
REMARKS

On 11/17/2016, at approximately 1924 hours I, Officer Foster, was traveling Eastbound on Randolph Road in a marked Middletown Police Cruiser. Traveling in front of my cruiser was a white Honda Accord bearing CT registration 756ZMF. A routine check with dispatch revealed that the registration had expired on 08/2016. I activated my emergency lights and siren to initiate a motor vehicle stop for the violation. The vehicle pulled to the right hand side of the roadway and came to a complete stop. I exited my patrol vehicle and approached the operator on driver's side and identified her as Angela Priest by her Connecticut Driver's License.

I explained to Priest that I had stopped her for having an expired registration. Priest stated she was unaware that her registration had expired. A check with dispatch revealed that Priest also had a suspended license and was not to operator any motor vehicle. Priest stated she was unaware of this as well. The emissions to the vehicle were also showing non-compliant as of 8/30/2015. Priest's vehicle was left legally parked in the Southfield Fire Dept. parking lot until suitable arrangements could be made.

Priest was issued a Misdemeanor Summons, MC 397124, for violation of C.G.S. 14-215 Operating a Motor Vehicle Under Suspension, violation of C.G.S. 14-12(a)* Operating an Unregistered Motor Vehicle, and violation of C.G.S 14-164c(n) Failure to Comply with Emissions Regulations. Priest is scheduled to appear in Middlesex Superior Court on December 1, 2016 at 0900 hours. Priest was cooperative throughout my interaction and respectful.

REMARKS

On 11/25/16 at approximately 1627 hours Lt. Maturo, Officer Santostefano, and I Officer Murphy were dispatched to 25 Garfield Ave for a report of a disturbance. The complainant was on the phone with Victim One when she could here yelling in the background before the phone was disconnected. While responding to the above call dispatch informed us that Victim One was the protected party in an active Protective Order with Offender One. Dispatch added that conditions one and two were checked in the active order.

Victim One provided a sworn written statement while on scene stating that Offender One was off her medications and was yelling at her throughout the day. Victim One stated that based on Offender One's behavior and unstable mental state, she was scared for her safety.

It should be noted that the initial complainant additionally stated that she heard Offender One in the background yelling earlier during another conversation at approximately 1400 hours. The complainant stated she personally knew Offender One and was concerned about her unusual erratic behavior.

While on scene Offender One admitted to confronting Victim One about her phone conversation, however claimed that she did not yell at her. Offender One added that she didn't believe her actions violated her order with Victim One.

Based on my investigation and the fear endured by Victim One at the time, this Officer believes that Offender One met the qualifications for harassment in that the accused intended to harass, annoy, alarm, and terrorize Victim One therefore violating condition two in her protective order. Condition two reads "do not assault, threaten, abuse, harass, follow, interfere with, or stalk the protected person." Based on this violation in conjunction with the statements provided by the complainant and Victim One, Offender One was placed under arrest for C.G.S. 53A-223 (Criminal Violation Of Protective Order) and transported for Middletown Police Headquarters for booking. Offender One was subsequently issued a \$5,000 Non-Surety bond to appear in court on 11/28/16 at 0900 hours. Due to the domestic nature of the incident, Offender One was additionally issued a Family Violence Conditions Of Release form with all conditions checked to be active immediately until her 11/28/16 court date.

REMARKS

On 11/26/2016 at approximately 0232hrs Police were dispatched to 47 Braeburn Lane for the report of a physical domestic dispute.

Upon investigation which included interviews of both involved parties it was determined that a verbal argument ensued between the female victim #1 and the accused. The verbal argument turned physical when the accused, Christopher Pyrek grabbed victim #1 who was sitting on the toilet going to the bathroom by her neck and threw her into the wall. The victim slapped Pyrek in an attempt to get away from him but Pyrek again grabbed her by her neck and threw him into the hot tub. The victim stated that Pyrek would not let go of her and continued to hold her down so she bit his hand to get away. Victim #1 then ran out of the bathroom and called her mother for help who advised her to hang up and call "911" which she did. It was learned through the investigation that during the altercation Pyrek had accused victim #1 of cheating on him with someone from Facebook and after she refused to let him see her phone he grabbed it from her and removed the battery throwing it in the neighbors yard. Pyrek was arrested and transported to Middletown

Police headquarters where he was processed on the charges of Disorderly Conduct 53a-182 and Criminal Mischief 3rd 53a-117.

"Pursuant to Public Act 15-164, the Victim of this incident will be referred to as VICTIM 1 and the Offender of this incident will be referred to as OFFENDER 1"

On 11/27/16 at approximately 1711 hrs, Officer Terribile and I, Officer Tiano, responded to an undisclosed location in Middletown CT, for a reported unwanted person. Prior to our arrival, dispatch stated the caller, VICTIM 1, was reporting her ex-boyfriend OFFENDER 1 was banging on her door and refusing to leave.

During interview of VICTIM 1, she agreed to provide a sworn written statement describing the circumstance of this incident. VICTIM 1 stated that OFFENDER 1 had been calling and texting her repeatedly leaving threats of violence against her. She said OFFENDER 1 also arrived at her residence, uninvited and was banging on her door so hard she thought he was going to force it open. She stated OFFENDER 1 also left her a voice mail containing additional threats of violence which she played for Officers. In this voicemail.

OFFENDER 1 can be heard telling VICTIM 1 that she was a dead woman, that he was going to get her, that he hates her and that he knew he may go to prison for what he was saying. VICTIM 1 further stated her and OFFENDER 1 had been in a previous dating relationship as of 2 months ago and had lived together during that time.

OFFENDER 1 was able to be contact by phone. While speaking with him, he admitted to going to VICTIM 1's residence, banging on the door and leaving the voice mail. OFFENDER 1 stated he had only done this out of angry and did not actually mean it.

OFFENDER 1 was later located by Meriden Police and taken into custody for domestic violence related crimes. He was transported back to the Middletown Police Department for booking and processing.

At the conclusion of this investigation, OFFENDER 1 was charged with the offenses of C.G.S. 53a-62 Threatening 2nd and C.G.S. 53a-182 Disorderly Conduct. He was issued a \$10,000 surety bond and a court date of 11/28/16 at Middletown Superior Court G.A. 9 at 0900 hrs. OFFENDER 1 was later released after his bond was posted by a bail bondsman.

REMARKS

Pursuant to Connecticut General Statute 54-86e, the victim in the incident, a 35 year old female, will be referred to as Victim 1 (or V1).

On 11/27/16 at approximately 2302hrs Officer Lombardo and I (Officer Wasilewski) were dispatched to a residence in Middletown on the second floor for a report of a possible past domestic. The caller, hereby referred to as Victim 1 or V1, called asking to the assistance of Police Officers. V1 stated she had a past domestic with David Fonda. During that incident she left her residence and went to a friends house on Spring Street. She stayed there for several hours in hopes that Fonda had left her apartment where he initially showed up. V1 called 911 asking for Police to meet her at her residence to ensure that Fonda was no longer there when she returned.

Officer Lombardo and I arrived at the residence and met V1 in the rear parking lot. V1 then explained that around 6pm Fonda knocked on her sliding glass door. Their 7 year old daughter (hereby referred to as Juvenile 1 or J1) saw Fonda at the door and opened it for him. Their 2 year old daughter (Juvenile 2 or J2) was also home at the time. Fonda is aware that he has a court set Protective order with Conditions CT01, CT03, and CT05 (No Contact) imposed. Fonda disregarded his no contact protective order and went inside the residence when J1 opened the door. V1 stated she did not feel threatened or scared that he had arrived but she did not want him to stay. Fonda eventually left and went outside. A few hours later V1 went outside and started to pack the car because she was taking the kids out. She open the rear hatch door of her SUV and saw Fonda hiding in the rear cargo area of the SUV. V1 agreed to drive him home but soon after they left they started arguing. V1 stated after she stopped the car she told Fonda to get out. As he got out Fonda reportedly took the keys and walked to the driver side. He opened the door and pulled V1 out of the car by her legs. V1 was able to get back in the car and grabbed the car keys from him. She then drove away and went to her friends house on Spring Street.

V1 showed This Officer messages from Fonda that originated around 11:21pm, 11:25pm, and 11:26pm confirming that Fonda violated the "No Contact" Protective Order. In the text messages Fonda writes

Fonda: "Cant Pick up Scum bag?"

V1: "Never thought it would come to this. I loved you"

Fonda: "You don't love me"

Fonda: "Your a Liar"

Fonda: " I don't care about going to jail."

V1 declined to provide a voluntary sworn written statement and said that she did not want him to get in trouble.

Fonda was later located by North Haven Police at his father's residence. After being read his rights Fonda gave his side of the story. Fonda admitted to going to V1's apartment and stated he called him and asked him to come over. Fonda stated she made up the story of him hiding in her vehicle and also about him taking the car keys out of the ignition and attempting to pull her out of the vehicle.

Fonda was placed under arrest and read his rights, photographed, fingerprinted, and processed at the Middletown Police Department. He was charged with violation of CGS 53a-223a Violation of Protective Order, 53-21 Risk of Injury/Impairing Morals of a Minor (2 Counts), and 53a-182 Disorderly Conduct. He was released on a \$10,000 Surety Bond and assigned a next day court date of 11/28/16 at 0900hrs. It was explained to him that he would have to appear at the GA 9 Court House on that date and time. He stated he understood.

DCF was contacted on 11/28/16 at 0335hrs and advised of the incident involving J1 and J2.
