Dear Camp Kid Time Parents/Guardians,

Welcome to a fun and safe summer at Middletown Recreation. The office staff and our summer recreational staff are looking forward to meeting your child and making your child's experience a memorable one, filled with good times while we renew old friendships and make new ones. We will be located at **Lawrence Elementary School** ~ please enter the building through the Cafeteria doors on the left side of the building if you are dropping off your children. We offer seven weeks of summer camp starting June 20th until August 5th. There is no camp on Monday, July 4th.

I would like to take this opportunity to introduce myself. My name is Rose Carlson and I will be the director of Kid Time this summer. I have worked for the Middletown Board of Education as a Paraprofessional for 15 years and I am currently working at Bielefield School. I have worked for Middletown Recreation for the past 13 years, in which, the last 9 years I have served as the director of Camp Kid Time.

Lunches and Snacks:

This year lunch and snack will be provided daily from Connecticut Renewal Team (CRT). You will need to supply drinks, healthy snacks and lunch, if you do not like what will be served from CRT daily. Campers may have a late morning snack during a break from program play. Lunches will be refrigerated if we are at camp, but not for all field trips. We encourage campers to have their own water bottles. They may carry them around all day to keep themselves hydrated. We do not provide any drinks other than cold water.

Field Trips and Swimming:

Your child will be provided with a Park and Rec yellow T-shirt that should be worn on field trip days **only**.

T-Shirts must be worn on field trips so that our campers are easily identifiable in crowded off-site areas. We travel off site twice a week, once for a field trip and once for swimming at Veteran's Memorial Pool. When we go swimming at Vet's Pool your child does NOT need to wear their field trip shirt.

Every Monday we will spend the afternoon at Vet's Pool. Children can wear their swimsuits to camp under their clothes, but we do suggest a change of clothes. Please be sure to pack a labeled towel and sunscreen. Vet's Pool does not allow any goggles and requires that all floatation devices are Coast Guard approved. All campers are swim tested and each group is monitored by lifeguards and camp staff at all times. **Please bring a labeled bottle of sunscreen!**

Personal Items:

Please provide a labeled book bag for your child to bring to camp every day. No electronics, games, cards or money should be brought to camp. We are not responsible for any lost or stolen items. We have a lost and found area at camp.

Parent Transportation

Please do not drop off participants at camp before 8:55 AM and please pick them by 3:00 PM sharp. If anyone else is picking up your child that is not on the registration form we must have a note indicating who is picking up your child; when that individual comes to pick up your child they must provide a valid photo I.D. There is a sign-out sheet for all parent pick-ups that needs to be signed when taking your child home from camp.

Clothing:

During the day, your child will be participating in many fun group activities both inside and outside. Comfortable, play clothes are recommended and as a safety precaution **sneakers must be worn** every day. Please also bring a labeled bottle of sunscreen.

Rules:

- Inappropriate behavior cannot be tolerated.
- Respect yourself, other campers, and all staff!
- Keep your hands, feet, objects and belongings to yourselves.
- Treat others as you want to be treated.
- No swearing, put-downs or bullying.

Consequences:

- Verbal warning and/or a phone call home
- If a child misbehaves or endangers themselves or others he will receive a disciplinary action form that will be sent home for a parent's signature. A signed copy must be returned camp in order for your child to attend camp. If a child receives three write-ups they will be suspended from camp for the duration of the summer. If any participant displays unsafe behavior at camp, they may be suspended from off-site activities. A child may be suspended immediately for a serious behavior incident without a refund.

We are all committed to providing your child with a fun camp experience this summer! Please remember all policies and regulations are put into place to ensure the safety of your child. 


Participant Behavior Rules

Please review the "Participant's Behavior Rules" with your child so they are familiar with the program's expectations prior to arrival. Please be advised that if your child does not comply with these rules, he/she may be asked to leave and no refunds will be provided.

In order to ensure the safety of our participants and to provide the most rewarding and enjoyable recreation experience we can, we must insist on a standard of behavior that includes the following:

- ⇒ Children must respect staff, other participants and equipment, at all times.
- ⇒ Children must practice fair play, honesty, and good sportsmanship.
- ⇒ Children must be able to cooperate in a large group setting.
- ⇒ Children must follow instructions and rules.
- ⇒ Children must be aware of obvious dangers (roads, water, etc.).
- ⇒ Children must be able to interact positively with fellow participants and staff.
- ⇒ Children must be able to use the bathroom independently.
- ⇒ Children must stay with their group and listen to the staff members.

The following will not be allowed and will be grounds for dismissal:

- Inappropriate, disrespectful, uncooperative or disruptive behavior
- Abusive language and inappropriate gestures
- Injuring another participant, staff or person through an inappropriate action
- Fighting or putting your hands on any other person in a harmful or inappropriate way
- Throwing things in anger
- Biting, spitting on others, equipment or property
- Stealing or misuse of property
- Bringing cigarettes, alcohol, drugs, firearms, knives or weapons of any sort on the bus or to camp
- Any other behavior that the City of Middletown deems disruptive to its programs or compromises the safety of others

We understand that Parents/Guardians and participant (s) will be held responsible for participant (s) actions at rec programs. We understand that part of the recreation experience involves activities and interactions that may be new to my child, and that they come with certain risks. I have instructed my child on the importance of abiding by the rules. My child and I both agree that he or she is familiar with these rules and will obey them. Failure to adhere to these rules may result in immediate dismissal from a recreation program with no refund.
