On 03/18/21 at approximately 0335 hours, Officer Pellegrini and I, Officer Murphy were dispatched to an address in Middletown for an unwanted party. The caller, Victim One reported to central dispatch that her "friend" Bryant Bernale who stays with her occasionally, would not leave. Victim One informed dispatch that Bernale was allegedly yelling at her and threatening to injure her if she did not let him in. Sgt. D' Aresta and Officer Sinclair additionally responded to the scene to provide assistance.

Upon our arrival we made contact with Victim One outside, who stated that she wanted Bernale, her ex boyfriend, to leave. Victim One added that she believed Bernale was under the influence of drugs at the time and was becoming violent towards her. Victim One stated that she was sleeping when Bernale tapped on her window, waking up both her and her dog. Victim One stated that when she opened the door, Bernale came in and immediately began arguing with her. As the verbal argument escalated, Victim One stated that Bernale walked closer to her in an aggressive manner and placed his left hand up to her cheek, and lightly striking it in a chopping motion. Victim One stated that when Bernale made this motion she said she was going to call the police, to which he replied "Go ahead I did 11 years I don't care. I'll put you in the hospital." Victim One detailed that she feared imminent injury at the time and was able to leave the apartment and call the police. Victim One stated she was uninjured as a result of the incident, however she was very concerned that Bernale would hurt her.

I subsequently spoke to Bernale who stated that he came home late from a friends house and was attempting to wake his ex girlfriend (Victim One) to get inside. Bernale stated that when Victim One answered the door she was verbally hostile towards him which lead to an argument between them. Bernale denied ever making any physical contact with Victim One, and ensured us that the incident was verbally only. Bernale additionally

denied threatening any violence towards Victim One. Bernale admitted to verbally arguing over coming home late, however stated he would sleep in the hallway to avoid further confrontation.

We determined on scene that based on the above domestic incident, there was sufficient probable cause to arrest Bernale for being in violation of C.G.S. 53a-182 (Disorderly Conduct), and 53a-62 (Threatening 2nd). Bernale was placed in custody and transported to Middletown Police Headquarters for processing. While at police headquarters Bernale was positively identified in our in house system, and read his Notice of Rights at 0448 hours which he freely signed and agreed to. Bernale is being held in Middletown Police custody on a \$5,000 Surety bond and is scheduled to appear in Middletown Court (GA#9) on 03/18/21 at approximately 0900 hours. It should be noted that a [redacted] inquiry revealed that Bernale has numerous violent convictions on his record including 53a-54c (Murder 1st Degree) and 53a-60 (Assault 2nd Degree).
