REMARKS

On 01/22/2021 at approximately 1835 HRS, I (Officer Van Almkerk) was on routine patrol traveling south on Pease Avenue. In front of my vehicle was a 2020 Nissan Altima (Bearing FL registration also traveling south on Pease Avenue. At the intersection of Pease Avenue and Spring Street, the operator of

the aforementioned vehicle failed to use a turn signal and come to a complete stop at the posted stop sign. These acts are in violation of Connecticut General Statute (CGS) 14-242 and 14-301. The vehicle began to travel east on Spring Street, and at the intersection of Spring Street and Main Street, the operator once again failed to use a turn signal and come to a complete stop at the posted stop sign. I continued to follow the vehicle and initiated a motor vehicle stop in the area of Route 9 north and exit 16 Hartford Avenue.

It should be noted; I initially observed the vehicle within 1500 feet (196.80 feet) of 66 Spring Street Washington Street (Macdonough Elementary School).

Upon approaching the passenger side of the vehicle, I smelled the strong and distinct odor of marijuana emanating from within. I was able to identify the odor of marijuana from previous training and experience. From previous investigations, I positively identified the operator as _____ the front seat passenger as _____ and seated behind _____ in the back seat was Jabbar McDaniel. Through those previous investigations, I know _____ and McDaniel are G-Shine Bloods gang members.

I asked _____ for his driver's license, vehicle registration, and proof of insurance. Once provided, I asked _____ to step out of the vehicle and secured him in handcuffs. In _____ jacket pocket I located a tightly twisted sandwich bag containing a green leafy bud like substance. I identified the substance as suspected marijuana from previous training and experience.

I proceeded to ask McDaniel to step out of the vehicle and secured him in handcuffs. In McDaniel's pant pocket I located a tightly twisted sandwich bag containing an off white rock like substance. Further inspection revealed the off white rock substance was individually separated and packaged. I identified the substance as suspected crack cocaine through previous training and experience.

Officer St. Peter asked _____ to step out of the vehicle and secured him in handcuffs. During the search of his person, _____ was not found to be in possession of a controlled substance or a weapon.

No one in the vehicle was found to be in possession of a Connecticut Medical Marijuana Program Certificate.

It should be noted; during the search of the vehicle and occupants, I did not locate any paraphernalia indicating _____ or McDaniel use crack cocaine. Normally, when individuals who ingest/consume crack cocaine, I will locate a cylindrical glass "crack pipe".

_____ was issued a written warning for violation of CGS 14-242 Failure to Give Proper Turn Signal, CGS 14-301 Failure to Stop at Posted Stop Sign, and 21a-279a(a)1 Possession of Less Than 1/2 Ounce of Marijuana.

Utilizing a NARK 2005 Testing Kit, the suspected marijuana tested positive for the presumptive presence of THC, the active chemical in marijuana. The combined weight of the marijuana was 2.04 grams.

Utilizing a NIK Wipe, the suspected crack cocaine tested positive for the presumptive presence of cocaine. The sandwich bag contained eight individually packaged parcels of crack cocaine, and had a combined weight of 3.04 grams. The street value of the crack cocaine was determined to be \$304.00 if sold at \$10.00 per .1 gram.

The large quantity of crack cocaine found was far more than an individual would have for personal use, and is indicative of illicit drug sales. Furthermore, how the illicit drugs were separated and packaged made it evident McDaniel is directly involved in the sale of crack cocaine.

A check of McDaniel's Connecticut criminal history revealed previous convictions for violation of CGS 21a-279(a)(1) Possession of Controlled Substance, CGS 53a-108 Criminal Trespass 2nd, CGS 53a-125 Larceny 4th, CGS 53a-103 Burglary 3rd, CGS 53a-125 Larceny 4th.

A check of McDaniel's conviction history revealed no previous convictions.

McDaniel was charged with violation of CGS 21a-279(a)(1) Possession of Controlled Substance, CGS 21a-279(b) Possession of Controlled Substance within 1500 Feet, CGS 21a-278(b) Possession of Controlled Substance with Intent to Sell by Non-Drug Dependent Person, and CGS 21-278a(b) Possession of Controlled Substance with Intent to Sell within 1,500 Feet. McDaniel was released on a \$25,000 surety bond and is scheduled to appear at GA-9 Middletown Superior Court on 04/14/2021 at approximately 0900 HRS.

Hernandez had been convicted of violation of Connecticut General Statute (CGS) 14-224(b) Evading, CGS 53-21(2) Illegal Sexual Conduct (Criminal offense against a victim who is a minor), CGS 53a-73a Sex Assault 4, CGS 53a-70 Sex Assault 1 (2 Times) and 53a-125b Larceny 6 (2 Times).

An indicated Hernandez had no previous convictions.

Hernandez was charged with violation of CGS 53a-62 Threatening 2nd, CGS 53a-181 Breach of Peace 2nd, CGS 53a-64 Reckless Endangerment 2nd and CGS 53a-167a Interfering.
