REMARKS

On 1/28/2021, at approximately 13:47 hours, I, Officer Foss-Rugan along with other Middletown Police Department officers responded to an address in Middletown, CT for a physical domestic disturbance.

Upon my arrival, I exited my patrol vehicle and could hear a lot of yelling which was coming from the rear of the residence. I walked around the west side of the residence where I made contact with the accused, Alejandro Ortiz. Ortiz was very animated and visibly upset. Ortiz explained that his younger brother who will be referred to as Juvenile #1 for the remainder of this report is extremely disrespectful to him. Ortiz said that he constantly causes problems with him and he is sick of it. I asked Ortiz if anyone was involved in a physical altercation and he said that he and Juvenile #1 were, "wrestling around like brother's do".

I then made contact with Ortiz's mother who will be referred to as witness #1. Witness #1 said that Ortiz is constantly being rude to her and if he is not happy with what she is making for food, he makes rude comments towards her. Witness #1 said just prior to her calling the police, Ortiz was causing problems and further that she told him he needed to get out. Witness #1 said what she meant by this was that Ortiz needed to leave the residence before things escalated. Witness #1 said that Ortiz refused to leave the residence and that is when Juvenile #1 intervened and told him he needed to go. Witness #1 said that Ortiz got up and wrapped his arms around Juvenile #1's upper shoulder area and began wrestling him the ground in the kitchen. Witness #1 said she then called 911 for help at which time Ortiz got up and left the residence.

Juvenile #1 reported that Ortiz is constantly causing problems within the house. Juvenile #1 said that Ortiz is very disrespectful towards their mother (Witness #1). Juvenile #1 said he heard Ortiz ask Witness #1 what she was making for food and he was not happy with it. Juvenile #1 said that Ortiz started making rude comments towards Witness #1. Juvenile #1 said that Witness #1 told Ortiz that he needed to be out and Ortiz continued to refuse to leave. Juvenile #1 said he heard Ortiz tell Witness #1 that he did not care if the cops came. Juvenile #1 said he told Ortiz if he did not leave like Witness #1 wanted him to he would remove him from the residence. Juvenile #1 said Ortiz then put his arms around his shoulders and pulled him to the ground causing him to fall into the kitchen portable island. Juvenile #1 said that Ortiz was wrestling with him and caused his right elbow to get cut open. Juvenile #1 said that Ortiz's zipper on his shirt caused his face to get scraped causing abrasions.


I advised Ortiz that he was being arrested for the domestic.

When Ortiz was secured in the cage area of the cruiser, he intentionally smashed his face/head into the plexiglass which separates the front of the cruiser from the back seat. Officer Owens transported Ortiz to Middletown Police Department where he was processed by Officer Peck. Ortiz was charged with 53a-61- Assault in the third degree and 53a-182- Disorderly Conduct. A Family Conditions of Release was completed with CT01, CT03, CT05, do not use or possess a dangerous weapon and do not use or possess an intoxicant or controlled substance being checked.

Ortiz was released from custody on a \$2,500 non-surety bond and was issued a court date of 1/29/2021 at 09:00 hours at Middlesex Superior Court.

REMARKS

On 1/28/21 at approximately 1731 hours I, Officer St. Peter, responded to a location in Middletown (a multifamily apartment building) for the report of a domestic. Dispatch advised the caller was a third party, who was on the phone with Victim1. Dispatch stated according to the caller the incident sounded physical. Officer Travis and Officer Bloom also responded.

Upon arrival I could hear yelling coming from the building. I opened the common door and could hear a male yelling. I then heard a female voice say "they are here". The apartment was on the second floor of the

building. As I got to the second floor the female (Victim1) was standing in the doorway and said "he's trying to go out the back". I entered the apartment and saw a male (Glendo Burch) attempting to exit the residence. I told him to stop and moved towards him. He came back into the apartment (Kitchen area). I observed a large hunting knife on a glass table, within arms reach of Burch. Based on the knife I moved in quickly, grabbed onto Burch, detained him in handcuffs and moved him away from the knife. I attempted to remove him from the apartment so I could conduct my investigation. As I was walking him out he attempted to pull away from me on three separate occasions. He was removed from the apartment and sat on the stairs inside the building. I ran his name and date of birth. This inquiry revealed three (3) standing criminal protective orders (CT01, CT03, CT05) listing Burch as the respondent and Victim1 as the protected person.

Based on the orders Burch was advised he was under arrest. As I walked him out he again attempted to pull away from me numerous times. He said "I'm not going to fucking jail" and attempted to pull away as we got to my vehicle. He was unsuccessful in his attempt to pull away from me and he was seated in the backseat of my vehicle.

Officer Travis took a statement from Victim1. The statement details Burch being at the residence when Victim1 returned home.

While I was transporting Burch to Middletown Police Headquarters, he said he was in the ARMY for 20 years. He then said "I'm a born killer, I'm gonna kill her, snap her neck, matter of fact I'm gonna snap everyone's neck, I'm gonna snap your neck". I asked if he had just made a treat and he said "I'm gonna snap your neck, I'm a born killer".

Burch was charged with the violations of CGS: 53a-223a Violation of a standing criminal protective order (3) counts, 53a-62 Threatening in the 2nd degree, and 53a-167(a) Interfering with police. He is scheduled to appear at GA09 in Middletown on 1/29/21 and was held on a \$500,000 surety bond.
