

The City of Middletown Department of Planning, Conservation and Development is seeking proposals from qualified Licensed Environmental Professionals (LEP) to oversee and administer the environmental remediation cleanup of the city-owned Portland Chemical Property at 680 Newfield Street (rear) (CT Rte. 3). The city will use state bid contractors to conduct the cleanup and the selected consultant will oversee their work. There is a current Phase 3 Environmental Site Assessment of the property and a Remedial Action Plan. The project is funded using EPA Brownfields clean-up funding.

Proposals should include individual and/or firms experience, resume of staff assigned to project and a fee proposal. Proposals should be submitted on or before September 22, 2006 at 4:30 p.m. to the Department of Planning, Conservation and Development, Room 202 at the Municipal Building, City of Middletown.
