Recycling Center Regulations

Residents must obtain a vehicle tag to use the Recycling Center. These can be obtained by applying online or in person at the Public Works Office upon presentation of proof of residency such as vehicle registration or drivers license. Only Middletown waste material is accepted.

The Middletown Recycling Center is located at 185 Johnson St. at the corner of Johnson St. and North Main St.

April - June, September –November:	Every Saturday	7am-11:45am


Recyclables accepted free of charge:

Aluminum foil	Antifreeze
Brush (less than 6" in diameter; brought in by residents)	Glass & Metal Food and Beverage Containers Catalogs & Magazines
Cooking Oil	Corrugated Cardboard
Drink boxes	Electronics
Mixed paper	Catalogs & Magazines
Junk mail	Lead acid batteries
Leaves	Food Scraps
Milk & soup cartons	Mattresses and Box Springs (good condition)



Bulk Waste Regulations



All bulky waste material that enters the Recycling Center will be weighed on a scale and charged according to tonnage. No more than 2 tons of material is allowed.

All bulky waste material will be charged **\$160/ton** unless otherwise noted. All vehicles, including cars and SUVs will be weighed and charged.

There is a minimum charge of **\$10** for bulky waste.

All commercial transporters must be registered and licensed with the City.

Bulky Waste Material Includes:

Carpentry	Demolition and construction debris
Furniture	Landscape debris
Scrap metal	Wood
Brush \$25/load delivered by a contractor	Freon containing items (\$15.00 per unit)
Passenger tires (\$3.00 each: Limit 4 per trip)	Truck tires & tires on rims (\$10.00 each)

Curbside Bulk Waste Collection:

Curbside bulk waste collection is offered for \$75 per pick up. Mattresses and box springs are an additional \$36 per item.

Payment must be made to Public Works in-person prior to collection. Bulk waste pickup is suspended mid Oct. – Mar 1st.
