## RECYCLING REGULATIONS

Address: 185 Johnson St.

Residents must obtain a vehicle tag to use the Recycling Center. Tags can be obtained by [online application](#) or in-person at the [Public Works office](#). Documentation needed: proof of residency (driver's license) & the license plate number of the vehicle. Only recyclables/bulk waste from Middletown is accepted!



All year:	Mon-Fri	7am-2:45pm
Dec-Mar & July-Aug:	1st & 3rd Saturday	7am-11:45am
Apr-June & Sept-Nov:	Every Saturday	7am-11:45am

### Recyclables accepted free of charge:

- Aluminum foil
- Antifreeze
- Brush
- Catalogs & Magazines
- Cooking Oil
- Cardboard
- Drink boxes
- Electronics
- Food Scraps
- Glass & Metal Food Containers
- Junk Mail
- Leaves
- Milk & soup Cartons
- Newspaper
- Plastic Containers

### Household Electronics:

- Copiers
- Computers
- Radios
- Monitors
- Speakers
- Televisions
- Telephones
- Printers
- Microwaves
- Cell Phones

Residential items only.  
Per state law, no more than 7 items accepted per load.

## BULKY WASTE REGULATIONS

### Recycling Center Bulky Waste Charges


All bulky waste that enters the Recycling Center will be weighed on a scale and charged according to tonnage. No more than 2 tons of material is allowed. All bulky waste material will be charged **\$160/ton** unless otherwise noted. All vehicles, including cars and SUVs will be weighed and charged. There is a **minimum charge of \$10** for bulky waste. All commercial transporters must be registered and licensed with the City.

### Curbside Bulk Waste Collection

Curbside bulk waste collection is offered for a charge of \$75 per pick up. Mattresses and box springs are an additional \$36 per item. Payment must be made to Public Works in-person prior to collection. Bulk waste pickup is suspended mid Oct-Mar 1st.

### Bulky Waste Material Includes:

- Carpentry/wood
- Furniture
- Scrap metal
- Brush/landscape debris (\$25/load if delivered by a registered contractor)
- Passenger tires (\$3.00 each: Limit 4 per trip)
- Demolition and construction debris
- Freon-containing items (\$15.00 per unit)
- Truck tires & tires on rims (\$10.00 each)
