REMARKS

On 12/23/20 at approximately 0909 hours I, Officer Murphy responded to a three car motor vehicle accident in the area of 634 Newfield Street.


Upon my arrival I made contact with one of the involved parties who positively identified himself as Derrick Mcmillan via his valid CT Operators license. While on scene I concluded in my accident investigation that Mcmillan was following too close to the vehicle in front of him ultimately causing him to impact the rear bumper of said vehicle. When I asked Mcmillan for his vehicle's insurance and registration paperwork he informed me that he had neither. Mcmillan stated that he recently purchased his 2008 Nissan Altima bearing CTReg: _____ color blue, and did not have an opportunity to register nor insure it.

Central dispatch confirmed that the above vehicle did not have active insurance at the time and that the registration provided came back on another Nissan Altima. Mcmillan claimed at the time that he was on his way to the DMV to attempt to register his vehicle.

Mcmillan was subsequently issued Misdemeanor Summons #MC455547 for being in violation of C.G.S. 14-213b (Failure to Provide Minimum Insurance), C.G.S. 14-147c (Misuse of Registration Plate), C.G.S. 14-12a* (Operating Unregistered M/V), and C.G.S. 14-240 (Following Too Closely). He is scheduled to appear in Middletown Court on 04/13/21 at 0900 hours.

REMARKS

On 12-15-2020 Middletown Police Street Crime Unit Detectives made contact with Calvin Spivey regarding an active arrest warrant, as he was exiting a parking lot in his car. Upon asking Spivey to exit his vehicle to be handcuffed I asked Spivey if he had anything illegal on him. Spivey admitted to having some "dope" in the car, while motioning toward the open car door.

Det Schriener recovered a number of small white glassine bags, folded in half and bound with a black rubber band under the driver's seat. I know bags such as this are commonly used to package heroin and fentanyl. OFC Scarzinsky searched Spivey and found another bundle of white glassine bags in Spivey's front right pants pocket. There were a total of 10 bags for suspected fentanyl in Spivey's possession.

Based on Spivey's warrant and the narcotics in his possession he was taken into custody. At the police department Spivey was charged with 21a-279(a)(1) possession of a controlled substance and

21a-267 possession of drug paraphernalia on UAR # 8878144. He was given a \$250,000 non-surety bond, but was held due to the \$25,000 court set surety bond in regards to the Warrant.

Spivey's Check showed previous convictions for 21a-277(b(2(A) sale of a controlled substance (numerous counts), 21a-279(a)(1) possession of a controlled substance / narcotics (numerous counts), 53a-32 violation of probation (numerous counts), 54-252 failure to register as a sex offender (numerous counts), 53a-172 failure to appear 1st (numerous counts), 53a-103 burglary 3rd, 53a-124 larceny 3rd, 53-21 risk of injury to a minor and 53a-71 sexual assault in the 2nd. Spivey has numerous pending charges at GA-09 for 21a-279(a)(1) possession of a controlled substance (numerous counts), 21a-278(b(1(B) sale of a hallucinogen (numerous counts), 21-267 possession of drug paraphernalia (numerous counts).


There were three passengers who were all found to be in possession of a controlled substance or drug paraphernalia. All of the passengers were issued warnings for their respective narcotics charges and released from the scene.

At the police department the bags of fentanyl were tested by Detective Peck using NARK kit # 32 showing a positive result.
