On 2/5/2021 I, Officer Wade, was assigned to evening shift patrol.

On this date I was dispatched to the Middletown Police Department lobby for a walk-in complaint. I met with the complainant, VICTIM, and we proceeded to the MPD interview room. VICTIM informed me that on 2/4/21 she and Sean Robotham (the father of her one year old child) were sending messages back and forth in regards to a rental car he wanted back from her. VICTIM stated that Robotham had two rental cars and let her use one of them. VICTIM stated they had a verbal agreement about using the rental, but now Robotham wanted to "stir things up." VICTIM showed me numerous messages between she and contact name and phone number area code 321-***** in regards to the rental and other issues. VICTIM explained that she was the account holder of that phone number and now blocked the number from sending or receiving calls, but that Robotham has more than one cellphone.

VICTIM stated on 2/5/21 around 1050hours she received a message from another female that Robotham has a child with, i. I obtained a sworn written statement from VICTIM which stated the following;

"I, VICTIM (D.O.B 8/13/85,) have a one year old child with Sean Robotham On 2/4/21 around 2030hrs until about 0100hrs Robotham and I were texting back and forth in regards to a rental car he wanted back from me. On the morning of 2/5/2021 I woke up to a missed call from another female that Robotham has a child by. I called FEMALE back around 1154hrs. said "I don't want to be in the middle but Sean called me and said call my white cock sucking baby mother and tell her I'm on my way from Enfield and she better give me my rental when I get there or I will burn the house down with her and her kids in there. I don't give a fuck about her or her kids." FEMALE then said Sean said this about an hour ago and she recommended I leave the home just in case he comes there. I then left my home with my kids. I went to the court house and filed a restraining order. I was only going to go to the court house

but I listened to a voicemail from 1041hrs on this date and it was Sean saying "I'm on my way to your house so make sure the fucking cops are there bitch. My rental better be at my fucking house word to my mother my nigga I'll burn that shit down with you and your kids in there I don't give a fuck." I then decided I needed to go to the police department and file a report.

I know Sean has a history of being physically violent with the other mothers of his children and has two pending domestic violence case. Sean has also been physical with me in the past. I am scared about filing a police report because I think he will retaliate if he is released or not arrested today. I would like to press charges against Sean Robotham."

VICTIM emailed me photographs of she and Robotham sending messages on 2/4/21 as well as a voicemail of Robotham saying "'I'm on my way to your house so make sure the fucking cops are there bitch. My rental better be at my fucking house word to my mother my nigga I'll burn that shit down with you and your kids in there I don't give a fuck."

VICTIM informed me that Robotham was currently at his fathers' house in Hartford, CT. I reached out to Hartford PD requesting verification that Robotham was at that address. I received notification that Hartford officers made contact with Robotham. I informed officers that I would be doing a full custodial arrest on Robotham, and Detective Stroud and I met up with officers at Hartford Public Safety Complex. I placed Robotham in properly fitted handcuffs, placed him in my cruiser, and transported him to Middletown PD Headquarters.

While at headquarters, Robotham stated they were going back and forth about his rental car. Robotham stated he let VICTIM use the rental car on 2/3/2021 and on 2/4/2021 he requested she give the vehicle back. Robotham stated she was not cooperative in giving the vehicle back. I asked Robotham about making statements in regards to burning her house down with the kids inside. Robotham said "I didn't mean that dumb shit" and again during our conversation stated he said it but did not mean it. Robotham explained that he was frustrated with VICTIM because of the rental car which contributed to him making the threatening statement.

It should be noted that Robotham had two cellphones in his possession at the time of this arrest. I asked Robotham how many phones he had and he stated three. I further asked Robotham about the 321 area code phone number and told him I saw the message between he and VICTIM. Robotham said each phone is on through a different mother of his child and the "321" number in the text messages I read were through VICTIM phone account. I also asked why VICTIM had his "321" number under the contact and inquired on who was. Robotham stated that was his daughter and showed me a tattoo of the name on his arm.

Robotham was charged with violation of C.G.S. 53a-61aa - Threatening in the First Degree. Robotham was released after posting a \$25,000 surety bond. Robotham was bonded out by Wilfredo Diaz - Surety Bail Bond Agent. A Criminal Appearance Bond Form was completed. Robotham is scheduled to appear at

On 2/6/2021 at 0114 hours, Sergeant D. Puorro, Officer Ceccolini, K-9 Officer A. Smith and I responded to an address in Middletown on the report of a domestic disturbance.

Middletown Police Dispatch advised that the complainant, Female Victim #1 reported her daughter Karina Gaynor told her and was breaking and throwing items within the house. No injuries were reported.

Upon arrival, I made my way to the second floor apartment unit up a flight of stairs which entered into the kitchen. Female Victim #1 and Karina were separated and the scene was calm. Karina was observed through an open bedroom door on a bed which was located directly off the kitchen. There were numerous household items strewn about the bedroom into the kitchen. There was a trash bag containing broken glass.

I made contact with Female Victim #1 who informed me that Karina had returned home highly intoxicated and was having behavioral problems. Female Victim #1 stated that Karina was throwing items such as pillows, blankets, clothing and personal items around the bedroom and out into the kitchen. Female Victim #1 stated that during Karina's tantrum a small television was purposely knocked off television stand. It was not determined if the television was broken.

Female Victim #1 stated that she did not wish to have Karina arrested she merely wanted her removed for the remainder of the evening so she could sober up. Female Victim #1 stated that Karina has a history of abusing and she believes she needs to seek treatment and counseling for her alcohol abuse.

I made contact with Karina who was still seated on the mattress which did not have a sheet upon it. Karina appeared highly intoxicated and disheveled. When asking Karina questions about the incident that led to the Police response

On 2/6/21 at approximately 2153 hours I, Officer St. Peter, responded to a location in Middletown for the report of a domestic disturbance. Dispatch advised the male was throwing items in the residence. Upon arrival the male party involved (David Brown) was sitting on the front porch of the residence. He stated he had a verbal argument with his girlfriend (Victim1). Brown stated the argument was heated but never became physical. Brown denied throwing anything in the residence. Brown was clearly intoxicated (slurred speech, blood shot and glossy eyes).

Victim1 provided a sworn written statment which details Brown arriving home intoxicated, verbally arguing whith her, throwing and breaking a cast iron stove grate during the argument and fearing he may become physical.

I observed that the cast iron grate to the stove had been broken in two peices. I also observed damage to the tile floor, in the area where Victim1 stated the grate had been thrown. The damage appeared to be made by an item consistent with the shape of the grate.

I questioned Brown about the damage to the grate and the floor. He stated the grate and the floor had been damaged. He stated his landlord could confirm the damage was old.

Based on the statment and visible damage, Brown was issued MSC #MC716043 for violation of CGS 53a-182 Disorderly conduct. He was issued a court date of 2/8/21 at GA09 in Middletown. Conditions of release were filled out and signed by Brown.
