Middletown Sanitation District and Recycling Center New Years Service Alert

The Middletown Sanitation District will not be collecting trash and recycling on Friday, Jan. 1, 2021. Both trash and recycling will be picked up for Friday customers on Monday. Both Friday and Monday customers will be picked up on the Monday following the holiday. Staffing is short due to Covid exposures, so if your cart is not picked up on Monday, please leave it out for later collection.

The Sanitation District will only pick up the items that fit in your cart. Excess recyclables can be brought to the Recycling Center at no charge. Food waste can also be segregated and brought to the Recycling Center at no charge. Food waste must be loose. No plastic bags and containers. Compostable bags are acceptable.

Christmas tree collection will begin January 4, 2021, weather permitting. Crews will circulate through the City once. If trees are not out when trucks go through, they can be brought directly to the Recycling Center at no charge.

The Recycling Center will be closed on Friday, January 1, 2021 and open Saturday, January 2 from 7 a.m. - 11:45 a.m.
