### REMARKS

On Monday 01/02/2017 at approximately 1900 hours, Narcotics detectives were conducting surveillance in the 300 block of Newfield St. This area is known to Detectives, due to previous investigations, to have a significant amount of drug activity including sales and usage.

I observed a black Ford Fusion bearing CT Reg. AC66487 exiting Stoneycrest Dr. with a broken right rear brake light. The vehicle traveled straight across Newfield St. and directly onto Bartlett Hollow. As the operator, later identified as ARRESTED PARTY 1 (API), pulled into Bartlett Hollow I activated my emergency lights and siren to initiate a motor vehicle stop. API did not respond to my lights or siren and continued to drive approximately 150 feet. He then attempted to "U-turn". I stopped my vehicle facing the driver side of the Fusion and made direct eye contact with API. He continued attempting to maneuver his vehicle until he was completely across the road and up against the curb. API finally stopped

the vehicle when he had no other option.

Detective Lemieux and I exited our vehicle and ordered both **API** and the passenger, later identified as Steven Perry, to raise their hands. As Det. Lemieux was approaching the passenger side of the vehicle he clearly saw Perry open the door and drop a beer bottle on the ground. Det. Lemieux removed Perry from the vehicle and detained him in handcuffs. Perry stated he had a small amount of marijuana on his person. Det. Lathrop removed a small white plastic container from Perry's right jacket pocket. Inside the container Det. Lathrop found a plastic baggie containing a green-leafy material which he immediately recognized as suspected marijuana. Det. Lathrop conducted a further search of Perry's person and no additional items were located. Det. Lemieux picked up Perry's discarded beer bottle and directly behind the front tire he observed a glass tube which had been burnt on the ends. Det. Lemieux immediately recognized this as a pipe used to smoke crack cocaine. Based on the location of the crack pipe, it was obvious that Perry had dropped it when he opened the vehicle door. Had it been there prior to the stop, it would have been run over by the vehicle.

As I approached the driver door to make contact **API**, he began rapidly chewing on an item. Through training and experience I am aware that persons in possession of crack cocaine will try and ingest it to avoid detection by the Police. I immediately ordered **API** to open his mouth, but he had already swallowed the item. I could clearly see a white residue coating the inside of his mouth. **API** was secured in handcuffs and a search of his person was conducted. No contraband was located on **API**'s person.

Once both parties were out of the vehicle, small pieces of copper wool could be seen scattered throughout the front passenger compartment. It is common knowledge that copper wool is used as a filter and stuffed into glass tubes in order to smoke crack cocaine.

Off. Schreiner and his K9 partner, Otto, were requested to respond to the scene and conduct a search of the vehicle. Upon their arrival several small pieces of a white rock-like substance were located on the driver side floor of the vehicle. This substance was identified as suspected crack cocaine.

On the passenger side, in between the center console and the passenger seat, Otto alerted to a small burnt piece of copper wool which was consistent with the size and shape of a crack cocaine filter.

Behind the driver's seat I located a large piece of unused copper wool which had clearly been pulled apart.

Under the driver's seat Det. Lathrop located a glass tube with copper wool stuffed in the end.

**API** and Steven Perry were subsequently placed under arrest and transported to Middletown Police Headquarters. Upon arrival, both were advised of their rights, fingerprinted and photographed.

All items seized were transported to Middletown Police HQ. The crack cocaine was later transported to Middletown Police Headquarters where it was tested positive for the presence of cocaine using NARK Kit #13. The marijuana seized from Perry was weighed, using a department scale, for a total of grams, I then tested it, using NARK kit #8, which returned a positive result for the presence of THC. The items were then tagged as evidence and secured in a locker.

Steven Perry is a convicted felon with previous convictions for; Assault 3rd Degree, Interfering with an Emergency Call,

Larceny 6th Degree (multiple convictions), Possession of Narcotics, Disorderly Conduct (multiple convictions), Interfering/Resisting, Sale of Illegal Drugs, Sale of Hallucinogen/Narcotics, Burglary 3rd Degree (multiple convictions), Larceny 5th Degree, Criminal Mischief 2nd Degree (multiple convictions), Failure to Appear 2nd Degree (multiple convictions), Threatening (multiple convictions), Assault 3rd Degree (multiple convictions), and Criminal Trespass 3rd Degree.

Steven Perry was charged with violations of; CGS 21a-279(a)(a)(1) – Possession of Marijuana Under ½ ounce and CGS 21a-267(a) – Possession of Drug Paraphernalia. He was released on a \$25,000.00 Non-Surety bond and issued a court date, at Middletown Superior Court, on 01/13/2017 at 0900 hours.

I stopped my vehicle facing the driver side of the Fusion and made direct eye contact with Anderson. He continued attempting to maneuver his vehicle until he was completely across the road and up against the curb. Anderson finally stopped the vehicle when he had no other option.

Detective Lemieux and I exited our vehicle and ordered both Anderson and the passenger, later identified as ARRESTED PARTY 2 (AP2), to raise their hands. As Det. Lemieux was approaching the passenger side of the vehicle he clearly saw AP2 open the door and drop a beer bottle on the ground. Det. Lemieux removed AP2 from the vehicle and detained him in handcuffs. AP2 stated he had a small amount of marijuana on his person. Det. It was determined that Michael Anderson is currently on special parole. I contacted his Parole Officer, \_\_\_\_\_, and advised him of the situation. P.O. \_\_\_\_\_ advised me that a Remand to Custody Order would be filed for Michael Anderson. The order was faxed to Middletown Police and a copy was submitted with this case report.

Michael Anderson is a convicted felon with previous convictions for; Breach of Peace, Assault of Personnel, Larceny 6th Deg (multiple convictions), Failure to Appear 2nd Degree (multiple convictions), Possession of Narcotics (multiple convictions), Probation Violation (multiple convictions), Interfering/Resisting (multiple convictions), Sale of Hallucinogen/Narcotics, Possession of Drug Paraphernalia (multiple convictions), Tampering with Evidence (multiple convictions), Misrepresenting a Controlled Substance, Sale of Illegal Drug, Sale of Narcotics (multiple convictions), Assault of an Officer (multiple convictions), Assault 2nd Degree, Tampering with a Motor Vehicle and Burglary 2nd Degree.

Michael Anderson was charged with violations of; CGS 21a-279(a)(1) – Possession of Narcotics, CGS 21a-267(a) – Possession of Drug Paraphernalia, CGS 53a-167 – Interfering/Resisting and CGS 14-223(a) – Failure to Obey Officer Signal. He was informed of the Remand to Custody Order during booking. Michael Anderson was held on a \$5,000.00 Surety bond and issued a court date, at

On 12-16-2016 Detective Dirga and I were traveling west on Liberty St approaching Pearl St. This area is considered a high crime area known for prostitution, narcotics offenses, assaults and other quality of life issues. We at the intersection of Liberty St and Pearl St and observed two males standing shoulder to shoulder in very close proximity to one another, staring down at their hands. I know this type of behavior to consistent with individuals engaging in a narcotics transaction, from my training and experience.

When the males noticed us they started walking away and I observed one of the males later identified as Terrance Harding reach down toward a sewer drain in front of Aresco's market and drop and cylindrical object into it. The object was consistent with a crack pipe.

Harding was searched for narcotics with negative results. We lifted the sewer grate and located a glass crack pipe with burned ends.

Harding was charged with 21a-267 possession of drug paraphernalia on MSC # MC117675 and given a court date of 01-03-2017 at GA-09 in Middletown.

Yepes advised Detectives of his observations, consistent with a narcotics transaction, a description of the individuals and the direction the parties were walking.

Detective Lemieux and I, Detective Peck, observed the parties walking W/B on Rapallo Ave. As they approached the intersection at Main St., they both turned right and began walking S/B on Main St. As the parties approached Los Primos, 656 Main St., Det. Lemieux and I made contact with them. We immediately identified ourselves as Police Officers and ordered both **AP1** and Feulner to stop walking. Feulner stopped immediately and Det. Lemieux detained him. **AP1** however, turned towards us and took several steps back.

Det. Lemieux detained Feulner and secured him in handcuffs. Det. Lemieux asked Feulner if he had anything illegal on his person. Feulner stated that he had crack in his front left lower pocket and that he had a crack pipe in his front left upper pocket. The items were removed from Feulner's person without incident. No additional items were located on Feulner's person.

Both **AP1** and Feulner were placed in marked Police vehicles and transported to MPD HQ where they were advised of their rights, fingerprinted and photographed.


The crack cocaine was transported to Middletown Police Headquarters where it was weighed by Det. Lathrop, using a department scale, for a total amount of .2 grams and tested positive for the presence of cocaine using NARK Kit #13.

The \$40.00, crack cocaine and crack pipes were tagged as evidence and secured in an evidence locker.


It should be noted that the area where **AP1** and Feulner were stopped is 1232.42 feet from MacDonough Elementary School. A map of the area has been included in this case report.

As Gaunichaux stepped away he reached into his left pocket, removed a small item and inserted it into his mouth. I immediately secured Gaunichaux in handcuffs and attempted to retrieve the item he had swallowed, however, it was already gone. I asked Gaunichaux what he had put into his mouth and he denied that he had placed anything in his mouth. I explained to him that I had seen him place something into his mouth and he continued to repeat that he "didn't do nothing." A search of Gaunichaux's person revealed \$40.00 US currency and a small glass tube with a burnt residue on the end. Through training and experience I recognized this item as a pipe used for smoking crack cocaine.

Det. Dirga made contact with an employee of Los Primos bodega who allowed him to review the surveillance footage from the front area of the store. While reviewing the footage, Gaunichaux and AP2 can be clearly seen walking past the store. Det. Lemieux and I can be clearly seen approaching them. As I approach Gaunichaux, he can be clearly seen reaching into his left pocket, removing an item and placing it into his mouth. A copy of the footage was transferred to CD and tagged as evidence.

Both Gaunichaux and AP2 were placed in marked Police vehicles and transported to MPD HQ where they were advised of their rights, fingerprinted and photographed.

The crack cocaine was transported to Middletown Police Headquarters where it was weighed by Det. Lathrop, using a department scale, for a total amount of .2 grams and tested positive for the presence of cocaine using NARK Kit #13.


The \$40.00, crack cocaine and crack pipes were tagged as evidence and secured in an evidence locker.

Ismail Gaunichaux was charged with violations of; CGS 21a-267(a) – Possession of Drug Paraphernalia, CGS 53a-167(a) – Interfering/Resisting, CGS 53a-155 – Tampering with Evidence. He was held on a \$50,000.00 surety bond and issued a court date, at Middletown Superior Court, on 01/03/2017 at 0900 hours.

In addition, it was determined that Gaunichaux also had an outstanding Remand to Custody Order issued from Department of Corrections. This order was served and he was advised. A copy of the order has been included with his case file.

### REMARKS

On 1/1/17 at approximately 1613 hours I responded to a residence in Middletown to investigate the report of a physical domestic dispute between family members.

Upon arrival at the residence I spoke to a female, hereinafter referred to as V1 (victim 1). V1 explained that she had come to the residence and entered using her key. She stated that she visits the residence several times a week and that today when she entered no one was home. V1 stated she was making coffee when her mother Bonnie Malmberg entered the residence. She stated that Bonnie was on the cell phone talking with someone when she entered and began to make derogatory comments about V1 being at the residence. V1 stated that Bonnie then hung up the phone and began to question her about why she (V1) had her grandmother's purse with her. V1 stated she responded "none of your business" at which point Bonnie slapped her in the right side of her face causing pain. V1 stated that Bonnie then began to "attack" her by grabbing her shoulders and trying to throw her down while screaming at her. V1 stated that she began to wrestle with Bonnie to get free. She stated that once she got free Bonnie took her phone and stated that she was going to call the police and tell them that V1 was attacking her. V1 stated that she grabbed several items from around the house which belonged to her and left the residence to come to the police department to report the incident. She stated she has a poor relationship with Malmberg and they have been involved in an ongoing verbal dispute for several days.

I then spoke with Bonnie Malmberg about the incident. She stated that she returned to the residence and saw that V1 had let herself inside with a key. Malmberg stated V1 does not reside at the residence and has not for over 1.5 years. She stated that V1 has had narcotics addiction problems in the past and has anger issues. She stated when she arrived at the residence she attempted to speak with V1 and that V1 said something very disrespectful to her so Malmberg stated she slapped V1 in the face.


Malmberg stated that after she slapped V1 that V1 began to attack her, striking her in the left side of her face. Malmberg stated V1 grabbed her and tried to throw her down. She stated that she tried to get away from V1 so exited the rear door of the residence at which point V1 closed and locked the door with her outside. Malmberg stated she had her keys on her so was able to unlock the door and contact police. She stated that V1 was gathering belongings and she yelled at her several times to leave the house. She stated she also contacted police at this time.

Malmberg, who stated she had slapped V1 in the face initially, was issued a misdemeanor summons on the charge of disorderly conduct (53a-182) in violation of the CT General Statutes. She was issued a court date of 1/3/17 due to the domestic nature of the incident.

Witness # 1 reported that Zimny was drunk and was yelling at Victim # 1. Witness # 1 stated that he tried to



Zimny reported that after the argument she gathered some belongings and left the residence.



### REMARKS

On 01-02-2017 at approximately 2012 hours I, Officer Thompson, was dispatched to Plaza Dr. for an assault.

Upon arrival I met with the victim who explained he was assaulted by his brother, Shawn Fierghery. The incident began when Fierghery gave the victim a ride home from work and became frustrated because the victim was taking to long to get into his vehicle. They arrived home a short while later and continued to argue. The victim claimed Fierghery grabbed him and began to throw him around his bedroom. Fierghery grabbed him by the shirt and neck which caused a scratch mark along his upper chest. At one point the victim grabbed a pocket knife from his bedroom and told Fierghery to leave him alone.

Detective Lathrop located Fierghery on Bartlett Hollow Rd. who was detained until I arrived on scene for questioning. He gave a similar story to the victim on what started the confrontation. He stated the victim kept antagonizing him about some of his life decisions which escalated the argument. Fierghery then went upstairs to the victims bedroom when the victim grabbed a knife. He then grabbed Fierghery to control him and calm him down.

Based on my investigation I believe their was enough probable cause to pursue charges against Fierghery

for domestic violence. The victim returned to his bedroom which is on the second floor of the apartment. Fierghery resides in the basement and did not have to follow the victim upstairs into his bedroom. The victim displayed a mark which on his chest which was consistent with Fierghery grabbing him. The victims girlfriend also witnessed the incident and gave the same story as him.

Fierghery was issued Misdemeanor Summons and Complaint #MC 379951 for violation of CGS 53a-182, Disorderly Conduct. He was issued a court date of 01-03-2017 at GA 9 and released on a family violence no contact conditions of release. He was identified by his CT drivers license.
