## REMARKS

On 11/4/2016, at approximately 0036 hours I, Officer Foster, was traveling Eastbound on Washington Street in a marked Middletown Cruiser. While driving a 2001 Mazda Millenia, bearing CT registration AD83489, pulled out in front of my cruiser from the 500 block of Washington Street causing me to brake suddenly. The vehicle continued Eastbound on Washington Street weaving in and out of the left travel lane. I activated my emergency lights and siren to initiate a motor vehicle stop. The driver continued at a high rate of speed Eastbound approximately 1,600 feet before turning left onto High Street and coming to a complete stop. I approached the operator on the driver's side and identified him as Edmond Searles by his Connecticut Driver's License.

I could smell the strong presence of an alcoholic beverage emanating from Searles's vehicle and breath. Searles looked very pale and had a glassy look to his eyes. I asked Searles if he would consent to a field sobriety test to determine if it was safe for him to operate a motor vehicle. Searles replied "yes" and stepped to the front of his vehicle as directed. Searles subsequently failed the SFST.

The sum of all observations from the first contact with Searles to the time of arrest supported the probable cause for the arrest of D.U.I (C.G.S. 14-227a). Searles was placed in handcuffs and was transported to Police headquarters for processing. Searles was read his Notice of Rights Form at approximately 0117 hours and at 0119 hours he declined console from an attorney.

I am certified in the Drager Alcotest 9510. The device was checked in accordance with the applicable state regulations.




approached the male operator who is later identified as Eric Webb, he drove away and Ofc. Gagne pursued down Millbrook Road to where Webb ultimately parked his vehicle on the corner of East Ridge and Randolph Road. Webb was detained.


I arrived on Millbrook Road to speak to the victim. The victim stated verbally and later in a sworn written statement that around 2:45 PM her ex boyfriend Eric Webb showed up to drop off some of her belongings. He saw she had bags packed to go over a friends house for the night. He was already upset with her and now seeing she had plans made him more angry. The victim stated she went to her car to leave and Eric started yelling at her and charged at her like he was going to hit her or stop her from leaving. The victim stated she lifted up her knee to protect herself from him and it hit Eric in the groin. The victim stated they both fell to the ground. The victim was able to get up and put her bag in her car. Eric came over and started looking through her belongings and took her car keys. They started fighting over the keys. The victim was able to get the keys and got into her car. Eric followed her into the car and continued to yell at her and then started choking her. The victim stated she wasn't able to breath and she started slapping and hitting him to get him to stop. After he let go of her throat she took Eric took her bags and went into his car to leave. The victim stated she went into his car to try and get her stuff back and Eric drove away with the door open. They continued to argue because she wanted him to bring her back. He ended up driving back to the driveway and she was able to get her stuff and get out of his car. The police showed up and Eric drove away. The victim stated Eric made statements to her in the car that he wants a last hoorah and that he is going to rape her. He has also said in the past to her that no paper is going to stop him from seeing her. The victim stated she fears for her safety and thinks he will show up at her house again in the future.

The victim complained of pain in her right wrist and throat and refused medical attention. I observed a small cut to the victims lip. I saw no redness on the throat of the victim.

Eric was transported to police headquarters for processing by Ofc. Gagne where he was read his rights and refused to answer any questions about the incident.

Eric was charged with C.G.S. 53a-181 "breach of peace 2nd," 53a-64cc "strangulation 3rd," 53a-167a "interfering with an officer," and 14-223(b) "failure to obey officers signal." Eric is being held on a \$25,000 bond with a scheduled court date of 11/07/16 at GA09 Middletown.

### REMARKS

On 11/6/2016, at approximately 1614 hours I, Officer Foster, encountered a vehicle in front of Aresco's Market. The rear passenger, Nicole Roy, was showing to have two warrants for failure to appear. Roy was taken into custody without incident. Roy's black zip-up jacket was removed from her person and was searched for weapons and contraband. In the front right pocket of the jacket, I located a syringe which was halfway filled with a yellowish clear liquid. Through my knowledge of Roy's substance abuse and my training and experience, I recognized this substance to be suspected liquid state heroin. The contents of the syringe were later tested with NARK kit #33 which yielded positive presumptive results for heroin. I continued my search of the immediate area of where Roy was sitting in the vehicle. On the floor area where Roy was sitting I located two unused hypodermic needles.

I also located a single dollar bill on the floor area in an unusual folded manner. Upon manipulating the dollar bill, I could feel something contained inside. As I opened the bill, white powder fell from inside. I observed the white powder closer

which appeared to be suspected cocaine. This was later confirmed with NARK kit #1004 which yielded positive presumptive results. All mentioned contraband was seized as evidence and was transported to Middletown Police HQ for evidence.

In addition to the two warrants, Roy was advised she was also under arrest for the illegal possession of the suspected narcotics. Roy was transported to Middletown Police HQ to be processed and booked. The warrants were processed under two separate case numbers (16-27428 and 16-23753). Roy was charged with two counts of violation of C.G.S. 21a-279(a) Possession of Narcotics and violation of C.G.S. 21a-267(a). Roy was released on \$500 non-surety bond, however, was held on bail from her two warrants. Roy is scheduled to appear at Middlesex Superior Court on November 7, 2016 at 0900 hours.

Upon arrival I spoke to Victim 1. Victim 1 stated her boyfriend Terrance Johnson had gotten into a dispute with her and damaged items inside the apartment. Victim 1 directed me to a spare bedroom where the mattress was laying in the hallway and the door to the room appeared to have been broken into. Victim 1 stated she had been having issues with her eyes and wanted to go to the hospital. Johnson began giving her a hard time about wanting to leave with the baby and they got into an argument about it. Johnson told Victim 1 to leave and she locked herself inside the spare bedroom. Johnson then punched the door until it broke open. Victim 1 said Johnson grabbed the mattress off of the bed, threw it into the hallway, and told her she could sleep out there for the night. Victim 1 stated she was holding their baby and Johnson grabbed her by the wrist and told her to put the baby down. Fearing that she would get hit by Johnson, she refused to put the baby down.

Victim 1 stated she left the room and went into the main area of the apartment. Johnson followed her and kept trying to get her to put the baby down. Victim 1 put the baby down and Johnson began trying to push her out of the apartment. Victim 1 said she was able to break away from Johnson and she grabbed the


baby's car seat and put him in it. Johnson began throwing the baby's stuff outside of the apartment. Victim 1 got her car keys out of one of the baby's bags and since Johnson had her cell phone, she drove to the Quality Inn in Cromwell to call the Police. Victim 1 stated she thought Johnson hid her cell phone from her. Victim 1 provided a sworn written statement detailing the incident.

Johnson arrived back at the apartment while I was speaking to Victim 1. I met Johnson outside and asked him what had happened. Johnson confirmed they had been arguing because Victim 1 wanted to leave to go to the hospital. Johnson said he wanted to keep the baby with him and she wanted to take him with her. Johnson said Victim 1 started throwing candles around the house and locked herself in the spare bedroom. Johnson admitted to breaking down the door to get into the bedroom, but stated the incident had never become physical. Johnson stated they argued for a bit longer and he told her she needed to leave before things escalated. Johnson said Victim 1 left, and he also left shortly after. Johnson said he did not know Victim was leaving to call the Police. Johnson refused to provide a sworn written statement.

Johnson was issued misdemeanor summons #379738 which he signed. Johnson was charged with Disorderly Conduct (53a-182) and issued a court date of November 07, 2016 at GA9 scheduled for 0900 hours. Johnson was also issued a Conditions of Release with all available stipulations imposed against him. Johnson was advised if he were to violate any of the stipulations put in place against him, he would be arrested under an additional charge. Johnson said he understood.



**REMARKS**

On 11/4/16 at approximately 1617 hrs, Officer Wasilewski and I, Officer Tiano, responded to Froyo World located at 386 Main Street for a report of an intoxicated person. Prior to our arrival, dispatch stated the caller was reporting a white male wearing a black jacket, a red nap sack and gray sneakers approximately 40-50 years old, was intoxicated and falling into the businesses front window. The intoxicated party was later identified as the accused, Thomas Provenzano.

He was issued a \$5,000 surety bond and a court date of 11/7/16 due to being unable to post his bond.



## REMARKS

On November 5, 2016 at approximately 1803 hours I (Ofc. Terrible) and Ofc. Dimassa were dispatched to the area of Rapallo Ave and DeKoven Drive for a report of an active Fight. While en-route dispatch informed responding Police Units that there appeared to be four (4) black males and one (1) white female involved in the incident.

Ofc. Tiano immediately made contact with a black male who appeared to have been assaulted. The individual was initially unwilling to provide any demographics and stated he was not interested in providing any details or in pressing charges. After a brief conversation the individual identified himself by his Connecticut Operators License #198382862 as Dana Sweeney, but still refused to provide an information pertaining to the incident.

After speaking with Witnesses it was learned that Sweeney was the agitator of the incident.

Based on the investigation I issued Sweeney an Infraction for C.G.S 53a-181a; Creating a Public Disturbance. He was given an Infraction Reply Date of November 18, 2016. Sweeney became irrational and started yelling that we were puppets. When I asked Sweeney to acknowledge the Infraction by signing he refused to do so. Sweeney was then provided his Infraction at which time he turned to walk away. At

At this time he turned around towards us and simulated masturbation with his hand and stated, "All over your chest and rub it in." Sweeney was asked to refrain from using the follow language and proceed on his way. Sweeney walked approximately 200 feet prior to stopping and using his cell phone. While on his cell phone he began proceeding back towards the incident location. He then yelled that we were all just puppets and to suck his dick. These comments were loud, alarming, and disruptive to the community that were also witnessed by small children.

Based on the his irrational, alarming, and disrespectful comments Myself and Ofc. Tiano approached Sweeney. Sweeney turned away from us and started to proceed away from us. At this time he was demanded to stop, which he did. He immediately began stating he was sorry for his actions and comments. Sweeney was then placed into handcuffs, checked for tightness, and double locked. He was placed into the rear seat of Police Cruiser #114 and transported to Middletown Police Department for the booking process.

Upon arrival he was read his Notice of Rights, which he acknowledged at approximately 1850 hours. Sweeney was then photographed and fingerprinted which provided a Uniform Arrest #8873684 for C.G.S 53a-181; Breach of Peace 2nd Degree. He was unable to post his \$5,000.00 Surety Bond and was placed into Middletown Police Department Male Cell #3 pending his arraignment on November 7, 2016 at 0900 hours.

It shall be noted that several attempts for Sweeney were given to proceed on his way, which he blatantly disregarded and violated. Sweeney was extremely disrespectful during the investigation especially in the transport to the Police Station. Nothing further.




