### **USDA FARMERS TO FAMILIES FREE FOOD DISTRIBUTION**

**Held at Amazing Grace Food Pantry (16 Stack Street in Middletown) on December 21, 2020**

Middletown, CT – Just in time for the Holidays, St. Vincent de Paul Middletown is hosting a distribution of 756 USDA boxes of fresh food from the Farm to Families program to our community! This drive-through event is happening on Monday, December 21<sup>st</sup>, from 11:00 AM until 3:00 PM, or until the available food boxes run out. The event will be held at the Amazing Grace Food Pantry located at 16 Stack Street in Middletown.

The free box of delicious food includes a cold, fresh gallon of milk, three pounds of chicken products, yogurt, potatoes, onions, carrots, apples and more. One box is available per family. No sign-up or identification is required.
