
REMARKS

REMARKS

On 11/08/2016 at approximately 0749 hours I, Officer Kraeger responded to the area of Garfield Avenue for a private property minor motor vehicle accident.

On arrival I observed two vehicles. The first vehicle that I observed was facing South and was bearing CT marker plate AD11232. A DMV records check indicated that the vehicle was a 2001 Toyota Camry color gray with the registered owner listed as Lucinda Milardo.

The second vehicle that I observed was facing West in a private driveway and was bearing CT marker plate 301-YYL. A DMV records check indicated that the vehicle 2005 Hyundai Elantra color blue with the registered owner listed as Victim #1.

I spoke to Victim #1 who stated that Milardo had backed out of the drive way and struck the right side of her vehicle. I observed gray in color transfer paint on the right side of the vehicle.

I spoke to Milardo who stated she did back her vehicle out of the driveway this morning but did not hit any vehicle. I observed left rear bumper damage to the vehicle that appeared to be fresh as well blue transfer paint. I asked Milardo about the damage to the left rear bumper and Milardo stated that the damage was

new. I again informed Milardo to exchange information with victim #1 due to the fact it was a private property accident.

At approximately 0915 hours I was dispatched back to the area of Garfield Avenue. On arrival I spoke to Milardo who again stated that she did not hit victim #1's vehicle. I again explained to Milardo that this was a civil matter and that it did not involve the police since it was a private property accident and that it did not happen on the road.

At approximately 0927 hours I was again dispatched to the area of Garfield Avenue. On arrival I observed Milardo speaking to victim #1 outside of the residence. I instructed Milardo to step away from Victim #1. Victim #1 stated that as soon as I left Milardo began yelling and screaming at her, calling her and Victim #1's daughter fucking bitches. I spoke to Victim #1's daughter who stated that Milardo was screaming at them and did call them fucking bitches.

I spoke to Milardo who stated that its was only words and that she did not hit her. I informed Milardo that she was under arrest for Disorderly Conduct. I should be noted that victim #1 and Milardo are roommates and live together. It should be further noted that all three times that I was in the area it was heavily congested with pedestrian foot traffic walking to Woodrow Wilson Middle School to vote in the presidential election.

Milardo was transported to headquarters for booking and processing. Milardo was read her rights, processed, charged with Disorderly Conduct 53a-182, released on a \$500.00 Non-Surety bond and given a court date of 11/09/2016 at GA-09. No orders on file. Milardo was issued a Conditions of release family violence with block (CT01) checked.

Victim # 1 stated that Thomas got up and pushed her off of the bed. Victim # 1 stated that she got up and they got in each other's face and were arguing. Victim # 1 stated that Thomas then threw her onto the bed and pinned her down.

Victim # 1 reported that they then separated but the argument continued. Victim # 1 reported that Thomas pushed her again and threw her against the wall. She stated that Thomas continued to yell at her until he contacted the police.
