REMARKS

On 01/11/2017 at approximately 1225 hours I, Officer Kraeger and Officer Gagne were on Grand Street near the intersection of Grand and Pearl Street at which time I could hear a motor vehicle revving its engine very loudly, squealing its tires.

I looked West bound towards the above stated intersection and observed a 4 door gray in color vehicle traveling at a high rate of speed South on Pearl Street. The vehicle approached the above intersection barely slowed down for the stop sign and continued South on Pearl Street.

I entered my vehicle and made a left turn from Grand Street onto Pearl Street and did not observe the vehicle on Pearl Street. I then mad a right turn onto Liberty Street from Pearl Street and was immediately flagged down by a pedestrian who was yelling, "that guy in the gray car almost hit me and I had to jump out of the way".

I traveled West on Liberty Street at which time I observed the gray vehicle in the parking lot of Aresco's market on Liberty Street.

I observed a black male exit the vehicle who would be identified as Frank Clegg. I and Officer Gagne approached Clegg who was standing out front of Aresco's market. A DMV records check indicated that his CT drivers license #226429919 was currently suspended. Suspension date 11/02/2016.

Clegg was issued a MSC in the field #MC397237 and charged with Operation of a motor vehicle under suspension 14-215, Reckless Driving 14-222 and given a court date of 02/01/2017 at GA-09.

REMARKS

On the above date and time, I, Middletown Police Officers were dispatched to Verizon Wireless at 955 Washington Street for the report of a potential fraud taking place. The caller advised Dispatch that a male wearing all black, with black and white sneakers was presenting an ID in a different name than one he had used on 12/30/16 when he'd made a purchase in the same store, with the same clerk.

The first Officer's on scene advised they were out with the suspect and a second male, operating a FL registered Nissan in the parking lot of the Verizon store. The vehicle was later confirmed to be rented by the operator, Trevor Coburn (26).

During the investigation it was discovered that Coburn, identified via his New York Driver's License (from New York had been waiting for his friend (unknown last name) while he shopped in the Verizon store. When asked if was also from New York, Coburn said no, he was from

"around here". Coburn had no explanation as to why the two of them were in Middletown and denied knowing that _____ was trying to purchase a \$969.99 I-Phone. Coburn said he'd given _____ his wallet, but didn't explain why.

It should be noted that it is common for suspects to come out of state from New York with out-of-state identification to purchase high value/ticket items such as cellular phones using stolen or fraudulent credit cards. That often suspects will rent cars and drive around the state making fraudulent purchases which are not discovered as such until weeks afterwards.

During the Officer's investigation, it was established that " _____ " was actually _____ 26) out of New York. A criminal records check revealed Coburn has a prior arrest and conviction history out of New York State for Counterfeit Credit Card Use.

Coburn was also arrested and transported headquarters for processing on the charges of Conspiracy to Commit Larceny in the 5th Degree in violation of CGS 53a-48/125a. The accused was released on a twenty five hundred dollar non-surety bond and assigned a court date of Monday, 01/30/17, 0900 hours at GA9 Middletown.

REMARKS

On Monday, January, 23rd, 2017, at 6:15 p.m., Officer Wasilewski and I, were dispatched to Middlesex Hospital Emergency Department located at 28 Crescent St., Middletown on a past domestic. The accused, Shawn M. Waite, resides with victim, roommates.

Victim said that on this date at around 5:30 p.m, the Mr. Waite pushed him against the living room wall after he was upset with him. Mr. Waite grabbed victim a second time and pushed him backward out the front door and he landed on his back on the concrete porch. Victim complained of right elbow and left hip pain as a result of being pushed.

Victim was diagnosed with a contusion to his right elbow and left hip. He was prescribed Motrin and rest. This officer went to the residence in an attempt to interview Mr. Waite, but he was not home. Victim's son was home. He said that he heard a commotion and when he went upstairs, he saw Mr. Waite pushing victim out the front door.

I contacted the Mr. Waite by phone. He agreed to meet me at police headquarters to be interviewed. Mr. Waite said that he didn't pushed victim that he placed his hand on the victim's chest and began escorting him out because he was smoking in the house. I informed Mr. Waite that victim's inquiries are consistent

with a struggle.

Offender was advised that he was being placed under arrest. He was issued an MSC for the charge of assault in the third degree, 53a-61. He was assigned a court date of 01/24/17 to appear at GA9 at 0900 hours. Prior to being released, he was issued a Condition of Release Family Violence form pursuant to CGS 54-63c. He was advised that he's to have no contact with the victim until after his court appearance.

Case closed by arrest.

On 1/23/17 at 2233 hours, I, Officer Remotti responded to 1 Labela Circle 2nd Floor which is housing shelter, for a intoxicated male causing a disturbance and being confrontational toward another resident. This was the second time responding to the address for the party within 2 hours.

Upon arrival, I interviewed the male victim identified as _____ who stated Charles Mishler was banging and kicking his door trying to force his way into him room. Mr. Mishler was questioning why _____ called the police on him the first time and was screaming at him. After speaking with Mr. Mishler, he admitted to the above facts after initially denying it. He was highly intoxicated, slurring his words and unable to form a sentence without loosing his train of thought.

Mr. Mishler became agitated when I informed him I was sending him to the hospital for detox and became increasingly angry as we waited for an ambulance. He began screaming, banging his head against a

concrete wall and attempted to leave the site on foot. Concerned for his safety, I took Mr. Mishler's arm and attempted to handcuff him. As I did, he took a fighting stance and clinched his fist in anger toward me. Mr. Mishler refused to be handcuffed resulting in him being brought to the ground. After a lengthy struggle which ultimately ended with him being handcuffed, Mr Mishler was instead arrested.



REMARKS

On Monday January 23, 2017 at approximately 2103 hours I was dispatched to 460 Main Street apartment 9. The caller, Keith Stack had been involved in an incident earlier in the night where he was the complainant of a larceny. Stack stated he was back at the apartment and could not figure out how to get back downstairs. Stack had been intoxicated when we had taken his complaint earlier in the night.

Upon arrival, Officer DiMassa and I were coming up the stairs to where apartment 9 is located when we heard a loud crashing sound. It sounded like something made of glass had broken. As we approached apartment 9 the door was open and Stack was standing inside the apartment. Stack was instructed to sit down against the wall. I began inspecting the apartment. The door appeared to have been broken open. The door frame was broken, and the deadbolt was still in the locked position, but bent back from being forced open. The refrigerator was in the middle of the kitchen away from the wall. The stove door was open and appeared to be bent down. The kitchen cabinet doors were pulled off of the cabinet and laying

on the floor of the kitchen. I then entered what appeared to be a bedroom off of the kitchen and there was a dresser with the drawers pulled out of it. I could see a bathroom from there which had broken glass on the floor. As I looked into the bathroom I saw that the glass was from the mirror above the sink and the toilet seat was broken. I determined that the breaking glass sound I had heard was the mirror. There was nobody else inside the apartment.


I asked Stack what he was doing inside the apartment and he said he had come back to get even from the larceny that had occurred earlier. Stack stated he had caused the destruction throughout the apartment out of frustration. Stack admitted to causing all of the damage I described in the previous paragraph, with the exception of breaking open the door. Officer Haddad would end up taking pictures of the damage to the apartment which are attached to this incident report.

Due to the fact I did not know who lived there, Stack was removed from the apartment. Stack was placed under arrest and transported to Middletown Police headquarters where he was advised of his rights, fingerprinted, and processed.


