REMARKS

On 01/27/2017 at approximately 1719 hours, I, Officer Santostefano was dispatched to an undisclosed location in Middletown for a reported Vandalism.

Dispatch informed me the suspect was a Heriberto Hernandez who was wearing a gray sweat shirt and blue jeans. Dispatch further stated Hernandez had broken the windows of his girlfriend's vehicle and fled the scene westbound on Washington Street.

Upon arrival on scene I observed the front driver's seat window completely shattered and the front windshield severely damaged.

Officers canvassing the area located Hernandez on Washington St. and Bernie O'Rourke. Hernandez stated his girlfriend of 2 years did not allow him to have the keys to her vehicle so he became frustrated and

broke the windows of her vehicle.

Photographs of the damage were taken and attached to this report. The damage to the vehicle was estimated to be less than 1,500.00 dollars but more than 250.00 dollars.

Through the victim's sworn written statement, Hernandez's admission, and my observation of the property damage Hernandez was arrested for the following charges: 53a-182; Disorderly Conduct, and 53a-116; Criminal Mischief 2nd degree.

Hernandez was transported to Middletown Police Headquarters for processing for the following charges: 53a-182; Disorderly Conduct, and 53a-116: Criminal Mischief 2nd Degree. Hernandez was read his Notice Of Rights at approximately 1818 hours which he stated he understood and willingly signed in the designated area.

Hernandez was issued a Conditions of Release Family Violence form which he stated he understood and willingly signed in the designated area.

Hernandez was released on 5,000.00 dollar Non-Surety Criminal Appearance Bond which he willingly signed in the designated area and issued a next available court date of 01/30/2017 at 0900 hours on G.A #09 located on #01 Court St. Middletown, CT 06457.

REMARKS

On 01/29/2017, I responded to Stop & Shop for a report of a purse snatching. While en route, dispatch advised that the suspect was being pinned down in the parking lot.

Upon arrival, one suspect fled on foot and was unable to be located or identified.

Witness, pointed out a black male on scene, later identified as Alfred Marshall. reported that this individual was involved in this incident and attempted to flee the scene in a Ford Escape. also reported that he observed this individual throw a glass pipe, referring to a crack pipe, across the parking lot. I observed this glass pipe which is commonly used for smoking crack cocaine shattered on the pavement. There was a piece of steel wool still lodged into the stem of the glass pipe.

The victim reported that the unidentified suspect stole her purse, had a struggle with her in the parking lot

and fled the area on foot. The victim had recovered her purse from the suspect.

I made contact with Marshall who insisted he was not involved. He said his friend " " took the victim's purse. I asked Marshall if he threw the glass pipe and he confirmed that he did. Marshall was patted down and in his possession I located two bottles of Dove shampoo and two bottles of Dove conditioner valued at \$17.96.

I retrieved the broken glass pipe from the pavement and confirmed it was paraphernalia to be used to smoke crack cocaine.

The victim reported that while in Stop & Shop she was in an aisle looking at glasses. She stated that she left her purse in her shopping cart. She reported that a black male (Alfred Marshall) approached her and asked if she could help him find a pair of glasses. She stated that Marshall told her he had trouble seeing and needed help. She stated she helped him look for the glasses and pointed them out to him.

The victim reported that she turned around towards her shopping cart and noticed that her purse was missing. She stated that she yelled "help, someone stole my purse" and then ran towards the front of the store. She stated that when outside she again repeated "someone stole my purse". She stated that witness) pointed towards a car parked in the fire lane and said that the purse was in the backseat.

The victim reported that she went up to the car and tried opening the door. She stated that a black male was in the vehicle and trying to start the vehicle with a pair of keys. Witness) grabbed the males hands and tried to take the car keys from him but the suspect was able to get out of the car and run from the area.

The victim stated that she located her purse and all the contents. The victim reported that the purse is valued at \$40, the Samsung cell phone is valued at \$200 and that there was \$300 cash inside her wallet.

I reviewed Stop & Shop video surveillance footage of this incident.

Marshall and the unidentified suspect are seen parking in the fire lane in the green Ford Escape and then entering Stop & Shop together. Marshall and this individual are then observed in the area of the shampoo and conditioner. Marshall is observed taking several items off the shelf, believed to be the items he was later found in possession of.

The victim is then observed pushing her shopping cart through the aisle. She is observed leaving her shopping cart alone while she walks towards the rack of glasses.

Marshall appears to notice that there is a purse inside the victim's shopping cart. He attracts the attention of the unidentified suspect and immediately approached the victim. The unidentified suspect is then seen walking up to the shopping cart and walking away carrying the victim's purse.

The unidentified suspect enters the Ford Escape and the victim and bystanders open the doors to the vehicle. The unidentified suspect was able to exit the vehicle and the victim is seen holding onto the suspect. The suspect was attempting to get away from the victim and was pushing her off him. The suspect was able to break free and fled the area.

Marshall is also observed raising his arm and appeared to throw an item in the direction that the crack pipe that was located.

The vehicle in the fire lane was searched for further evidence. In the trunk inside a jacket pocket were five small pink pills which were identified as Quetiapine fumarate 25 mg, a prescription only medication. These pills were loose in the jacket and not inside a prescription bottle. Marshall had made a statement that he was aware of them being inside the jacket in the trunk. In the front passenger seat door arm rest was a metal pick used for poking the inside of a crack pipe.

Marshall was advised he was under arrest and transported to headquarters for processing. Marshall was processed and charged with Conspiracy to Commit Robbery in the Second Degree (53a-48/53a-135), Conspiracy to Commit Larceny in the Second Degree (53a-48/53a-123), Illegal Possession of a Prescription Drug (21a-108), Possession of Drug Paraphernalia (21a-267) and Larceny in the Sixth Degree (53a-125b). Marshall is being held on a \$100,000 cash/surety bond. Marshall is scheduled to appear before Middletown Superior Court GA-9 on 01/30/2017, at 0900 hours.

REMARKS

On 1/29/17 at approximately 1753 hours, Officer Foss-Rugan and Officer Ortiz were dispatched to the area of 108 Newfield Street to investigate a reported possible domestic dispute. Shortly after they arrived at the scene, both Officers radioed for help as the male party was engaging them in a physical altercation. From the radio transmissions, it appeared that this physical altercation was escalating quickly.

It was later learned that the male, Thomas Figueroa and his girlfriend / were in a verbal argument as they were walking south on Newfield St., from 108 Newfield St. As Officer Ortiz and Officer Foss-Rugan arrived at the scene, they attempted to interview Figueroa and As they attempted to speak with Figueroa, he would not comply and continued to walk south on Newfield St. Figueroa then turned now facing the officers, he charged the officers ultimately leading to them ending up on the grass area on the east side of Newfield St., in the area of its intersection with Westfield St. Figueroa continued to struggle with officers as he would not comply with their commands and he continued to resist. During the active physical altercation, Officer Ortiz and Officer Foss-Rugan sustained moderate injuries to their hands and shoulder areas.

When back up officers arrived, control was eventually gained of Figueroa, who was then handcuffed and placed in the rear seat of a cruiser for transport.

Figueroa was then booked and processed under UAR 8873946 for violation of C.G.S 53a-167(c)-Assault on a Police Officer, 2 counts, 53a-167(a)-Interfering/Resisting Arrest, 2 counts, and 53a-181-Breach of Peace in the second degree, without further incident. He was issued a court ate of 1/30/2017 at 0900 hours at GA 9, Middletown. He was held on a \$250,000.00 Surety bond.

REMARKS


On 01/29/17 at approximately 2340hrs this Officer was parked in a driveway near 468 Mile Lane with my headlights off monitoring traffic. A short time had passed when I observed a subject wearing a heavy jacket, jeans and work boots sprint by the front of my cruiser holding a fairly large object in his hand. I immediately found this to be unusual due to the time of day and how the subject was dressed. I also realized that just down the street from where the subject was coming from is a new housing development where several vacant homes are under construction and there are valuable tools and materials inside and around the homes. This area has been targeted by thieves in the past.

The male subject noticed this Officer in his Police car and dropped a large object that he had been holding in his right hand. The male subject then ran on foot after I activated my overhead lights. After a brief foot pursuit the accused attempted to scale a picket fence that was in the yard of 431 Mile Lane and it collapsed, slowing the accused. I was able to get a hold of the accused and secure him in handcuffs. After identifying the accused as Timothy Stevens and further investigating the circumstances it was determined that Stevens had entered the property which is a new residential development off of Mile Lane and stole a Hitachi brand Framing Nailer to sell so he could support his heroin habit. Stevens was alone during the incident and the framing nailer was the only item he had stolen.


Stevens was placed under arrest and transported to HQ where he was processed and held on a \$15,000 bond for Larceny 6th (53a-125b), Criminal Trespass 2nd (53a-108), Interfering with Police (53a-

167a) and Criminal Mischief 3rd (53a-117).
