### REMARKS

The Middletown Police Department Street Crimes/Narcotics Unit continually receives information regarding illegal activity from reliable confidential informants, informants, arrested persons, concerned citizens, anonymous callers and brother police officers. Detectives have recently received information that there has been an increase in prostitution in the North End of Middletown. This is a high crime area with numerous documented incidents of vice crimes, such as drug dealing and prostitution.

On 12/26/2016, at approximately 2120 hours, dispatch received a complaint from a resident of Grand Street who said that there was a heavy set white female wearing gray sweatpants and a black sweatshirt waving at cars. He believed that she was a prostitute attempting to solicit customers.

Detective Lemieux and I drove past a female fitting the description given by later identified as Jessica Monroe) in front of 81 Grand Street and observed her waving at cars.

I returned to headquarters and obtained an undercover police vehicle and I was dressed in street clothing. I was equipped with real time audio monitoring, which was later copied onto a DVD for this case. Detectives Lemieux, Peck, Lathrop and Sergeant Yepes were assigned to visual surveillance.

I proceeded to Grand Street and found Monroe still standing in front of number 81. I pulled over to the north side of the

roadway and Monroe got into the front passenger seat of my car. After a brief conversation I asked Monroe "how much". Monroe asked me what I wanted. I told her that I wanted a "blowjob" (meaning that I wanted to receive oral sex from her). Monroe told me it would cost \$30. I gave the surveillance units the signal word to initiate a stop on my car and arrest Monroe.


Detectives pulled behind my car and activated their emergency lights and siren. I pulled over on Spring Street by Pease Avenue. Monroe was taken into custody. Officers Aroyo and Murphy responded to the scene and transported her to the Middletown Police Department.

Monroe was fingerprinted, photographed and processed. She would not give a statement. She was released on a \$20,000 non-surety bond for violation of 53a-82 Prostitution. She is scheduled to appear at GA9 in Middletown on 1/6/2017 at 0900 hours.

Monroe has prior convictions for prostitution, breach of peace 2nd, 3 counts of possession of narcotics, larceny 5th, 2 counts of credit card fraud, 2 counts of violation of probation, larceny 6th, and robbery.

### REMARKS

On 12/27/2016, at 1438 hours, the accused Jason L. Glickman was involved in a minor motor vehicle accident while exiting the driveway of Luce Restaurant, 111 Washington Street. **REMARKS**

On 12/28/16 at approximately 1948 hours I responded to the are of #749 South Main Street to investigate the report of a motor vehicle complaint.

Upon arrival to the area I met the complainant in the area of #690 South Main Street. She explained that her ex boyfriend but current roommate Raymond Hassenfeldt had taken her vehicle, a 2003 GMC Safari, without her permission. She stated that Hassenfeldt is currently intoxicated, had been drinking, and had taken her vehicle after a brief verbal argument.

While I was speaking with the complainant Officer St. Peter relayed via police radio that he had located the vehicle traveling on Highland Avenue at its intersection with South Main. Officer St. Peter followed the vehicle as it made several dangerous and reckless traffic violations before pulling into the driveway of #749 South Main Street and the operator, Raymond Hassenfeldt, exited the vehicle. Hassenfeldt refused to perform any standardized field sobriety tests however he was unsteady on his feet, slurring speech, and smelled of alcohol. He was placed under arrest.

Hassenfeldt provided two valid breath samples which were both above the legal limit for blood alcohol content.


A check of DMV records revealed that Hassenfeldt's operator license has been suspended as of 4/15/15. He also has multiple previous convictions for operating with a suspended license as well as operating under the influence.

Hassenfeldt was then charged with Operation Under The Influence (14-227a), Reckless Driving (14-222), Operating with a suspended license (14-215), and Possession of less than 1/2 ounce marijuana (21a-279aa1) in violation of the CT General Statutes. He was issued a court date of 1/11/17 and released on a \$500.00 non surety bond and turned over to a friend who had arrived at headquarters to pick him up.

## REMARKS

On the above date and time, I, Officer Aura Smith and Officer DeFrance responded to Middlesex Behavioral Health at 33 Pleasant Street for the report of a panic alarm.

Upon my arrival I spoke to one of the doctors on scene. He stated that a male patient, who had just left, had caused a scene inside, prompting staff to hit the alarm. The doctor advised that male and threaten to kill himself because he wasn't able to get the medication he wanted.

Officer DeFrance located the male, later identified as Kevin Bader (21) on Old Church Street. The accused was extremely agitated, hostile and angry. He was pacing back and forth and refused to answer any questions and cursing every other word. When questioned about his suicide threat the accused said he was very angry, that he suffers from multiple mental health issues.

When told he needed to go to the hospital, the accused became even more agitated and said he wasn't going to the hospital. His body language became more aggressive, indicating to me that he was either go to fight us or try to run - his shoulders tensed, he bladed himself, his eyes were wide, pupils were dilated and he was clenching and un-clenching his fists. The accused refused to give his name or address.

When the accused tried to walk away again, Officer DeFrance and I each took one of his arms and told him he was being detained. The accused started wriggling away from us and would not place his hands behind his back. Officer DeFrance and I took him down to the ground and after a second brief struggle, Bader was placed handcuffs for his protection and ours.

Approximately two hours after the initial call, Middlesex Hospital called Central Dispatch and advised that Bader had become combative and tried to leave the hospital, when prevented from doing so, he had bitten a security guard.

Hospital Security Officer stated the accused was being prepared to move from the Emergency Department to the Emergency Crisis Area (a secured area for psychiatrically disturbed patient's). said he and other staff were standing by waiting for the accused to get onto a wheel chair to move the ECA when accused got into a fighting stance and started to run. said he took him down to the ground and in the struggle on the floor, the accused bit hard on his right thumb braking the skin on the top and bottom of it.

On 12/30/16 at approximately 1100 hours, Middlesex Hospital advised that they were be releasing the accused. He was taken into custody without issue. The accused was positively identified via fingerprints from a previous arrest.

He was processed and released on a five thousand dollar non-surety pending his Friday 01/06/2017 0900 hours court appearance at GA9 where he will answer for the charges of Interfering with an Officer and Assault on Public Safety /Emergency Personnel/Health Care Personnel, CGS 53a-167a and 53a-167c.

After approximately ten 911 calls, and routine calls, where the caller kept hanging up, Middletown dispatched was finally able to get someone to answer a call back. The female caller stated that her name was Michele Carlson of 11 Glover Place. She stated that there was no problem, and that the person who had called 911, had since left the scene. Carlson added that she was now alone.


I arrived at 11 Glover Place with Officer Ortiz. We got no answer at the front door and dispatch stated that call backs were now going to voice mail. Officers then found that the rear door was unlocked. Officers called inside several times but got no answer.

Officers did find Michele Carlson and [redacted] in bed hiding under the covers. Michele jumped up and began screaming at officers. Michele would not calm down. I did try to explain to Michel that Officers were only there to be sure that she was not injured. I did convince Michele to sit back down on the bed. I was attempting to determine if a disturbance had taken place. Both were visibly intoxicated. They both stated that Michele's phone was not even on scene. They both stated that Michele's husband had been

calling 911 with Michele's phone, from a different location so that the police would respond there. I stated that Michele was in the middle of a divorce. Michele then said to me, "Hey you bald guy", and she reached toward my face. Michele was then handcuffed as she was escalating toward being physical. She wrestled with officers, to try to not be handcuffed.

Michele Carlson was also issued a misdemeanor summons # MC 455157, for the Charge of Interfering with a police Officer, 53a-167a. She was issued a court date of 01-11-2016 at 0900 hours in GA 9, located at 1 Court Street.




Hamilton was released on a Promise to Appear and has a scheduled court appearance at GA09 Middletown on 01/13/2015 at 09:00 hours.

## REMARKS

On 01/04/16 Ofc. Sevigny and I were dispatched to 6221 Town Place for a reported domestic incident. The caller, V/O #2, told Central Dispatch that she had a verbal argument with her girlfriend, V/O #1, who damaged items in the apartment and put a hole in the wall. Further stated that V/O #1 had left about 20 minutes ago in a white Mazda.

Upon arrival we were met by a V/O #2, who was crying hysterically and difficult to calm down. V/O #2 explained that she had discovered that V/O #1 had "stolen" \$2500 out of a credit card account (it was later discovered that the account was a shared one between V/O #1 and V/O #2). V/O #2 stated that she made contact via phone with V/O #1 and wanted to discuss the matter further when V/O #1 got home from work. V/O #2 stated that she was going to meet V/O #1 in the parking lot outside because she did not want to have this conversation in front of V/O #1's son. When V/O #1 got home from work, V/O #2 met her in the parking lot, where a verbal argument began, which then continued when both parties made their way up to their apartment.

V/O #2 stated that during the heated verbal argument, V/O #1 picked up a picture frame that was leaning against the bedroom wall and attempted to throw and break it. V/O #2 stated that she attempted to grab ahold of the frame because she did not want it broken, which was then being swung wildly about, and

defend herself from being struck at the same time. V/O #2 stated that V/O #1 finally smashed the frame, as well as swiped several bottles of perfume off of a side bed table before grabbing some belongings and leaving the apartment to drive away. I observed several bottles of perfume next to a side bed table on the floor, as well as a broken picture frame laying on the floor at the foot of the bed. V/O #2 admitted to calling her daughter, [REDACTED] after the event because she was so upset, and warned us that she and V/O #2 might get into something upon their arrival to the residence.

A short time after we arrived on scene, V/O #1 and [REDACTED] also arrived. Although we were not aware of anything happening between the two parties in the parking lot, we needed to separate them to continue the investigation.

V/O #1 provided a sworn written statement and explained:

"At 11:28pm I arrived home from work and V/O #2 was waiting for me outside...knocked on the passenger window and got in my car accusing me of theft. I explained to her what the situation as I did not steal anything and she became irate and began screaming outside. I came up to grab some things to leave. The chain was on the door. I told her to remove it and she pulled the door open with force and pulled me in by my neck. I started to try to defend myself and I got upset and grabbed a frame and broke it. I calmed down as I packed my things and she continued to confront me and get in my face. She then proceeded to wake my son up to "tell him what a piece of trash I am." That is when I became most upset and told my son to pack a bag. She then got on the phone with her daughter and ex-husband during which time I heard her say "she needed him to come with reinforcements." I didn't know what that meant because it sounded like a threat so I took my son and left. However, shortly after I realized I left behind things I needed. I told her via text that I was returning to grab my things and when I arrived I was welcomed by her daughter, [REDACTED] i, verbally attacking me outside and going into my home where she was still allowed to continue her verbal attacks. The police was already on site when I arrived and I decided I wanted to stay in my home until I was asked to leave."

I observed a small scratch above the nose of V/O #1, but no evidence of her being grabbed by the throat as she had alleged.

V/O #1 was issued a misdemeanor-summons for Disorderly Conduct (C.G.S. 53a-182) with a court date of 01/04/17 at 0900 hours. She was also issued a Conditions of Release, was explained the stipulations and understood the repercussions of violating same.

While deciding who would be leaving the residence for the evening, V/O #1 stated "you win, V/O #2...I'll leave". V/O #1 stated that she would be staying at a local hotel until her court appearance.

**REMARKS**

On 01/04/16 Ofc. Sevigny and I were dispatched to 6221 Town Place for a reported domestic incident. The caller, V/O #2, told Central Dispatch that she had a verbal argument with her girlfriend, V/O #1, who damaged items in the apartment and put a hole in the wall. Further stated that V/O #1 had left about 20 minutes ago in a white Mazda.

Upon arrival we were met by a V/O #2, who was crying hysterically and difficult to calm down. V/O #2 explained that she had discovered that V/O #1 had "stolen" \$2500 out of a credit card account (it was later discovered that the account was a shared one between V/O #1 and V/O #2). V/O #2 stated that she made contact via phone with V/O #1 and wanted to discuss the matter further when V/O #1 got home from work. V/O #2 stated that she was going to meet V/O #1 in the parking lot outside because she did not want to have this conversation in front of V/O #1's son. When V/O #1 got home from work, V/O #2 met her in the parking lot, where a verbal argument began, which then continued when both parties made their way up to their apartment.

V/O #2 stated that during the heated verbal argument, V/O #1 picked up a picture frame that was leaning against the bedroom wall and attempted to throw and break it. V/O #2 stated that she attempted to grab ahold of the frame because she did not want it broken, which was then being swung wildly about, and

defend herself from being struck at the same time. V/O #2 stated that V/O #1 finally smashed the frame, as well as swiped several bottles of perfume off of a side bed table before grabbing some belongings and leaving the apartment to drive away. I observed several bottles of perfume next to a side bed table on the floor, as well as a broken picture frame laying on the floor at the foot of the bed. V/O #2 admitted to calling her daughter, \_\_\_\_\_, after the event because she was so upset, and warned us that she and V/O #2 might get into something upon their arrival to the residence.

A short time after we arrived on scene, V/O #1 and \_\_\_\_\_ also arrived. Although we were not aware of anything happening between the two parties in the parking lot, we needed to separate them to continue the investigation.

V/O #1 provided a sworn written statement and explained:

"At 11:28pm I arrived home from work and V/O #2 was waiting for me outside...knocked on the passenger window and got in my car accusing me of theft. I explained to her what the situation as I did not steal anything and she became irate and began screaming outside. I came up to grab some things to leave. The chain was on the door. I told her to remove it and she pulled the door open with force and pulled me in by my neck. I started to try to defend myself and I got upset and grabbed a frame and broke it. I calmed down as I packed my things and she continued to confront me and get in my face. She then proceeded to wake my son up to "tell him what a piece of trash I am." That is when I became most upset and told my son to pack a bag. She then got on the phone with her daughter and ex-husband during which time I heard her say "she needed him to come with reinforcements." I didn't know what that meant because it sounded like a threat so I took my son and left. However, shortly after I realized I left behind things I needed. I told her via text that I was returning to grab my things and when I arrived I was welcomed by her daughter, \_\_\_\_\_ verbally attacking me outside and going into my home where she was still allowed to continue her verbal attacks. The police was already on site when I arrived and I decided I wanted to stay in my home until I was asked to leave."

I observed a small scratch above the nose of V/O #1, but no evidence of her being grabbed by the throat as she had alleged.

V/O #2 was issued a misdemeanor-summons for Disorderly Conduct (C.G.S. 53a-182) with a court date of 01/04/17 at 0900 hours. She was also issued a Conditions of Release, was explained the stipulations and understood the repercussions of violating same.

While deciding who would be leaving the residence for the evening, V/O #1 stated "you win, V/O #2...I'll leave". V/O #1 stated that she would be staying at a local hotel until her court appearance.

Nothing further.
