REMARKS

On 12/30/2020 at approximately 1256 hours I, Officer Sinclair responded to the area of 44 Camp Street on the report of a two car motor vehicle collision.

Upon arrival, I spoke with Monique Poitier, the operator of one of the vehicles involved in the collision. A DMV query of Poitier's vehicle, Massachusetts registration plate [redacted] which was affixed to the back of the red 2004 Subaru Legacy, confirmed that the registration did not belong on the Subaru Legacy. Dispatch stated that, the registration belonged on a 2003 Honda Civic registered to Monique Poiter. Dispatch also stated that the registration plate was suspended and revoked due to insurance compliance. This information confirmed that Poitier was in fact misusing the registration plate. I confiscated the resignation plate and placed it into the designated bin to be returned to the Connecticut DMV.

The proper registration for the Subaru Legacy was CT registration [redacted] Dispatch later ran said registration, the vehicle was stated to be registered to [redacted] who was the previous owner. Dispatch also advised me that, the insurance on the vehicle was unconfirmed. I contacted [redacted] via phone. [redacted] advised me that she had traded the Subaru into to Mazda of Manchester sometime during the month of August 2020. [redacted] stated that she was no longer responsible for the vehicle.

It was determined that Poitier was in violation of Connecticut General Statue 14-147(c) Improper use of registration plate, and 14-218a(a) Traveling too fast for conditions. Poitier was issued Misdemeanor Summons #807784 and a court date of April 5, 2021 at 0900 at GA-9 to answer to said charges.

REMARKS


On Sunday, January 3, 2021 at 1556 hours I, Officer Skarzynski was dispatched to the area of Washington Street and High Street for the report of a motor vehicle accident. Upon arrival I observed the two vehicles.

Vehicle-1 was identified as a white 2003 Toyota Echo bearing New Hampshire registration operated by the registered owner later identified via Blue-Link as

Vehicle-2 was identified as a white 2013 Kia Optima bearing Connecticut registration operated by the registered owner later identified by his suspended CT Driver's License as Zayden Flood.

During the course of my investigation it was determined that Vehicle-1, operated by / was at fault. while traveling in a southerly direction on High Street failed to obey the traffic control light at High Street and Washington Street. Vehicle-2, operated by Zayden Flood was traveling in a westerly direction on Washington Street and, with the right of way entered the intersection with High Street. Vehicle-1's front bumper made contact with Vehicle-2's passenger side front and rear door resulting in disabling damage to both vehicles.. Zayden and his passenger, later identified as sustained minor injuries.

Zayden was issued a Misdemeanor Summons (MC 541076) for violating Connecticut General Statute 14-215 Operating a Motor Vehicle with a Suspended License. Zayden was released on a Promise to Appear and is scheduled to appear at Middletown Superior Court on Thursday, April 15, 2021 at 0900 hours. Nothing further.

REMARKS

On Tuesday, December 22, 2020 I, Officer Skarzynski was dispatched to 308 Main Street Extension (CVS) for the initial report suspicious motor vehicle. Central communications reported a white male passed out in a white colored vehicle in the CVS parking lot, the car was in reverse.

Upon arrival I observed the vehicle later identified as a white 2002 Toyota Camry bearing Connecticut registration The vehicle was in the CVS driveway, stopped just prior to entering Main Street Extension.


The only occupant in the car, the driver, was later identified as Patrick Meadows . Witnesses on scene stated Patrick was breathing but currently unconscious. I walked up to the vehicle and banged on the drivers side window in an attempt to wake Patrick up. Patrick did not respond. It should be noted that the vehicle was in reverse but Patrick had his foot on the break. I repositioned my marked police cruiser directly behind the Toyota in case Patrick became conscious he took his foot off the break. Officer Ward, who was also on scene banged on the passenger side window in a further attempt to wake Patrick up. I shined my flashlight into the vehicle and observed Patrick, he was pale white and drooling. I notified Central Communications, requesting an ambulance for a possible drug overdose.

The decision was made to break the passenger side window due to Patrick's current state. Officer Ward was able to break the passenger side window with his baton and gain entry into to the vehicle. Patrick became conscious and was able to turn the car off.

I directed Patrick to unlock his car doors, he complied. I opened up the driver side door, I observed Patrick's eyes which appeared to be glazed over, he was mumbling and drooling on himself. As I open the door Patrick attempted to get out. Patrick put one foot on the ground and fell out of the car, he was able to prop himself up in a sitting position against the driver side rear passenger door.

I asked Patrick if he was OK and/or did he use any narcotics just prior to our arrival. Patrick nodded yes, I observed in Patrick's left hand what was later identified as wax paper folds containing trace amounts of a dark powdery substance that through my training experience known to be used to carry narcotics, i.e. heroin in. Patrick made mention that he had used "10 bags today" stating it was Fentanyl. Patrick happen to be carrying 10 wax paper folds in his left hand. I also observed on the driver side door arm rest, an un-capped hypodermic needle/syringe. There appeared to be fresh blood around the needle portion of the syringe. I then asked Patrick how he ingested his narcotics, he stated he used a needle.

Patrick was issued a Misdemeanor Summons and Complaint (MC 732768), being charged with violating Connecticut General Statute 21a-267 (a) Use of Drug Paraphernalia. Patrick is scheduled to report to Middletown Superior Court, 1 Court Street on Monday, April 5, 2020 at 0900 hours. Patrick was released on a Promise To Appear.

REMARKS

On Saturday, 01/09/21 at approximately 2056 hours, I Ofc Hillman responded to an address in Middletown for a domestic complaint.

Upon arrival, the victim was laying in the parking lot in front of the above address, crying and holding her right arm. The caller, _____ and _____ were with the victim and stated they witnessed Steven Majczak hit her with his vehicle. They also stated neighbors went to their doors to look outside after hearing the disturbance.

The victim was transported by ambulance to Middlesex Hospital.

I spoke with the _____ who provided me with a sworn written statement about the incident. In the statement she said the victim was at her residence when Steven Majczak came to pick her up around 2050 hours and the two got into a loud argument in the parking lot. _____ went outside and witnessed the victim get hit by Steven's car. She said Steven was operating a black Pontiac sedan and he drove off after hitting the victim.

The victim provided me with a sworn written statement about the incident. In the statement the victim said she was at _____ residence when Steven came to pick her up around 2050 hours and the two got into an argument outside. She said the altercation escalated when Steven opened his car door and purposely hit her with it. Then Steven started driving away causing her to be dragged by the door. She said Steven was operating a black Pontiac sedan and drove off after hitting her.

Officers made multiple attempts to contact Steven but had negative results.

I also spoke with the nurse from Middlesex Hospital who stated the victim's injuries are minor and non life-threatening. He said she has a laceration to her right elbow (approximately 6mm long) which she was given stitches for. She was discharged tonight to a family member.

The accused was later located by New Britain PD and consequently arrested and transported to Middletown PD headquarters for processing. Majczak was held in lieu of posting a sixty thousand dollar surety bond pending his arraignment at G9 Middletown on Monday, 01/12/2021, 0900 where he will answer for the **domestic violence charges** of Connecticut General Statutes, 53a-181, Breach of Peace 2nd Degree, 53a-60, Assault 2nd Degree and 14-225, Evading Responsibility.

REMARKS

On Friday, 01/08/2021 at approximately 2129 hours, I, Ofc Hillman responded to an address in Middletown for a domestic call.

Upon arrival, there were two females in the bedroom of the above address arguing. I spoke with Najae White who stated she was arguing with the victim. She said the argument started because the victim isn't appreciative of what she does for them. She stated the altercation became physical and she admitted to pushing the victim and putting her hands around the victim's neck. Najae said she did not apply any pressure or squeeze the victim's neck to strangle her.

Najae was forthcoming with information and cooperative during the entire interaction with officers.

Ofc Travis, Ofc Arroyo and Lt Maturo were also on scene. Officers Travis and Arroyo spoke with the victim who provided them with a sworn written statement about the above incident. In the statement the victim said she was in a verbal argument with Najae and it escalated to Najae pushing her, hitting her, then putting her hands around her neck in the bedroom and hallway of the residence. The victim stated she was still able to breathe when Najae's hands were on her neck (see attached documents for full statement). She also denied having any injuries and refused medical attention.

Ofc Travis gave Nakaylah a Domestic Violence Lethality Screening which Nakaylah did not score as a high-danger victim on. She was also given a victim services card.

Najae was issued a Misdemeanor Summons (MC715923) for a violation of Connecticut General Statute 53a-182, Disorderly Conduct and a Family Violence Conditions of Release form.


