The Preliminary design has been completed for the City of Middletown's Multi-Use Trail project. The trail will begin at the ball fields on Long Hill Road and will continue to the intersection of Long Lane and Wadsworth Street.

The City of Middletown will conduct an informational meeting in the Community Room at the Police Station, 222 Main Street, on September 29th at 7:00pm. Deaf and hearing impaired persons wishing to attend this meeting and requiring an interpreter may make arrangements by contacting the Public Works Department at 860-638-4850 at least five working days prior to the meeting.

Based upon preliminary assessment, the construction cost will be approximately \$ 690,000. The Federal Highway Administration will provide 80% of the construction cost with the City providing 20%.

It is the City's and the State's policy to keep persons informed and involved when such projects are undertaken. It is important that the community share its concerns with us to assist in the project's development.
