## REMARKS

On 01/07/2017 at approximately 2125 hours, Officer Ortiz and I, Officer DiMassa were dispatched to 1 Labella Circle, the Eddy Shelter to investigate a threatening complaint. It was reported that a Hispanic male name "Chino" was heavily intoxicated and he threatened the complainant. It was also reported that "Chino" left the building and was walking towards Silver St. It was reported that the male in question was wearing a tan jacket and he was reported to be five feet and five inches tall. As we arrived at the scene, it was relayed to us that CVH Police had a male matching the description of "Chino", on Silver St. at its intersection with the Rt. 9 exit 14 off ramp.

When we arrived at the Eddy Shelter, we spoke with the complainant , who was the

single on duty employee of the Eddy Shelter. provided me with a sworn written statement reiterating which she initially told me in regards to "Chino's" actions. It was later revealed that "Chino's" name is Edgardo Anibal Martinez by his Ct. Identification number 238984991. He later told police that he is a Latin King and his street name is "Chino".

In her statement, stated that on 1/4/17 at approximately 9:15PM, she received a phone call from a client of the Eddy Shelter named , who lives on the second floor of the Eddy Shelter. stated that told her that "Chino" or Edgardo Martinez was heavily intoxicated and that he went into several women's unlocked rooms asking them if they would have sex with him for \$20.00. stated that the clients on the second floor are not allowed to lock their doors.


stated that she then went upstairs to the second floor with a DOC staff member She stated that when they were going upstairs, they saw Martinez in the first floor doorway as he was coming inside from outside. stated that she asked Martinez if she could breathalyzer him. She stated that Martinez immediately became aggressive with her and by going towards them, posturing, and yelling and swearing at them. She stated that Martinez was calling her a "Bitch" and saying "Fuck You". stated that she told Martinez that she felt threatened and that she was going to call the police. stated that Martinez responded by saying "Bitch, if you call the police then pay back is a bitch". She stated that Martinez started to yell and swear at them again before he abruptly left the Eddy Shelter and started to walk towards Silver St.

Officer Ortiz and I then went to Martinez's location on Silver St at its intersection with the Rt. 9 exit 14 off ramp. Officer Freiman and Officer Skarzynski were at the scene with Martinez and the CVH police. I immediately observed that Martinez was intoxicated as I could smell alcohol emanating from his breath. Martinez was crying and saying that he did not do anything. I asked him to explain what happened at the Eddy Shelter several times. Each time he kept saying that he did not do anything and that he has spent half of his life in prison. He never gave an explanation of what happened at the Eddy Shelter.


Martinez was then placed in custody for violation of C.G.S 53a-181-Breach of Peace and he later was charged with Failure to Submit Fingerprints. He was placed in the rear seat of Officer Ortiz's cruiser for transport to headquarters. While in the booking room, Martinez was verbally abusive and threatening to Officer Ortiz and any other officer in the room. He stated several times that if anyone touched him that he would "break their jaws". He would stand up, posturing, with his chest out and clenching his fists, and he would randomly bang his fists on the desk in the booking room.

Do to the fact that Martinez stated, after being asked if he would willing to be fingerprinted, that he would break anyone jaw who touched him, we took it as a refusal to be fingerprinted. Officer Ortiz later completed UAR number 8873861 in regards to this arrest. Martinez was issued a court date of 1/5/17 at 0900 hours at GA 9, Middletown. He was held on a \$10,000 Surety bond. There is no further information. Case closed by the arrest of Edgardo A. Martinez.




vehicle, a blue 1990 Ford Ranger pick up. I stopped the vehicle on Saybrook Rd at East Main St.

I responded to 48 Talcott Ridge to speak with Ms. Lombardo. She was home at the time. I explained the incident to her. She kept saying that she was mortified that she had done ths, apologizing, and saying that she needs help. She admitted to doing this type of incident for numerous months.

I obtained a written and sworn statement of the incident from \_\_\_\_\_ and a video of the incident.

The value of the items taken in this incident was \$26.09. Ms. Lombardo was released on the scene on an

MSC for Larceny 6th with a court date of 1-18-17 in GA 9 and also advised not to return to Stop & Shop or that she would be arrested for Trespassing. She stated that she understood.
