### Charges

1: 53a-223b (CRIM VIO OF RESTRAINING ORDER)

On 02/23/2021, at approximately 2234 hours, I responded to an address in Middletown for a report of a violation of a restraining order.

Upon arrival, contact was made with Victim # 1. Victim # 1 stated that she has an active restraining order against William Gaspie. Victim # 1 reported that the terms of the order indicate Gaspie is not to have any contact with her.

Victim # 1 reported that on 02/23/2021, at 1504 hours, she received an e-mail on her cell phone from William Gaspie. Gaspie sent the e-mail from his gmail e-mail account to their shared msn e-mail account. Victim # 1 reported that Gaspie is aware she has access to this shared e-mail account from her cell phone. Victim # 1 stated that Gaspie's e-mail sent to her contained a picture that said "best wishes". Victim # 1 believed that Gaspie sent this to her because she recently had surgery. Victim # 1 stated that Gaspie has sent her other e-mails in the past on her shared e-mail account, also violating the order, but that they have since been deleted by Gaspie. Victim # 1 provided me with a sworn written statement regarding this incident and forwarded me a copy of the e-mail she had received.

indicated that there was an active restraining order on file listing William Gaspie as the respondent and Victim # 1 as the protected party. The conditions of the restraining order are as follows: Do not to assault, threaten, abuse, harass, follow, interfere with, or stalk the protected person (CT01), Stay away from the home of the protected person and wherever the protected person shall reside (CT03), Do not contact the protected person in any manner, including by written, electronic or telephone, and do not contact the protected person's home, workplace or others with whom the contact would be

likely to cause annoyance or alarm to the protected person (CT05), Respondent may return to the protected person's home one time with police to retrieve belongings (CT14), Stay 100 yards from the protected person (CT16) and Surrender or transfer all firearms or ammunition (CTF).

Contact was made with Gaspie who confirmed that he sent the above email message. Gaspie indicated that he did not intend to send the e-mail to Victim # 1 and was attempting to send it to his sister instead. Gaspie stated he was aware of the no contact restraining order.

Officers made contact with Gaspie at the Carrier Motor Lodge, located at 2660 Berlin Tpke in Newington, CT, inside room # 144. Gaspie was advised that he was under arrest for Criminal Violation of a Restraining Order. Gaspie was transported to this department for processing.

Gaspie was processed and charged with Criminal Violation of a Restraining Order in violation of C.G.S. 53a-223b. Gaspie is being held on a \$10,000 cash/surety bond. Gaspie is scheduled to appear before Middletown Superior Court GA-9 on 02/24/2021, at 0900 hours.
