
REMARKS

REMARKS

On 9-27-16 at 1501 hours, Officer Ortiz and I were dispatched to the intersection of Hartford Ave and Route 9 for a W/M holding a sign and panhandling.

Upon arrival on the scene, we located Mr. Walsh. I know him from previous encounters and I, along with several other officers, have instructed him to stop panhandling and to not be in the center of the roadway.

As I was pulling up to him, a pick up truck pulled up and a male gave him \$2.00 as I watched.


I spoke with Mr. Walsh and I am also aware that he has a heroin addiction. Also, a records check showed him on Probation. I called and spoke with his probation officer, Bill Dinunzio. Officer Dinunzio stated that Mr. Walsh had been in this morning and had agreed not to return to Route 9 for panhandling. Officer Dinunzio also stated that he may have heroin on his person.

I asked Mr. Walsh if he had any heroin, needles, or other illegal items on him. He stated that he did not and that I could check if I wanted. I began to check his pants and then his pockets. He then stated that the pants he was wearing were not his and that he doesn't know who's they are. In the right front small change pocket I located two empty heroin bags. These were seized as evidence. I did not locate any other illegal items. However, Mr. Walsh also stated that it was not his jacket that he was wearing either.


Mr. Walsh was released on the scene on an MSC for Possession of Drug Paraphernalia, Panhandling, and Unsafe Use of the Highway by a Pedestrian with a court date of 10-12-16 in GA 9.

I seized the two empty heroin bags, his cardboard sign, and \$11.51 as evidence and placed the items into property.

REMARKS

On 9/27/2016 at 2230hrs, I Ofc. Sanford, was performing patrol in the area of Middle Street when I overheard a vehicle's engine revving and tires screeching. I determined the sound was coming from the parking lot behind Electrical Wholesalers on Middle Street. As I entered the rear parking lot I found a vehicle traveling at a high rate of speed in the parking lot driving in circles, with its tires squealing and the engine reaching its rev limiter. The vehicle was making a great deal of noise as it spun around the parking lot. The vehicle was a 1990 Nissan 240SX bearing CT early American reg "1C232".


I enacted my overheard lights and stopped the vehicle in the parking lot. I identified the operator as Lukasz Zawistowski (CT DL#198300660). Zawistowski stated he was just messing around doing donuts in the parking lot. I looked to see where Zawistowski had been driving and the parking lot was covered in tire marks from where the car had skidded around the parking lot. There were several large trailers in the lot at the same time Zawistowski was driving recklessly.

Zawistowski was unable to provide a registration for the vehicle.

Zawistowski was issued MSC #MC 330325 for violating statutes 14-222 - Reckless driving and 14-13 - Failure to carry registration with a court date of 10/12/2016 0900 at Middletown Superior Court.

REMARKS

On Monday 10-03-2016 at approximately 2045 hours Detective Peck and I (Detective Lathrop) were traveling S/B on South Main Street in an unmarked Police vehicle. We observed a Toyota Highlander in the parking lot of the laundry mat

which is located on the corner of Warwick Street and South Main Street. We were looking for a blue Toyota Highlander we had observed earlier in the evening and wanted to identify the operator and passenger due to some possible suspicious activity involving the passenger. I turned our vehicle around and headed back N/B on South Main Street to get a better look at the Highlander. Once I got to the intersection of South Main Street and Warwick Street I was able to see the Highlander better and realized it was a dark brown or maroon and not the vehicle we were looking for. I then took a left turn onto Warwick Street and a black Nissan Maxima drove past our vehicle in the opposite direction. I observed the operator and sole occupant of the Maxima as we drove past and immediately recognized him as Marques Moody from past Police interactions. Moody is known to Detectives as an illicit narcotics dealer with multiple convictions for possession of narcotics and possession of narcotics with intent to sell.

I turned our vehicle around and we got behind the Maxima. I was able to see the CT registration marker and could identify the first two letters, AD as it was traveling N/B on South Main Street. It is known to Detectives that Moody operates a black Nissan Maxima AD14403 and he has been seen in the vehicle in the past. Near the area of 192 South Main Street Detective Peck and I observed numerous items being thrown out of the Maxima as it was traveling N/B on South Main Street. The Maxima then took a right turn onto the connector and we followed the Maxima onto the connector. There were several vehicles on the connector and we were unable to get directly behind the Maxima and we lost it as it merged with other vehicles. Detective Peck called Detectives Dirga and Lemieux who were in another unmarked vehicle and told them what we had observed and they immediately went to the area of 192 South Main Street to look for what was thrown from the Maxima. Detective Peck and I continued to look for the Maxima and Moody.

A short time later Detectives Dirga and Lemieux arrived in the area of 192 South Main Street. Detective Lemieux found one clear plastic baggie with a white soap like substance suspected to be crack cocaine on the side of the road. He then found another one in the grass area near the sidewalk. Detective Dirga found four more clear plastic baggies with a white soap like substance suspected to be crack cocaine deeper in the grass area and in the front yard of 192 South Main Street. ~~Detective Dirga collected the four baggies using rubber gloves and those baggies will be sent to the lab for touch~~ DNA testing at a later time. All six baggies were collected transported to MPD headquarters.

Detectives then waited in the area to see if Moody would return to collect the suspected crack cocaine. Approximately 20 minutes later Moody was walking N/B on South Main Street near Burr Avenue. Sgt. Yepes observed as Moody as he continued to walk on the sidewalk until they got near 192 South Main Street. Moody stopped and started looking on the ground and in the grass area for the items. Sgt. Yepes called us and told us that Moody was in the same area where we collected the suspected crack and he were bending over looking for the baggies. We drove towards 192 South Main Street from both directions and Moody started to walk away as we approached. Moody was placed in handcuffs which were double locked and checked for tightness. A pat down search of Moody revealed a blue flip phone, and Apple iphone6, \$20.00 in US currency, and keys to the Nissan Maxima.

I asked Moody what he was doing in the front of 192 South Main Street and he said "nothing, I am just walking". I asked him what he was bent down looking for in the grass and he didn't answer. I asked Moody where the Maxima was and he stated "My grandma's house". I asked Moody how he got back to South Main Street and he stated "I ran". I know from prior investigations that Moody's grandmother lives at 115 Frisbee Street and I know he would not be able to run all the way from there back to South Main Street in that short amount of time.

Moody was advised he was under arrest and he was transported to MPD headquarters for processing.

We then went to 115 Frisbee Street and the same Maxima (AD14403) was parked in front of the house. I felt the hood of the vehicle and it was hot to the touch. The keys Moody was found in possession with were a match to the vehicle. Detective Dirga called for a narcotics detecting K-9 to the scene to do a sniff search of the outside of the vehicle. A short time later Officer Del Mauro arrived on scene. His narcotics K-9 Killian, alerted to the front driver side door. The vehicle was then seized and transported to MPD headquarters. A search warrant for the vehicle will be applied for at a later date.

REMARKS


On 9-24-2016 I responded to 416 East Main St (Stop and Shop) for the report of a larceny where the suspect attempted to hit the victim. Dispatch advised the suspects left the scene in a white vehicle.

Upon arrival I met with the complainant . provided a sworn written statement where he told me he was exiting the back room of the store when he observed a black male approximately 6'-6'02" tall with short hair (or bald) putting food items in a bag as they were standing in the beauty aisle. A chubby white female who was approximately 5'08" tall was giving him the items to put in the bag.

The suspect vehicle was located and stopped by OFC Spedding. There was a male driver who stated the suspect, had already exited the vehicle. There was only a female remaining in the vehicle at the time of the stop.

The female in the vehicle was identified as Patricia Direinzo. Direinzo admitted to her part in the shoplifting attempt to OFC Jeffries. Jeffries told me she was very cooperative during his questioning of her. Based on her admission, she was issued MSC# MC378285 for 53a-48 (53a-125b), conspiracy to commit larceny in the sixth degree. She was given a court date of 10-07-2016 at GA-09 in Middletown.



REMARKS

On 10/04/16 at approximately 0130 hours, I Officer Murphy was traveling in a marked police cruiser heading south on Pearl St. As I approached the intersection of Glover Place and Pearl St. I observed a white older model Chevy van bearing CTReg#413CX leave west out of Glover Place at a high rate of

speed. I attempted to catch up to said vehicle as it increased speed onto Liberty St. While following the older model van I additionally noticed that neither tail light was illuminated.

I subsequently caught up to said van at the intersection of Spring St. and Rome Ave where I activated my emergency lights and siren prompting a motor vehicle stop. Operator and sole occupant, Harold Bradshaw stated he did not have his license on him, nor could he provide proof of registration.

It should be noted that at this time a call came into central dispatch that an older white van struck a parked car in front of 11 Glover Place and evaded the scene. The caller, _____ was subsequently transported to Spring St. and Rome Ave where he positively identified both Bradshaw and his van as the driver and vehicle involved in the evading motor vehicle accident minutes earlier.

Based on the above, Bradshaw was transported to Middletown Police Headquarters for processing where he was read his rights at 0242 hours. Bradshaw was charged with C.G.S. 14-218a* (Traveling Too Fast For Conditions), C.G.S. 14-224(b)* (Evading Property Damage), C.G.S. 14-36(a) (Operating M/V Without License), C.G.S. 14-96c (Failure to Illuminate Tail Lamps) and is being held on a \$500 cash bond. Bradshaw is scheduled to appear in court on 10/04/16 at 0900 hours.

REMARKS

On October 03, 2016 at approximately 2209 hours, Officers were dispatched to (the Incident Location) for a reported domestic. While en route to that location, we were informed by dispatch that a female called 911 while crying. During that call, dispatch could also hear a male yelling in the background. The female was yelling "he's choking me".

Upon entering the apartment, we were met by the Victim and the Offender.

The Offender had visible scrapes around his left eye, and he was initially evasive about how he had received them. The Offender would later admit that he held down the Victim on her bed, without choking her, and she had scraped him to break free.

The Victim stated herself and the Offender had been in a verbal argument, but refused to provide details

about the physical altercation occurring between herself and the Offender, saying "you won't get it out of me".

The Offender was placed under arrest for the following violations of the Connecticut General Statutes:

53a-182, DISORDERLY CONDUCT
53a-96, UNLAWFUL RESTRAINT
