On 2/10/2021 at 2312 hours, Middletown Police responded to an address in Middletown on the report of a physical domestic dispute.

Middletown Police Dispatch advised that the reporting party stated her son Male Victim #1 was in a verbal argument with his girlfriend Cheyenne Dickinson. Dickinson ultimately ended up becoming physical and struck Male Victim #1 in the face.

On scene, Cheyenne Dickinson identified herself by her valid Connecticut operators license number Dickinson who was visibly upset and crying; was forthcoming and stated she had been involved in an argument with her boyfriend Male Victim #1. Dickinson stated that the argument was verbal in nature but she punched Male Victim #1 in the face. I asked Dickinson if Male Victim #1 had become physical with her and she said he had not but he has in the past.

Dickinson stated she was uninjured. I did not observe any signs of injury on Dickinson's person that would lead me to believe that she had been physically assaulted or struck.

Dickinson was detained and placed into department issued handcuffs that were double locked and checked for proper fit. Dickinson was placed into the prisoner compartment of Marked Police Cruiser 1501 and escorted back to the scene.

I made contact with Male Victim #1 who was inside the residence with his mother seated at the kitchen

island. Upon viewing Male Victim #1, I observed that the right side of his face was reddened and appeared to be slightly swollen. Male Victim #1 stated that he was uninjured but he had been struck in the face by Dickinson.

~~Male Victim #1 stated that he and Dickinson were in a dating relationship that was not working out.~~ Male Victim #1 stated that Dickinson had been drinking often and had been very angry with mood swings. Male Victim #1 stated that he had asked Dickinson not to come to his residence on 2/10/2021 because he did not want to deal with her excessive alcohol consumption and erratic behavior. Dickinson ended up showing up to Male Victim #1's residence uninvited while only the caller was home. The caller initially did not allow Dickinson into the residence but after persistent knocking at the door and yelling she allowed her in.

Male Victim #1 stated that The caller informed him that Dickinson was at the residence and he came straight home. Male Victim #1 stated that when he arrived home Dickinson was in a drunken rage throwing some personal items around his bedroom. Dickinson asked her to stop and to leave his house. The verbal argument escalated with Dickinson ultimately striking Male Victim #1 on the right side of his face with her fist. Male Victim #1 stated that he backed away from Dickinson and returned to the kitchen with his mother and asked her to call the police.

The caller stated that Male Victim #1 had asked her not to let Dickinson into his house because they were not getting along and he did not feel comfortable having her over. The caller stated that when Dickinson arrived at the residence uninvited she began banging at the door and yelling creating a scene. The caller eventually allowed Dickinson into the residence to keep Dickinson from making too much of a disturbance.

Once inside the residence Dickinson went upstairs to Male Victim #1's bedroom throwing items about. When Male Victim #1 arrived home he asked Dickinson to leave the residence and became involved in a verbal argument with her. When Male Victim #1 returned to the kitchen he informed the caller that Dickinson had struck him in the face and asked her to contact the Police.

Dickinson was issued Misdemeanor ~~Summons~~ and Complaint MC808423 for violation of C.G.S. 53a-182 - Disorderly Conduct and Released on a \$2,500 non surety bond. Dickinson is due to appear at GA-9 Middlesex Superior Court on 2/11/2021 at 0900 hours to answer to the above charges. Dickinson was issued a Family Violence Conditions of Release with the following conditions.

- CT01 – Do not assault threaten abuse, harass, follow, interfere with, or stalk the protected person.
- CT03 – Stay away from the home of the protected person and wherever the protected person shall reside.
- CT05 – Do not contact the protected person in any manner, including by written, electronic or telephone, and do not person's home, workplace or others.
