by striking her in the face with closed fists. The juvenile children attempted to intervene but were not successful from stopping Arroyo from assaulting their mother. One of the juveniles was able to call 911 from her phone but it was quickly ripped away from her during the emergency call. Sworn written statements were given by both Victim #1 and Juvenile #1.

Based on testimony made by all parties involved and the physical evidence observed on scene, the probable cause was sought for the arrest of Arroyo. Arroyo was placed in handcuffs and was transported to Middletown Police HQ for processing. It was determined that Victim #1 acted in self-defense which resulted in minor injury to Arroyo's arm.

Arroyo was charged with violation of C.G.S. 53a-61 Assault 3rd, two counts of violation of C.G.S. 53-21 Risk of Injury to a Minor, violation of C.G.S. 53a-183b Interfering with an Emergency Call, and violation of C.G.S. 53a-182 Disorderly Conduct. Arroyo was held on a \$50,000 surety bond and will appear in Middlesex Superior Court on January 20, 2017 at 0900 hours.
