On 03/10/21 officers responded to 15 East Lake Drive for an emotionally disturbed person who was currently in crisis.

While on scene officers called via the two way radio and requested a third officer to respond. On arrival this officer was informed by officer(s) on scene that a third person, the accused Jeffery Roller who was identified through his CTDL had been interjecting into the incident which was causing the emotional person to escalate his behavior towards officers. Roller had spoken to the emotional person via cell phone while officers were on scene and he was told to not interfere with what was going on and that his assistance was not needed.

Roller had been told repeatedly to stop interjecting and when he did arrive on scene he was again told to stay away and to not come onto the property by officers and the home owner.

After my arrival on scene Roller again got out of his vehicle and challenged officers which in turn made to emotional person escalate towards officers. The emotional person had been reported to have grabbed kitchen knives several times and put them back. Due to the report of Covid 19 and that the emotional person was not feeling well he had not been patted down immediately.

Roller continued to challenge officers and refused to stop interjecting which escalated the emotional person. Roller was told to get into his car and leave, because he was causing the emotional person to escalate his behavior. Roller refused to leave, as this was happening another officer was able to finally pat down the emotional person with the assistance of the ambulance crew.
