REMARKS

On December 26, 2016, at approximately 1912 hours, I was patrolling the area of Randolph Rd. in my marked Middletown Police Vehicle. I was traveling Westbound toward the intersection with Ridge Rd. when from a side street I observed a dark colored vehicle pull out Westbound on Randolph Rd. with no headlights

on. This being in violation of 14-96a, I initiated my emergency overhead lights and siren and initiated a motor vehicle stop on the vehicle, bearing CT Reg 669 YTP. The vehicle pulled into the Grace Covenant Church Parking Lot, 999 Randolph Rd. Central Dispatch advised me the registration was cancelled on a Ford Taurus.

I made contact with the operator, John Brown (27), who admitted the car was unregistered and uninsured and said he was just trying to bring his cousin to a friends house. Brown was unable to provide me with any documentation proving ownership of the vehicle, including a registration, title, bill of sale, proof of insurance etc. When I asked him how he acquired the registration plate he told me his friend let him borrow it. He acknowledged he shouldn't be driving with someone else's registration and said he recently got the car and has not registered it yet.

Brown was consequently issued a Misdemeanor Summons Complaint (MC 397004) for violating CGS 14-213b, Operating a Vehicle without Minimum Insurance, 14-147, Misuse of a Registration, 14-12, Operating an Unregistered Motor Vehicle and 14-96a, Failure to Illuminate Headlights, the reason for the motor vehicle stop. He was given a court date of January 10, 2017, for 0900 at GA9.

REMARKS

On January 07, 2017, at approximately 1010 hours, myself and Officer Maio were on scene of an attempted burglary on Warwick St.

Officer Maio pointed to 26 Warwick St. and I observed a white male leaving the residence. It should be noted I was on scene to a Domestic Violence call at that address approximately a week ago where a Christopher Gosselin (56) had left the scene and warrant was applied for his arrest.

I observed a white male, later identified as Gosselin, leaving the residence of 26 Warwick St. who matched the description of Gosselin from the original call. I approached Gosselin to question him in regards to the potential burglary across the street. At the same time Central Dispatch confirmed there was a warrant for his arrest from our department. This was confirmed by Middletown Police Headquarters. He was placed under arrest and transported to Middletown Police Headquarters for processing.

REMARKS

On Thursday, January 5th, 2017 at 18:20 hours, central dispatch radioed that they were on the phone with an individual who's reporting that he's following a vehicle on Highland Ave, Middletown, that took off after being rear ended on High St. near Warwick St. Dispatch kept the caller on the line as additional information was being provided to responding officers.

A short time thereafter, dispatch radioed that the evading vehicle pulled into the driveway of 559 Highland Ave, Middletown. Sgt. Bartolotta, and Officers, N. Puorro, Foster and I, Officer Ortiz arrived immediately thereafter.

The complainant was identified as _____ He was operating a 2002 GMC pickup truck bearing Ct. Dealer registration DA20. The vehicle sustained rear end damage(s).

_____ said that around 6:15 p.m. he was operating his pickup truck south on High St. He came to a red traffic light at the intersection of High St. and Church St. He was stopped behind several vehicle and when the light turned green neither vehicle in front of his moved. He noticed that one of the vehicle was a Toyota Corolla. He waited about 45 seconds before passing on the left and continued south on High St. Scott said that he was rear ended of High St. and Warwick St. as he was slowing for traffic.

_____ said the vehicle that struck him, Toyota Corolla, left the scene and he followed. The Toyota drove at a high rate of speed on Highland Ave nearly causing several other accidents. The Toyota pulled into the driveway of 559 Highland Ave, at that point, the police arrived.

Scott S. Lewkowicz admitted that he was operating the Toyota Corolla. Scott said that he was traveling south on High St. approaching Warwick St. Scott said a pickup truck stop suddenly and he rear ended the vehicle. Scott openly admitted that he left the scene because he had been drinking this evening. Scott said that he had a couple of beers and a couple of shots of Jack Daniel.

I asked Scott if he be willing to perform a field sobriety test, he agreed. Scott failed the field sobriety test. Scott was advised that he was under arrest.

The first breath test was administered at 19:24 hours and registered a blood alcohol count of 0.1736. The second breath test was administered at 19:44 hours at least ten minutes after the first test and registered a blood alcohol count of 0.1625.

Scott was processed and charged with DUI, 14-227a, reckless driving, 14-222 and evading responsibility, 14-224. Scott was assigned a court date of 01/18/17 to appear at GA 9 at 09:00 hours. Scott was provided with all his personal properties and documents prior to being released. Scott was released on \$500 non-surety bond.

REMARKS

On 1/6/2017, at approximately 1811 hours, Officers were dispatched to an undisclosed address in Middletown on the report of a possible assault. The complainant was reporting a female was at her door with a bloody nose stating someone had entered her residence and assaulted her. The suspect was not known to the victim and she was unsure if the accused was still inside. On arrival, this Officer met with the victim who was hysterical. It is important to note that the victim in this

incident is a juvenile. Based on the physical evidence and the statements made by the victim, entry was made into the residence to look for the suspect, which yielded negative results.

The victim provided a clothing description of the suspect and Officer Foster located a party matching that description two streets north of the victims residence. The party was detained by Officer Foster and a "show-up" identification was done by the victim and I. The victim positively identified the suspect as her assailant. The accused was transported to Police HQ for processing. The victim was transported to Middlesex Hospital for evaluation and Det. Lacasse received a sworn written statement on sight.

In summary, the victim explained that the accused entered her residence through the front door unannounced and asked for a female by name. The victim explained that the female he was asking for did not live there and she asked him to leave. The victim stated that the accused forced her into a room and knocked her to the ground. The accused proceeded to "smash" her head into the ground and hit the victim in the face approximately eight times. The accused then placed both hands around the victim's neck to the point she couldn't breathe. The accused attempted to try and remove the victim's pants but was unsuccessful. The victim was able to escape the accused and ran for help out of the residence.


The accused was positively identified as Jean-Baptiste Berthony by a mug-shot photo from State Police.

Berthony was consequently charged with CGS: 53a-100aa; Home Invasion, CGS: 53a-49/53a-70; Attempt to Commit Sexual Assault 1st Degree, CGS: 53a-64bb; Strangulation 2nd Degree, CGS: 53a-107; Criminal Trespass 1st Degree, CGS: 53a-61(a)(1); Assault 3rd Degree, CGS: 53a-94; Kidnapping 2nd Degree & CGS: 53a-101; Burglary 1st Degree. He is being held on a \$500,000.00 surety bond. The accused will appear in Middlesex Superior Court on Jan. 9, 2017 at 0900 hours.

REMARKS

On Friday 01/06/2016 at approximately 2215 hours, Narcotics detectives were conducting surveillance in the area of Hotchkiss St. and Hubbard St. This area is known to Detectives, due to previous investigations, to have a significant

amount of drug activity including sales and usage. Sgt. Yepes observed a male, later identified as James Hall, walking N/B on Hotchkiss St. He stopped at 29 Hotchkiss walked up on the porch and entered the residence. This residence is known to the Middletown Police as having a significant amount of drug activity and has been the subject of numerous search warrants and narcotics arrests.

Hall was inside the residence for several minutes before exiting the residence and walking away, S/B on Hotchkiss St. to Goodyear Ave.

Det. Lathrop and I, Det. Peck, observed Hall walking E/B on Goodyear Ave., approaching the intersection of Hubbard St. As he crossed onto Hubbard St. and began walking S/B on the east sidewalk, Det. Lathrop and I made contact with Hall. We immediately identified ourselves as Police Officers and ordered him to stop walking. Hall complied without hesitation. As Hall stopped walking, I observed him drop an item on the ground. Det. Lathrop detained him in handcuffs and asked where he was coming from. Hall responded, "Maplewood." This response made no sense due to the fact the Maplewood Housing project is located more than a ½ mile directly east of our location.

As they were speaking, I observed 2 small plastic baggies at Hall's feet. One of the bags had an off-white rock-like substance which I recognized, through my training and experience, as suspected crack cocaine and the other had a small amount of a green leafy substance which I immediately recognized, through my training and experience, as suspected marijuana. Hall looked at the items and stated, "What is that?" I informed him that I had seen him drop the bags as we approached, but he continued to deny that it had happened.

Hall was advised that he was under arrest. Upon searching his coat pockets, Det. Lathrop located a glass tube with a copper filter, which had been slightly burned on the end. Through training and experience as a narcotics Detective, Detective Lathrop identified the item as a pipe used to smoke crack cocaine.

It should be noted that the area where Hall was stopped is 311 feet from St. John's School.

Upon arrival at the Police booking area, Hall was advised of his rights, fingerprinted and photographed.

The crack cocaine, marijuana and pipe were transported to Middletown Police Headquarters. The crack cocaine was weighed, using a department scale, for a total amount of .7 grams and tested positive for the presence of cocaine using NARK Kit #13. The marijuana was weighed, using a department scale, for a total amount of .7 grams and tested positive for the presence of THC using NARK Kit #8.

All items were tagged as evidence and secured in an evidence locker.

A check of James Hall's history revealed he is a convicted felon with previous convictions for; Possession of Narcotics (multiple convictions), Sale of Illegal Drugs, Sale of Hallucinogen/Narcotics (multiple convictions), Disorderly Conduct, Interfering/Resisting, Probation Violation (multiple convictions), Possession of Drug Paraphernalia (multiple convictions), Failure to Appear 1st (multiple convictions), Failure to Appear 2nd (multiple convictions), Burglary 2nd, Burglary 3rd, Larceny 4th, Larceny 6th (multiple convictions), Assault 3rd, Breach of Peace, Misrepresentation of a Controlled Substance, Possession Drugs in a Prohibited Place, Criminal Impersonation, and Criminal Mischief 2nd.

James Hall was charged with violation of CGS 21a-278(a)(b) – Possession of Narcotics in a School Zone, CGS 21a-267(a) – Possession of Drug Paraphernalia, CGS 21a-279aa1 – Possession of Marijuana Under ½ Ounce, CGS 53a-167a – Interfering/Resisting. He was held on a \$25,000.00 Surety bond and issued a court date, at Middletown Superior Court, on 01/09/2017 at 0900 hours.




Based on the totality of the circumstances, physical evidence, and verbal testimony of all parties involved, the probable cause was established for the arrest of both Victim/Offender's.

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
