On 3/25/2021 at approximately 2102hrs Officers were dispatched to a residence in Middletown for a report of a possible physical domestic. The victim in the domestic (Hereby referred to as Victim 1) was reportedly on the phone with a friend and told them that she was getting beaten up by Michael Mclean. Dispatch stated the phone call also disconnected so they did not have any further information regarding the possible physical domestic disturbance.

Upon our arrival Officers found the door to the first floor apartment was unlocked. Yelling could also be heard inside. After opening the door Officers were immediately confronted with Mclean who was verbally and physically confrontational. Mclean attempted to push Officers out and repeatedly yelled "Get the FUCK out!" Through prior law enforcement interactions Officers are aware that Mclean is in the Ruthless For Life motorcycle gang and is frequently involved with drugs and weapons. Mclean quickly approached Officer Nettis and I while yelling " Get the FUCK out of my house. FUCK you! Get the FUCK out you need a warrant!" Officers gave Mclean numerous loud verbal commands to turn around and place his hands behind his back. After a brief struggle Officers were able to detain him in handcuffs.

Officers tried speaking with Mclean about the incident but he was uncooperative and refused to speak with Officers. Victim 1 (OR V1) stated she had gone out to the La Boca Restaurant with Mclean where they had both been drinking. Once they got home he asked her where his new pack of cigarettes was. She told him she put them on the dresser. Mclean told her that they were not there and began to get angry. V1 stated she walked over to her dresser and grabbed the cigarettes then threw them into the living room where he was standing. Mclean told her to pick them up but she refused and told him to pick them up himself. She walked over to the couch and sat down. In front of the couch was a 3' x 3' square heavy

wooden coffee table. V1 stated Mclean walked over in front of the coffee table and flipped the table toward her. The table spun in the air and the top table portion landed on her head and face causing her nose to bleed. This officer also observed blood droplets on her legs and dress.

I then asked if she would provide me with a voluntary sworn written statement but she stated she did not want to do that. stated "I will tell you what happened but I don't feel like giving a statement".

Michael Mclean was read his rights, processed, photographed. He was charged with violation of CGS 53a-182 Disorderly Conduct and 53a-61 Assault 3rd Degree. Mclean posted the \$25,000 Bond and assigned a next day court date of 3/26/2021 at 0900hrs. He was told he would have to appear at the GA 9 Court House on that date and time. He stated he understood.

Mclean was also issued a Family Violence Conditions of Release with conditions CT01, CT03, and CT05. Additionally conditions stating "Do not possess a dangerous weapon" and "Do not use or possess an intoxicant or controlled substance" were also imposed. The conditions of release was entered into the Collect/ NCIC system by central dispatch on 3/25/2021 at approximately 2315hrs.

On 3/21/21 at approximately 2157 hours, dispatch advised officers to be on the lookout for a black Jeep Wrangler which was traveling eastbound on Washington St in the westbound travel lane, towards Main St. The caller was from Hunter's Ambulance and stated that they suspected the operator was under the influence.

Officer Van Almkerk and I, Officer St. Peter, were parked at the intersection of Main St and Washington St. A black Jeep Wrangler, bearing CT reg. turned right onto Main St (southbound) from Washington St. We drove behind the vehicle for a short distance observing the operation of the vehicle. The vehicle was in the right lane. The operator drifted towards the right and crossed over marked parking stalls on Main St. The vehicle drifted back into the right lane then abruptly pulled into a parking stall near Pedal Power on Main St. We pulled our police vehicle behind the Jeep and activated our emergency lights.

I approached the driver side of the vehicle to speak with the operator, who was positively identified as Alyssa Rajcula. I observed a in a glass in the cup holder of the vehicle (which I later determined to contain an alcoholic beverage). As I spoke with Rajcula I observed that her eyes were bloodshot and glossy. Her speech was slurred. I requested Rajcula provide me with her license, registration and insurance. She had trouble focusing on these basic tasks. I asked Rajcula where she was headed to. She pointed to La Boca and slurred "La Boca". La Boca is a local bar on Main St. I asked here she was coming from and she slurred "75 Center" which is a local bar in Southington. I asked her how much she had to drink. She slurred that she had "one drink". I asked if she had any medical conditions. She stated she did not. I requested she submit to a standardized field sobriety test. She stated she would take the test. I

requested she step out of the vehicle, which she did.

I requested she stand in front of her vehicle on the level sidewalk on the west side of Main St. Rajcula was unsteady on her feet while she walked to the front of the vehicle.

Rajcula did not preform the tests to standard.

Based on the call for service, my observation of Rajcula's operation, my observations of Rajcula while she was still in her vehicle and the standardized field sobriety test, I placed Rajclua in handcuffs and advised her she was under arrest. She was seated in the rear of our police vehicle and transported to Middletown Police Headquarters.

I advised Rajcula of her rights at 2223 hours. I read her the implied consent advisory and afforded her an opportunity to call an attorney at 2226 hours. I requested she submit to a breath test. Rajcula stated she would take the test.

The first test was administered at 2234 hours with a result of 0.2587. The second test was administered at 2254 with a result of 0.2438.

Rajcula was issued MSC # MC 455605 for violation of CGS: 14-227a Operating under the influence and 14-236 Failure to maintain lane. She was issued a court date of 5/5/21 at GA09 in Middletown and released on a \$2,500 non-surety bond.
