REMARKS

On Wednesday, January 6th, 2021, I was dispatched to 133 Church St. for a Motor Vehicle Accident with no apparent injuries. Dispatched indicated that Wesleyan security appears to see the driver of the red vehicle attempting to evade from the scene.

Upon arrival at approximately 0142 hours, I observed car debris and fluid on the asphalt street located in front of the residence 128 Church st. 3 vehicles were with heavy rear and side panel damage located in front of 133 Church St. I observed Ofc. Brooks who was already on scene making contact with a female individual who was seen in a red SUV vehicle with front driver side airbag deployment crying. I immediately checked the scene for safety and continued my investigation. I photographed 3 motor vehicles involved in the accident. I returned to Ofc. Brooks and the female individual. I could hear Ofc. Brooks explain to the female that it would be in her best interest to exit the vehicle to avoid air bag residue inhalation due to the crash. Soon after, Dispatch confirmed the red vehicle bearing CT Reg. 2011 Subaru Outback

color red owned by the female mentioned above. This vehicle owner was positively identified by CT Driver's Lic.# _____ as Lisa Estela.


While speaking with Lisa, I noticed her eyes were bloodshot and glossy. I immediately smelled the strong and distinct odor of an alcoholic beverage emanating from her breath. She stated as she was stumbling around and with a heavily slurred speech, that her and her husband had gotten into a verbal dispute and she left in her car very angrily. Lisa also appeared unsteady on her feet. Ofc. Brooks asked, Lisa if she's been drinking. Lisa responded "I had a couple." I asked Lisa, how many is a couple. She stated "just 2." At this point, Lisa decided to call her husband during our investigation. It was recommended by Ofc. Brooks and I she discontinue the conversation and hand over the phone. Lisa indeed handed over the phone to Ofc. Brooks. Ofc. Brooks came back to confirm with me that her husband acknowledged that they have both recently consumed alcoholic beverages throughout the night. Due to the previously mentioned observations, which I knew Lisa to be heavily impaired due to said consumption. In addition, Wesleylan security called at 0140 a.m hours and distinctly pointed out that this woman in question driving this said vehicle in question hit 2 parked cars. Due to the facts and circumstances of this investigation, Lisa made impact with her vehicle which latched on to motor vehicle bearing CT Reg.# _____ (minivan) from 128 Church St. and dragged approximately 40 feet, impacting motor vhehicle CT Reg.# _____ 2014 Mazda from the rear. I asked Lisa if she would be willing to submit to a standardized field sobriety test and she agreed.

Probable cause to Arrest

Based on Lisa's operation of the motor vehicle involved in an accident, the personal contact I had with her, the smell of an alcoholic beverage on her person and breath, her performance on the field sobriety tests and her and husband's admission to consuming alcoholic beverages prior to operating her vehicle, Lisa later was issued a bedside misdemeanor summons at Middlesex Hospital for Driving under the influence of alcohol and/or drugs. Sgt. D'aresta on scene advised me that Hunters ambulance will be responding to this said location to provide medical treatment to Lisa. Upon Hunters arrival, Lisa got infuriated by the seen of the ambulance that she shouted out "I will kill myself when I get out" multiple times. At this point, at approximately 0225 a.m hours, I decided to Police Request for Emergency Evaluation (PREE) for suicidal ideations/thoughts. I followed Hunter's ambulance to Middlesex Hospital.

At Middlesex hospital, I kept Lisa under close observation and saw that she was irritable and disheveled. At 0246 a.m hours, I read Lisa her Notice and Wavier of Rights. I then asked if she understood her rights. She stated that she did but refused to sign any paperwork. I Ofc. Thomas read the implied consent on the A-44 form and was given an opportunity to contact an attorney at 0244 a.m hours. Lisa did not have the information readily available and could not contact an attorney. Lisa would not answer any question and refused to submit to a breath test at 0245 a.m hours. Her refusal was witnessed by Ofc. Zadjura.

Lisa was later processed for the violation of CGS 14-227B (Driving Under the Influence of Alcohol) and 14-236 (Failure to Maintain Proper Lane). She was issued a Misdemeanor Summons # 808431, \$500 non-surety bond and is scheduled to appear in court on April 6,2021 at GA9 located at 1 Court St. this city at 0900 hours. Lisa was given a copy of her Breath test refusal at 0536 hours on January 6,2021. Lisa's driver's license was revoked for 24 hours. The Revocation form was completed and placed with her driver's license at the front desk at Headquarters.


