REMARKS

On 11/27/20 at approximately 0909 hours, I, Ofc. Passacantando responded to a two car motor vehicle accident with injuries at the intersection of Route 9 South and Hartford Avenue. Upon arrival my investigation revealed that CT Reg was on a 2004 Kia Sorento color black. The plate came back to a 2015 Jeep Grand Cherokee and was a misused plate. The Kia Sorento was traveling southbound on route 9 and went through the red traffic light at Hartford Avenue and struck another vehicle.


The Kia Sorento was being operated by John Botts, Botts stated he was driving south on Route 9 and the light turned red. He was unable to stop before the light and hit the car that was driving into the intersection.

Botts stated the vehicle has insurance and was able to provide me with valid insurance for the vehicle. A DMV check of Botts driver's license revealed his driving privileges were suspended. Botts admitted the plates on the vehicle were taken off another vehicle.

Botts was issued a misdemeanor summons and complaint (#188892) for C.G.S. 14-299 "failure to obey traffic control signal," 14-215 "operating a motor vehicle with a suspended license," and 14-147(c) "misuse of plates."

Botts has a scheduled court date of 04/13/21 at GA09 Middletown at 0900 hours.

Upon arrival, officers observed three people standing on the sidewalk while yelling at two females who were sitting inside of a vehicle. Officers separated all parties involved and interviewed them.

Ofc. DiFonzo spoke with the two females seated in the car. They were identified as Kyleen Rivera and . While Ofc. DiFonzo met with them, I spoke with the three other individuals standing on the sidewalk .

Rivera advised she was sitting in the car when she saw walking into the apartment building. She exited the vehicle and approached asking her if she wanted to fight. On 3/5/21 at 1507 hour Officer Ward investigated a disturbance at 36 Walnut St. His investigation revealed that Brandon Bell was Emotionally Disturbed and appeared to be under the influence of PCP. On 3/7/2021 at approximately 0123 hours I, Officer Sinclair responded an undisclosed location on the report of a domestic disturbance. Sergeant D'Areata was the assisting officer. The accused David Benson left on foot.

I spoke to Victim #1 who stated that she was punched in the face, pinned down, restrained and choked by Benson. It should be noted, three children were present and also witnessed the incident. In viewing the areas on Victim #1's body that were not covered by clothing, I observed blood coming from the area of Victim #1's mouth as she cried. Victim #1's neck displayed red bruising accompanied by multiple scratch marks around the neck area, which indicated that she had been grabbed by the neck at some point during a physical altercation. Both Benson and Victim #1 were ran via dispatch for court orders, dispatch advised me that there were no orders between the two on file.

On 3/7/2020 at approximately 0305 hours, I made contact with Benson via phone. When questioned about the altercation between he and Victim #1. Benson admitted to striking Victim #1. Benson advised me that he did not punch Victim #1 with a closed fist, however stated that he slapped Victim #1 in the mouth a few times. Benson said that he also wrestled around on the bed with Victim #1 prior to choking her as well as punching her in the rib area a couple of times before leaving the apartment.

During the daytime hours on 3/7/2021, Benson arrived at the Middletown Police front lobby and turned
