PRESS RELEASE – MVA w/ Injuries (SOUTH MAIN ST @ BRUSH HILL RD)

On February 17, 2022 at approximately 9:18pm the Middletown Police were dispatched to a two car motor vehicle accident with injuries at the intersection of South Main Street and Brush Hill Road.

South District Fire and two ambulance services (Hunters and Cromwell) responded and treated the occupants. Two patients were transported to Hartford Hospital and three patients were transported to Middlesex Hospital. All parties involved have either been released or remain in stable condition. The case is still under investigation so the occupants are not being identified as this time.

The preliminary investigation suggests that one of the vehicles, a 2013 Nissan Rogue bearing CT BE82364, was traveling eastbound on Brush Hill Road and failed to stop for the stop sign at the intersection of South Main Street. A second vehicle, a 2019 Toyota Corolla bearing MO LH2R3L, was traveling northbound on South Main Street and struck the front passenger side of the Nissan.
