REMARKS

On 1-20-2017 Det Dirga and I (Det Lemieux) were traveling east on Hillside Avenue behind the vehicle bearing CT registration AD11583. When the vehicle stopped at the intersection of Clew Dr and Saybrook Rd, I observed the right stop lamp was inoperable and there was no light illuminating the rear registration plate in violation of CGS 14-96e(a) and 14-96c(c). The vehicle turned south onto Saybrook Rd and began driving at a very high rate of speed in violation of CGS 14-218a.


I activated my emergency lights and siren and noticed the operator (referred to as arrested party 1 or AP1) and passenger (later identified as Jordan Robinson) began moving about the vehicle. I could see their bodies raising and lowering in their seats and their arms moving about the passenger compartment.


Upon approaching the vehicle I made contact with AP1 whose hands were down near his crotch. He was looking straight down at his crotch. I opened the door due to the furtive movements I observed as I was stopping the vehicle. When I did so I immediately smelled the overwhelming odor of marijuana coming from the vehicles interior.

When Robinson opened the passenger door he had loose suspected marijuana all over his lap. Det Dirga had him exit the vehicle and began searching Robinson. During the search, Robinson was pushing his crotch area against the vehicle. Dirga had to pull him away from the vehicle in order to properly search him, which led to the discovery of three bags of marijuana in the front of his pants (later found to weigh a total of 2.29 ounces). Robinson was also found to be in possession of \$239.00 in cash. Det Dirga and Det Peck began searching the vehicle and located a digital scale and a box of plastic sandwich bags in the center console. The box of bags was similar to the ones used to package the marijuana we located. I know from my training and experience as a Narcotics Detective individuals who sell marijuana and other drugs will buy a large quantity of marijuana and divide it into smaller amounts to increase profits. The marijuana is often packaged in plastic bags such as the ones we located in the vehicle. They also located two plastic bags containing marijuana residue in the vehicle. In the ash tray, they located numerous partially smoked marijuana cigars (total combined weight of 3.3 grams). It was clear to us on scene that with the amount of marijuana in possession of both AP1 and Robinson (2.77 ounces combined) along with the scale and the packaging material they are directly involved in the sale of marijuana. The amount they were in possession of is far more than a typical user would be in possession of with a total street value of \$1,570.00 if sold at \$20.00 per gram. Both AP1 and Robinson were transported to the Middletown Police Department for processing.

Jordan Robinson was charged with 53a-167a interfering with police, 21a-277(b)+ possession with intent to sell, 21a-267(a) possession of drug paraphernalia and 21a-279(a)(1) possession of a controlled substance on UAR 8873925. He was given a court date 1-23-2017 and held on a \$50,000.00 surety bond. Robinson's : shows one pending case for 53a-167a interfering and 21a-279(a)(1) possession of a controlled substance.

The bag of suspected marijuana in Robinson's possession was testing by Det Peck using NARK kit #9 revealing a red / orange color indicative of the presence of marijuana / THC. Det Peck has been trained in the use of narcotic test kits and has used them during numerous narcotic investigations in the past. The total weight of the three bags was 2.29 ounces and was weighed on a department scale.

I activated my emergency lights and siren and noticed the operator (later identified as Michael Overton) and passenger (referred to as arrested party 2 or AP2) began moving about the vehicle. I could see their bodies raising and lowering in their seats and their arms moving about the passenger compartment.

Upon approaching the vehicle I made contact with Overton whose hands were down near his crotch. He was looking straight down at his crotch. I opened the door due to the furtive movements I observed as I was stopping the vehicle.

When I did so I immediately smelled the overwhelming odor of marijuana coming from the vehicles interior. I asked Overton to step out of the vehicle and he reached for his phone and remained seated. I asked again and he still did not move. At that point I took the phone out of his hands and placed it on the dashboard. I told him again to step out of the vehicle and go to the rear. He stopped when he exited and did not go to the rear as I requested. Overton was not following instructions so at this point he was placed in handcuffs.


I asked Overton if he had any marijuana on his person or in his vehicle and he said no. I began searching Overton and when I reached his crotch area I felt a large lump which was not consistent with the male anatomy. When I ran my hand over the area the object made a crunching sound and was lumpy. I was immediately able to identify the object as a bag of marijuana from my training and experience. I asked Overton if it was marijuana and he said yes. The bag was removed and later found to weigh .48 ounces.

Det Dirga searched AP2 revealing 2.27 ounces of suspected marijuana. Det Dirga and Det Peck began searching the vehicle and located a digital scale and a box of plastic sandwich bags in the center console. The box of bags was similar to the ones used to package the marijuana we located. I know from my training and experience as a Narcotics Detective individuals who sell marijuana and other drugs will buy a large quantity of marijuana and divide it into smaller amounts to increase profits. The marijuana is often packaged in plastic bags such as the ones we located in the vehicle. They also located two plastic bags containing marijuana residue in the vehicle. In the ash tray, they located numerous partially smoked marijuana cigars (total combined weight of 3.3 grams). Overton was also charged with 14-96e improper signal lam, 14-218a* traveling too fast for conditions and 14-96c improper stop lamps on UAR 8873927. He was given a court date of 1-23-2017 at GA-09 in Middletown and held on a \$50,000.00 surety bond. Overton does not currently have an

I picked the bag up and noticed a greeting card inside which also contained a broken glass candle. V1 said that Shawnay broke that also, which was a gift for someone. V1 said that Shawnay just left.

Witness said that Shawnay was yelling at her mother and calling her a "bitch." Witness saw Shawnay

throwing things and braking the candle.

Shawnay arrived at police headquarters with her father about an hour later. Shawnay admitted to cursing at her mother and admitted to breaking the glass candle. Shawnay said that she did it because she was offended after she overheard her mother talking to witness about her.

Shawnay was issued an MSC for disorderly conduct, 53a-182. She was assigned a court date of 01/23/17 to appear at GA9 at 0900 hours. Prior to being released, she was issued a Condition of Release pursuant to CGS 54-63c. Shawnay was advised not to have any contact with her mother until after her court appearance.
